

La Villa Valente

Region: Languedoc **Sleeps:** 6

Overview

Set on a south-facing hillside on the edge of the medieval village of Gabian, Villa Valente opens onto lovely views of vine-striped hills and village rooftops. Surrounded by a sloping Mediterranean garden dotted with palms, pines and flowering shrubs, this welcoming villa offers a wonderful holiday home in the heart of the Languedoc region.

Step into the open-plan living space, where glass doors slide open to the charming terrace. Attractive furnishings and cool tiled floors flow through a light-filled lounge, dining area and well-equipped kitchen. Here, days revolve around the inviting 10-metre private pool, where the sun loungers set the stage for relaxed afternoons. Enjoy leisurely meals al-fresco by the barbecue, or challenge friends and family to a game of boules as the sky turns rose-gold.

All on one level, the villa is well suited for families and small groups, sleeping six guests in three comfortable bedrooms, including a king-size double room and two twins. A family bathroom and separate WC ensure convenience, while Wi-Fi, TV, toys and games make this a place as suited to rest as it is to recreation.

Tucked away at the end of a cul-de-sac with private parking, the villa remains just a short stroll from Gabian's local café-bar, bakery and grocery store. The nearby town of Pézenas offers bustling markets, artisan shops and excellent restaurants, while the Mediterranean's vast sandy beaches lie around half an hour away. Explore historic abbeys, cycle through vineyard-lined backroads or paddle through gorges by canoe - this region is rich in beauty and activity.

For those seeking an inviting base with effortless access to authentic village life, striking scenery and the sea beyond, Villa Valente offers a timeless Southern French escape.

Location & Local Information

Perched on a south-facing hillside near the edge of the medieval village of Gabian, Villa Valente enjoys a great location in the heart of the Languedoc wine country. Set at the end of a cul-de-sac in a residential area with a handful of neighbouring homes, the villa offers lovely views over the surrounding vineyards and rolling countryside.

Gabian itself, with its narrow streets and ancient ramparts, has everything you need within a 700m walk - a bakery, café-bar-restaurant, grocery store and pharmacy.

The celebrated market town of Pézenas is just 15 minutes away by car and makes for an ideal morning out with its artisan boutiques, antiques shops and vibrant Saturday market. Nearby Magalas (9km) and Roujan (4km) offer further shops, restaurants and transport links. Wine lovers are perfectly placed to explore the surrounding appellations, with acclaimed vineyards and tasting cellars dotted throughout the region, from Gabian itself to the celebrated wine villages of Faugères and Saint-Chinian.

When it's time to explore further afield, the options are endless. A 30 to 40-minute drive brings you to the Mediterranean coast, where you can enjoy a beach day at Cap d'Agde or the quieter stretches of Marseillan Plage. The fishing village of Bouzigues (37km), perched on the edge of the Étang de Thau lagoon, is famed for its oysters and relaxed waterfront dining. For those drawn to cultural charm, the port town of Sète (50km), Béziers' historic heart and canal walks (23km), and the pilgrimage village of Saint-Guilhem-le-Désert (45km) all offer captivating day trips.

Outdoor enthusiasts will find plenty to enjoy nearby. Hike or bike directly into the surrounding hills, swim in a local river or nearby reservoir, or spend the day at Lac du Salagou (32km), known for its striking red earth and summer watersports opportunities. From canoeing through dramatic gorges to exploring hilltop castles and abbeys, the region invites exploration at every turn.
