Overview


In the wine village of Faugères, Maison Capitelle blends the warmth of tradition with modern comforts. Once a working wine-maker's house, this characterful Languedoc home now offers a charming retreat with its private pool, flower-filled garden and air-conditioned bedrooms, just moments from local vineyards and village life.

Inside, the home unfolds across two main levels. Thoughtfully restored, the living spaces feel relaxed. The bright sitting room leads out to an elevated terrace with sweeping views, while the colourful kitchen encourages long, leisurely meals chez vous. Three inviting bedrooms, all air-conditioned, ensure restful nights even in the height of summer, complemented by two family bathrooms.

Outdoors, relax on the elevated terrace or follow the staircase down to the swimming pool and flower-filled garden. There's a summer kitchen with a fridge to keep your drinks cool as well as a barbecue. Meanwhile, table tennis adds a playful touch.

Maison Capitelle's location invites you to experience the best of southern France at an unhurried pace. In the village of Faugères, known for its namesake wines, you are a just a stroll from a café-restaurant and cellar doors. Spend mornings walking to the organic boulangerie just outside the village and exploring the village windmills, then venture to Béziers, Pézenas and the golden beaches of the Mediterranean, just 40 minutes away.

Whether you're here to discover the surrounding vineyards, dip into regional markets or simply relax in an authentic village setting, Maison Capitelle offers a welcoming base in southern France.

Main Floor

- Entrance hall
- Living room (via stairs) with wood-burning stove, TV (UK satellite channels), Wi-Fi internet and air-conditioning. Door opens to elevated terrace overlooking garden and pool below
- Fitted kitchen with island, gas hob, dishwasher and fridge freezer
- Dining room
- Shower room with WC, shower and sink



First Floor (via staircase with no handrail)

- Bedroom 1 with double bed and air-conditioning
- Bedroom 2 with two single beds and air-conditioning
- Bedroom 3 with double bed and air-conditioning

- Bathroom with corner bath/shower, separate shower and sink

Location & Local Information

In the historic winemaking village of Faugères, Maison Capitelle enjoys an enviable position amid the rugged hills of southern France, only 40 minutes from Béziers Cap d'Agde Airport.

Surrounded by vineyards and limestone ridges, this charming stone village offers an authentic slice of Languedoc life. Just 27km from Béziers and 40 minutes from the Mediterranean coast, it's perfectly placed for guests seeking both countryside and easy access to cultural and coastal highlights.

Faugères itself has a gentle, rustic pace. The house is on a road leading to the historic heart of the village. A short stroll brings you to a small café-restaurant, while a 15 to 20-minute walk leads you just outside the village centre to an organic boulangerie, a butcher and a seafood and tapas wine bar.


Within a 10-minute drive are the villages of Hérepian (9km) and Laurens (7km), each with a selection of shops, cafés and restaurants whilst both Magalas (13km) and Bédarieux (8.5km) offer even more amenities including supermarkets and train stations.

Nature lovers are spoiled for choice. The iconic Faugères windmills are just a short drive from the house, offering panoramic views across the surrounding vineyards. For outdoor adventures, the Orb River is ideal for canoeing and wild swimming, while the Languedoc Regional Park provides exceptional hiking through gorges, forests and craggy mountain paths. Golfers will enjoy nearby courses at Béziers and Lamalou-les-Bains, both within easy reach.

For those eager to explore the region's heritage, the spa town of Lamalou-les-Bains (12.5km) and the medieval village of Olargues (28km), listed among France's most beautiful, make for unforgettable day trips. Culture-rich Pézenas (25km) is just half an hour away, brimming with artisan boutiques, period architecture and a superb Saturday morning market. Alternatively, the lively city of Béziers (27km) offers shopping, markets and excellent dining, along with access to the serene Canal du Midi. When it's time to dip your toes in the sea, the golden sands of Valras-Plage are only 40 minutes by car for a brilliant day out by the Mediterranean.
