

# Maison Mascarille

**Region:** Languedoc **Sleeps:** 11

## Overview

On the very edge of Pézenas, Maison Mascarille reveals itself as a rare find in this much-loved Languedoc town. A renovated family home with a generous lawned garden and a private pool, it offers the ease of village living just a short stroll from artisan shops, cafés and the bustle of the famous Saturday morning market. Step inside to discover six bedrooms, an attractive living space and charming terraces made for long meals overlooking the garden and swimming pool.

The interiors are spacious and inviting, thoughtfully designed for family gatherings or holidays with friends. A bright open-plan living area connects effortlessly with a fully equipped kitchen, both flowing out onto the main terrace with steps down to the verdant garden and swimming pool below.

Each of the six bedrooms is air-conditioned for warm summer nights, and four sleek bathrooms add a sense of comfort and ease. Outside, the private garden is especially wonderful for such a centrally located house, offering room to dine al-fresco, swim in the pool or simply unwind.

From breakfast on the terrace to afternoons by the pool and al-fresco dinners on warm summer evenings, every corner of the outdoor grounds invites relaxation. Children can play on the lawn while adults watch-on, perhaps accompanied by a glass of local wine. For those who need to stay connected, the house is equipped with Wi-Fi and UK satellite TV, whilst a garage provides parking for four cars.

In just a couple of minutes on foot you will reach the historic heart of Pézenas, one of the region's cultural gems. Cobble streets weave through Renaissance architecture, artisan ateliers and sun-drenched cafés. The Saturday market is a must, overflowing with colour and local flavour, and look out for a wealth of vibrant festivities during the height of the summer.

When the sea calls, a 20 to 30-minute drive brings you to the sandy shores of Marseillan Plage or the vibrant beach scene at Cap d'Agde, where watersports, golf and beachfront dining await. You are also well placed for visiting wine villages, vineyards and oyster farms or venture a little further afield to the likes of Béziers and the Canal du Midi.

# Location & Local Information

On the edge of Pézenas, Maison Mascarille is located in an especially convenient position just a 5-minute walk to the heart of Pézenas. It is rare to find a holiday home with such a lovely garden and pool so close to the historic centre. Set on the main road leading to the Languedoc village of Nizas (6.5km), you only need to cross the road (near a small river), walk across a bridge and you will find yourself in central Pézenas within 400m.

Pézenas is a town steeped in charm, its cobbled streets and grand 17th-century façades evoking the days when Molière once graced its stages. Today, its cultural spirit lives on through summer festivals, street performances, artisan workshops and the vibrant Saturday market that spills across town from dawn till dusk.

From Maison Mascarille, you'll find every convenience within easy reach – a rich choice of traditional restaurants and numerous pavement cafés ideal for leisurely people-watching. The old quarter is a treasure trove of brocante stores and boutiques, while the surrounding wine country offers opportunities for vineyard tours and tastings in nearby villages such as Montagnac (6km), Caux (7km) and Neffiès (12km). Just minutes away, you'll be sipping fine Picpoul or Muscat beneath the Languedoc sun.

When the call of the coast beckons, the golden sands of Marseillan Plage (24km), Sérignan Plage (33km) and lively Cap d'Agde (27km) are all within a 30 to 40-minute drive. Whether you prefer quiet stretches or buzzing beach scenes, there's something for every mood. Cap d'Agde also offers a wide array of attractions, from golf and watersports to the popular Aqualand water park and a bustling marina lined with cafés and shops.

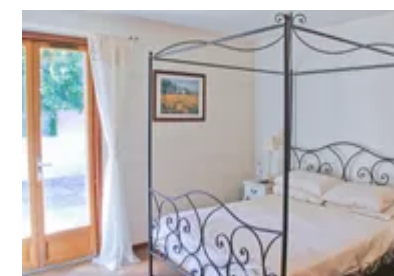
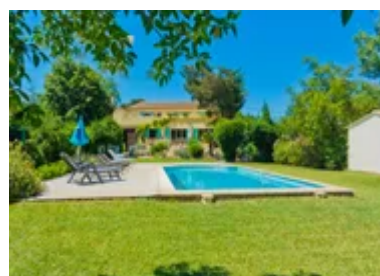
Meanwhile, the shimmering Etang de Thau lagoon provides a slower pace, ideal for oyster tasting, scenic boat trips, and soaking up the charm of harbourside villages like Bouzigues (23km) and Marseillan (18km).

For wider adventures, Béziers (25km) and Montpellier (56km) promise excellent shopping and rich urban culture, while the nearby Canal du Midi offers picturesque walks and cycle routes. Outdoor lovers can explore scenic hiking on the Mourgettes trail or enjoy freshwater swimming at Lake Salagou (30km).

Further afield, day trips to Carcassonne, the Pont du Gard or the Camargue reveal the region's astonishing diversity – from medieval citadels to flamingo-filled wetlands.
