

Mas De Lozanne

Region: Languedoc **Sleeps:** 8

Overview

Set among vines, Mas de Lozanne is a 19th-century farmhouse full of warmth, space and soul. Its stone walls and shuttered windows speak of a slower pace of life, while inside, original beamed ceilings and tiled floors create an atmosphere that is authentic yet utterly relaxed. This is a home that celebrates simplicity and charm, where each room feels like it has a story to tell.

From the upper floors, vineyard views stretch across the Languedoc landscape, a backdrop that feels almost timeless. Downstairs, the flow of daily life centres around the shaded terrace and garden, where games of boules, volleyball and badminton are played long into the evening, and meals linger over wine and laughter beneath dappled light. The 14-metre pool shimmers invitingly just beyond, bordered by sunbeds, hammocks and space enough for everyone to unwind.

Each of the three main bedrooms has its own style and space, all with air-conditioning to keep summer nights cool and comfortable. The large country kitchen is a natural gathering spot, with a refectory table perfect for slow breakfasts or planning market-day adventures. Meanwhile, the sitting room offers the familiar comforts of UK satellite TV and Wi-Fi.

Just a short stroll partly through the vines leads to the historic town of Pézenas, known for its colourful markets, winding medieval streets and bohemian spirit. The cultural life here hums with festivals, art and theatre, while its cafés and restaurants tempt at every turn. From Pézenas, Mediterranean beaches are less than half an hour away, offering everything from quiet beaches to lively seaside towns with waterfront dining and family-friendly attractions.

Whether savouring morning coffee or gathering for a twilight pétanque match as the cicadas hum, Mas de Lozanne invites you to step into a holiday in southern France that feels wonderfully unhurried.

Location & Local Information

In the heart of Languedoc’s vineyard country, Mas de Lozanne offers an enviable location on the edge of Pézenas, just a 10 to 15-minute walk (partly through the vines) from the historic town.

Known as the 'Versailles of the Languedoc', Pézenas enchants visitors with its cobbled lanes, grand townhouses and artisan ateliers. Stroll through the old quarter, browse a kilometre of antique and brocante shops, or savour the energy of the renowned Saturday market. Come summer, the town bursts into life with open-air concerts, costume festivals and art exhibitions, though quieter moments can be spent at a café terrace watching the world pass slowly by.

Surrounded by rolling vineyards, wine lovers will be spoilt for choice with nearby villages offering tastings of the region’s finest Picpoul de Pinet, Syrah and Grenache blends. For something different, head to the Paul Ricard distillery in Bessan or the Noilly Prat cellars in Marseillan for a taste of southern tradition.

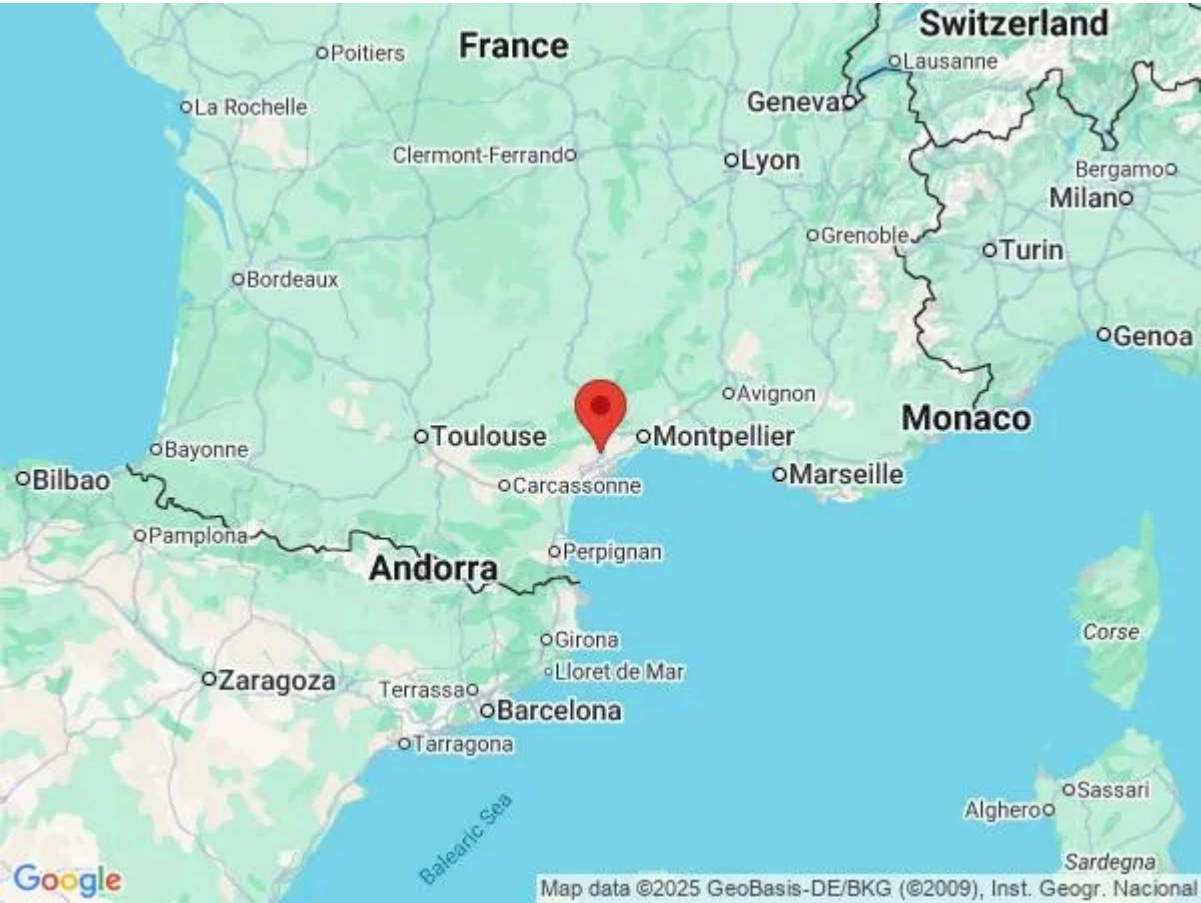
Meanwhile, hiking enthusiasts can explore the Mourgettes footpath just outside Pézenas, or venture to the dramatic landscapes of Gorges d'Héric for a wilder walk through the Languedoc Regional Park.

For beach days, the coastline beckons less than half an hour away. Cap d'Agde offers a vibrant atmosphere, family-friendly waterparks, boat trips and buzzing nightlife, while Marseillan Plage and Sérignan Plage provide a more relaxed seaside escape. Alternatively, along the Étang de Thau, indulge in freshly harvested oysters and seafood lunches at waterside restaurants, or take a boat trip across the shimmering lagoon.

A day trip to the canal-threaded town of Sète is a must, where traditional fishing boats bob in sun-drenched harbours and golden sands stretch for miles. Other unforgettable excursions include the UNESCO-listed Pont du Gard, the medieval city of Carcassonne, the Roman treasures of Arles, and the untouched beauty of the Camargue, where wild white horses roam among flamingos.
