

La Montade

Region: Languedoc **Sleeps:** 6

Overview

La Montade sits near the edge of a traditional Minervois village and enjoys glorious views that sweep across vines and gently undulating hills. The shaded terrace, where long lunches stretch into golden evenings, and the private swimming pool both make the most of this vantage point.

Inside, the home exudes a warm, unpretentious style that exudes comfort and simple charm. With its high-ceilinged living area and air-conditioned bedrooms, the house accommodates up to 6 guests with ease. The open-plan living and dining space leads directly onto the shaded terrace, creating a relaxed flow ideal for slow days. The attractive kitchen is well equipped for family meals, and the lounge offers a cosy retreat after the sun sets with its UK satellite TV and DVD player.

There are three bedrooms across two levels, including a double bedroom on the main upper level with its own bath and walk-in shower, a bedroom with 2 single beds and a double bedroom and shower room downstairs. Outdoors, the enclosed garden provides a delightful space to make the most of the pool. Afterwards, unwind with a chilled glass of Languedoc wine on your shaded terrace beside the barbecue.

Located in the Hérault village of Aigues-Vives, just a short walk brings you to essential amenities, from a bakery and grocery store to two local restaurants. Venture slightly further by car and you'll discover the atmospheric hamlets of La Caunette and Aigne, as well as bustling Olonzac with its lively Tuesday morning market and café culture.

Whether you're heading to Carcassonne for the day or cycling beside the Canal du Midi, returning to your garden and terrace at La Montade always feels like coming home.

Location & Local Information

In the Hérault department, on the edge of the picturesque village of Aigues-Vives in the Hérault, La Montade is located in the heart of the Minervois wine region, within an hour of both Carcassonne and Béziers Airports.

Just a short stroll from the village centre, guests have easy access to essential amenities including a bakery, café-bar-restaurant and two restaurants. The surrounding scenery is classic southern France - vineyards, country lanes and open skies that stretch across this unspoilt corner of Languedoc.


The nearby villages/hamlets of La Caunette (4km) and Aigne (2km) offer further culinary delights, while Olonzac (10km) comes alive on Tuesday mornings with its bustling traditional market. From artisan produce to vibrant local crafts, it's a must for anyone seeking authentic regional flavour. Meanwhile, wine lovers will be in heaven across the Languedoc region, with endless opportunities for tastings in renowned appellations such as Minervois, Corbières and Fitou.

For days out, the options are as varied as they are inspiring. The medieval village of Minerve (8km), dramatically perched above deep limestone gorges, is only a short drive and offers an unforgettable blend of natural beauty and Cathar history. Le Somail (12km), one of the prettiest spots along the Canal du Midi, invites lazy walks or bike rides beside the water, while boat trips provide a peaceful way to soak in the scenery.

Aigues-Vives is also ideally placed for exploring Carcassonne's iconic citadel (50km), the Roman heritage of Narbonne (25km), and the atmospheric streets of Béziers (40km). For a complete change of pace, Mediterranean beaches such as Narbonne Plage (43km) are also just under an hour away, offering vast sands and a range of watersports.
