

# Argelo La Riviere

**Region:** Dordogne **Sleeps:** 10

## Overview

Set amid five acres of meadow and gardens, a short walk from the Dordogne River, Argelo La Riviere is a beautifully restored farmhouse that captures the rustic soul of the Périgord Noir. Clad in ivy and featuring a charming two-storey tower, its traditional stonework and beamed ceilings hint at its heritage, while gorgeous terraces and a private swimming pool are perfect for relaxed outdoor living.

Inside, Argelo La Riviere balances character and comfort with ease. The warm kitchen and dining area are well-equipped for family meals, with both a filter and Nespresso coffee machine for easy mornings. A pretty living room opens onto the terrace and features UK satellite television and Wi-Fi to keep everyone connected. With four inviting bedrooms, all ensuite, including a top-floor tower room that sleeps four beneath the rustic beams, the house is perfect for extended families or friends holidaying together.

Mornings begin with breakfast under the covered terrace overlooking the garden and lawn. Lazy afternoons melt into long poolside moments beside the swimming pool. Evenings might be spent with a game of table tennis, or enjoying local produce on the barbecue beneath a canopy of stars. Whether lounging by the lawns or enjoying the comfort of a shaded seat with a book, the sense of space is irresistible.

Argelo La Riviere is perfectly positioned to explore the rich tapestry of the Dordogne. Within walking distance is Plage de Vitrac (1.2km), where a riverside restaurant and canoe hire invite days of gentle adventure. The medieval bastide of Domme lies just five minutes away by car, its hilltop views and cobbled lanes offering a step into the past. And only 9km north, the honey-hued streets of Sarlat-la-Canéda beckon with bustling markets, artisan shops and open-air cafés.

For families and friends in search of authentic charm and space to unwind, Argelo La Riviere is a place to slow down, reconnect and experience the very best of the Dordogne countryside.

## House Interiors

### Ground Floor

- Entrance into kitchen and dining area with table and chairs. Kitchen well-equipped with dishwasher, washing machine, oven, hob, fridge freezer and two coffee makers (filter and Nespresso)

# Location & Local Information

Set in the heart of the Dordogne's golden triangle, Argelo La Riviere enjoys a wonderful location just moments from the banks of the Dordogne River, close to the famous village of Domme and only a 15-minute drive from Sarlat-la-Canéda.

A leisurely 1.2km stroll brings you to Vitrac Port, where a riverside restaurant serves local favourites and canoe hire gives access to one of the region's most enchanting experiences – paddling past limestone cliffs, châteaux and walnut groves. Just five minutes away by car, Cénac-et-Saint-Julien (5.5km) provides essential amenities, while nearby Domme (3km), a 'Plus Beaux Village de France', invites exploration with its cobbled lanes, panoramic views and hilltop charm.



For day trips steeped in history and beauty, La Roque-Gageac, clinging to the cliffside above the river, and the medieval strongholds of Castelnau, Beynac and Montfort lie within a short drive.

Meanwhile, the splendid town of Sarlat-la-Canéda, just 9km by car, offers a vibrant taste of the region's soul. Its winding lanes, impeccably preserved Renaissance architecture and renowned Saturday market draw visitors year-round. During summer, Sarlat also comes alive with open-air night markets and street performers, adding to the festive atmosphere.

This region of the Périgord Noir is famed for its rich and authentic cuisine – duck confit, foie gras, black truffles and locally harvested walnuts feature heavily on menus, while bustling markets provide an irresistible spread of regional produce. Whether sampling artisanal cheeses in a market square or sipping wine at sunset, guests at Argelo La Riviere are perfectly placed to savour the very best of Dordogne life.
