Manoir De L'Hermier

Overview

Set in fifteen acres of garden lawns and woodland, Manoir de l'Hermier is a quintessential Dordogne estate perfect for relaxed country living. Just 7km from Sarlat-la-Canéda, this grand *manoir* and garden cottage offer an exceptional escape for families or large groups, with room to sleep up to 16 guests in character and comfort.

From the moment you step through the tower entrance of the original stone manor house, the sense of history and character is undeniable. Interiors are sensitively furnished across three levels, blending traditional charm with contemporary touches. There are two well-appointed lounges, a formal dining room and a well-equipped family kitchen that spills out onto the terrace. Six bedrooms (five en suite) are found throughout the main house, each with its own individual style, while the garden cottage offers further space, complete with a generous family bathroom, a living area and two connecting bedrooms.

Days here unfold at a gentle rhythm. Start with a swim in the heated 15-metre pool, then drift between tennis, table tennis or a lazy afternoon beside the trees. There is a boules court for leisurely evenings and an indoor gym for those who want to keep active. Inside, table-tennis, a TV lounge and Wi-Fi throughout ensure everyone is entertained, come rain or shine.

Set in a little hamlet just 3km from the village of Carsac-Aillac, the location is as idyllic as it is convenient. Sarlat-la-Canéda, with its medieval architecture, vibrant markets and atmospheric squares, is only a short drive away. Outdoor adventures abound nearby, from canoeing along the river Dordogne to forest zip-lines and scenic walking and cycling trails. A little further afield, discover prehistoric cave art in Les Eyzies or stroll through France's 'prettiest village' at La Roque-Gageac, nestled beneath dramatic limestone cliffs.

Manoir de l'Hermier promises a truly memorable stay in one of the region's most enchanting corners.

Manoir Interiors

Main Floor (via steps from the garden or courtyard)

- Entrance hall in tower (via stairs from courtyard)
- Living room with TV and patio doors to terrace
- Dining room with extendable table and chairs
- Kitchen and breakfast room with central preparation island, breakfast table and chairs, range cooker, two fridges and freezer and dishwasher. Door opens to terrace
- Second living room with large fireplace, library and card table
- Bedroom 1 with double bed and ensuite WC, shower and sink
- Bedroom 2 with double bed, air-conditioning, courtyard access and ensuite WC. Stairs to private bathroom with bath-tub, shower, hand basin and dressing room

Location & Local Information

Located in a little hamlet just a short drive from the village of Carsac-Aillac, Manoir de l'Hermier offers an idyllic base for exploring the very best of the Dordogne. Surrounded by gentle hills, ancient woodland and rolling fields, the setting is wonderful and perfectly placed for adventures along the river and into nearby villages. With Sarlat-la-Canéda just 7km away, guests are never far from charming cobbled streets, local markets and atmospheric dining spots.

Carsac-Aillac (3km) itself has all the essentials – from boulangeries and a handful of restaurants to a canoe base on the nearby Dordogne River, not to mention an occasional night market in the height of the summer. For families, there's also a tree-top adventure park with walkways and zip-lines just 1.5km away. Furthermore, a former railway line turned greenway/voie verte, offers flat and scenic cycling paths stretching from Sarlat, passing close to Carsac-Aillac (with a lovely detour to Groléjac and its lakeside beach).

The enchanting town of Sarlat-la-Canéda is a highlight of the region. Famed for its golden stone architecture, excellent restaurants and vibrant markets (Wednesdays and Saturdays), this medieval gem is a hub of Périgord Noir culture.


A short drive leads to riverside villages like Domme (12km), with its hilltop views and history-rich streets, and La Roque-Gageac (13km), dramatically tucked beneath towering cliffs and voted one of France's prettiest villages. From here, you can embark on traditional boat trips along the Dordogne or set off on more exhilarating canoeing excursions.

This part of the Dordogne is also steeped in history. Grand châteaux rise above the riverbanks, and the area is dotted with prehistoric wonders. Les Eyzies (27km), the capital of prehistory, lies amid spectacular rock formations and is home to some of the world's most important cave sites. The legendary Lascaux cave paintings are a must-see, offering a powerful window into early human creativity.

From gentle riverside picnics to days packed with heritage and outdoor fun, Manoir de l'Hermier invites you to experience the Dordogne at its most authentic and enchanting.
