

# Le Sechoir

**Region:** Dordogne   **Sleeps:** 10

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## Overview

In the Dordogne countryside, where golden fields roll into wooded hills, Le Séchoir stands as a charmingly reimagined barn where heritage and contemporary design meet. Once a traditional tobacco-drying barn, this architect-designed conversion now offers comfort across two spacious levels, set within a hectare of grounds with a private swimming pool.

Sleeping up to 10 guests, natural materials and thoughtful details define the interiors. On the ground floor, open-plan living and dining spaces invite sociable gatherings, while the colourful kitchen makes holiday cooking a pleasure. A ground-floor double bedroom with en-suite bath and shower provides ideal access, while upstairs, three additional bedrooms cater perfectly for families or groups, each with ceiling fans and served by two well-appointed bathrooms (one en suite).

Step outside and the experience continues. The private, heated pool stretches twelve metres long, edged with a sun terrace and loungers ideal for languid afternoons beneath the Dordogne sky. Children will love the swings and table tennis, and all the family can gather on the shaded dining terrace for long meals prepared on the barbecue. There seems to be so much space to roam, dine and unwind in every direction.

Le Séchoir's location offers both rural seclusion and proximity to the region's most charming towns. The nearby villages of Salviac and Cazals provide daily essentials and friendly cafés, while Gourdon and Sarlat-la-Canéda, both less than half an hour away, offer a deeper dive into local culture, gastronomy and unmissable markets. Whether ballooning above the valley, canoeing along the Dordogne or exploring ancient cave art near Les Eyzies, adventure and history lie close at hand.

With three electrically-assisted bikes available on request, the rolling countryside becomes effortlessly accessible, opening up scenic routes at your own pace. Le Séchoir promises a stay that is deeply rooted in its rural setting.

# Location & Local Information

In the unspoilt countryside near the border of the Lot and Dordogne departments, Le Séchoir boasts a superb location for discovering the region's rich tapestry of sights and experiences. Within easy reach by car, the villages of Salviac (4.5km) and Cazals (7.5km) provide all the essentials, from traditional boulangeries and café-bars to grocery shops and inviting restaurants.

This rural setting is a perfect base for venturing into some of southwest France's most picturesque villages. Domme (18km), a striking bastide perched high above the Dordogne River, captivates with sweeping vistas and historic charm. Down below, the river winds gently through postcard-perfect scenery, ideal for days spent canoeing past honey-hued cliffs and riverside hamlets. A little further along, the enchanting village of La Roque-Gageac (20km) nestles beneath towering limestone cliffs, where guests can enjoy relaxed river cruises, lively cafés and even an adrenaline-fuelled round of paintballing.

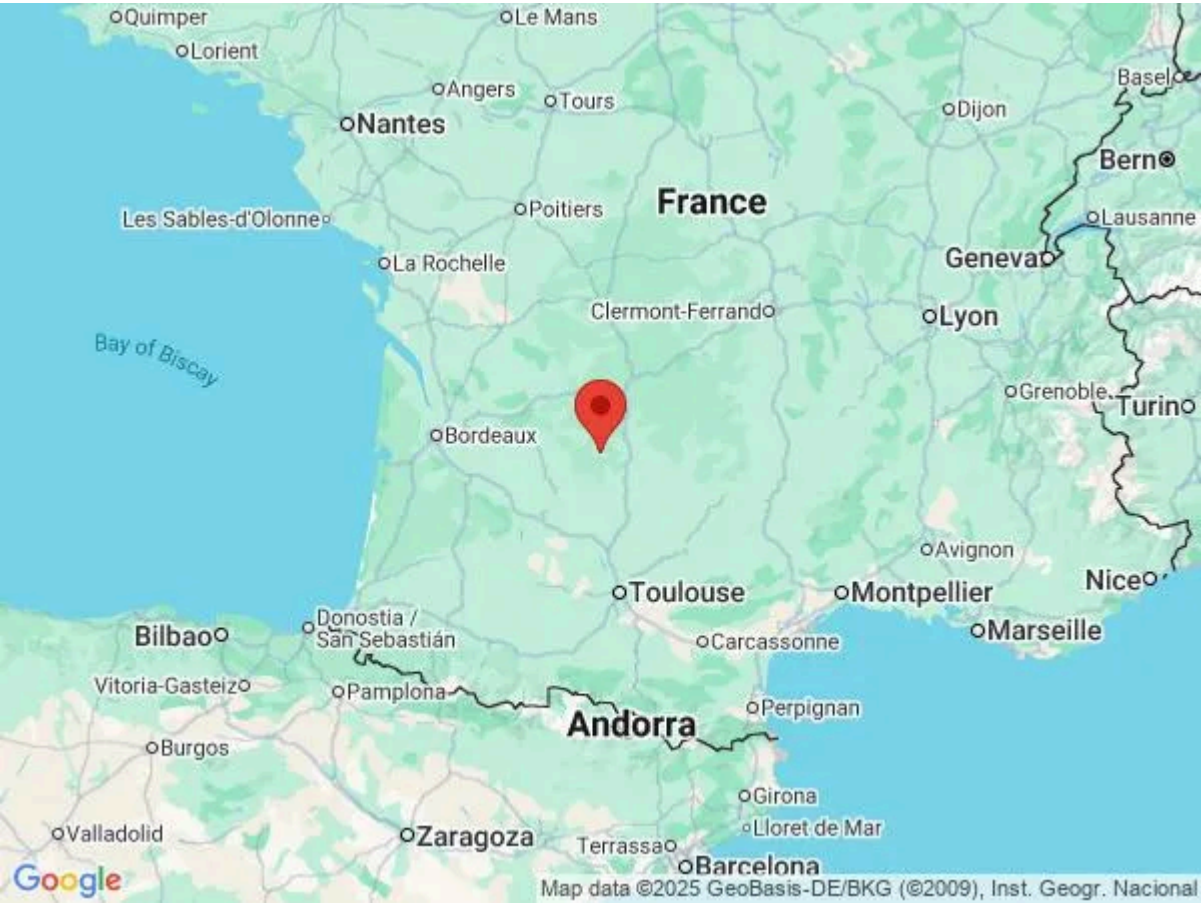
Nearby, the formidable castle at Castelnaud-la-Chapelle (22km) offers a powerful reminder of the area's medieval past, while the nearby Jardins de Marqueyssac (22km) invite visitors to wander leafy trails and soak up panoramic views.

A cultural highlight awaits in Sarlat-la-Canéda (28km), renowned for its golden-stone architecture, cobbled lanes, fine dining, and bustling Saturday market, one of the best in the country. For those willing to venture a little farther, Rocamadour (48km) rewards with its breathtaking cliffside setting and centuries-old pilgrimage heritage.

From leisurely walks through timeworn villages to tranquil paddles down the river or simply enjoying the relaxing pace of rural life, Le Séchoir is perfectly placed for an unforgettable French countryside retreat.
