

Maison et Bergerie De La Brousse

Overview

Stone-framed and sun-warmed in the northern Dordogne countryside, Maison et Bergerie de la Brousse is a masterfully restored 18th-century retreat only 16km from Sarlat-la-Canéda.

Framed by manicured gardens, this charming ensemble of a Maison de Maître and traditional Bergerie encircles a central garden, where a heated pool awaits. Exposed beams, weathered stone walls and authentic architectural flourishes run throughout, seamlessly marrying rustic heritage with modern comforts.

The main house is an inviting haven, designed for gatherings and slow-living moments. The gorgeous living room, with its vast fireplace and deep sofas, opens into a farmhouse-style kitchen equipped for convivial cooking. Two pretty double bedrooms, both with ensuite bathrooms, provide a restful escape.

Across the garden, the Bergerie offers three additional ensuite bedrooms spread across three floors, each with warm character and thoughtful touches, ideal for extended family or groups of friends.

Outside, this holiday home invites effortless outdoor living. Long lunches unfold on the shaded dining terrace beside the barbecue, and the swimming pool awaits for summer afternoons. Quiet corners are perfect for reading, while the evening draws guests together for wine and stargazing.

Perfectly positioned for discovering the wonders of the Dordogne, the property sits just 20 minutes from the enchanting town of Sarlat-la-Canéda, famed for its vibrant markets, mediaeval lanes and rich culinary culture.

Local shops and cafés in La Chapelle-Aubareil are just 4 km away, while riverside Montignac and the iconic Lascaux caves are just a short drive. From exploring prehistoric treasures in Les Eyzies to canoeing near La Roque-Gageac, this region is steeped in natural beauty and cultural treasures.

Maison et Bergerie de la Brousse offers a graceful setting where heritage and hospitality combine in timeless French style.

Location & Local Information

Maison et Bergerie de la Brousse enjoys a rural setting in a little hamlet in the Dordogne countryside, close to the village of Saint-Geniès and only 16km from the storied streets of Sarlat-la-Canéda. This beautifully restored abode offers easy access to some of the region's most captivating sights, from prehistoric wonders to medieval villages.

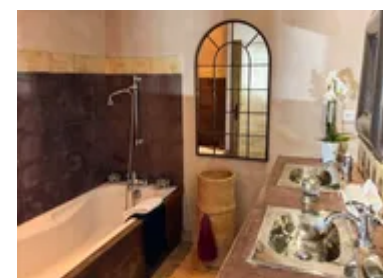
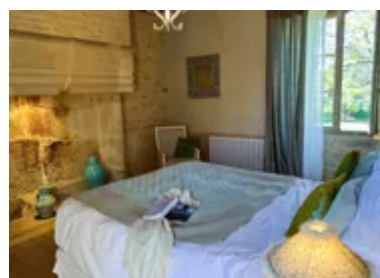
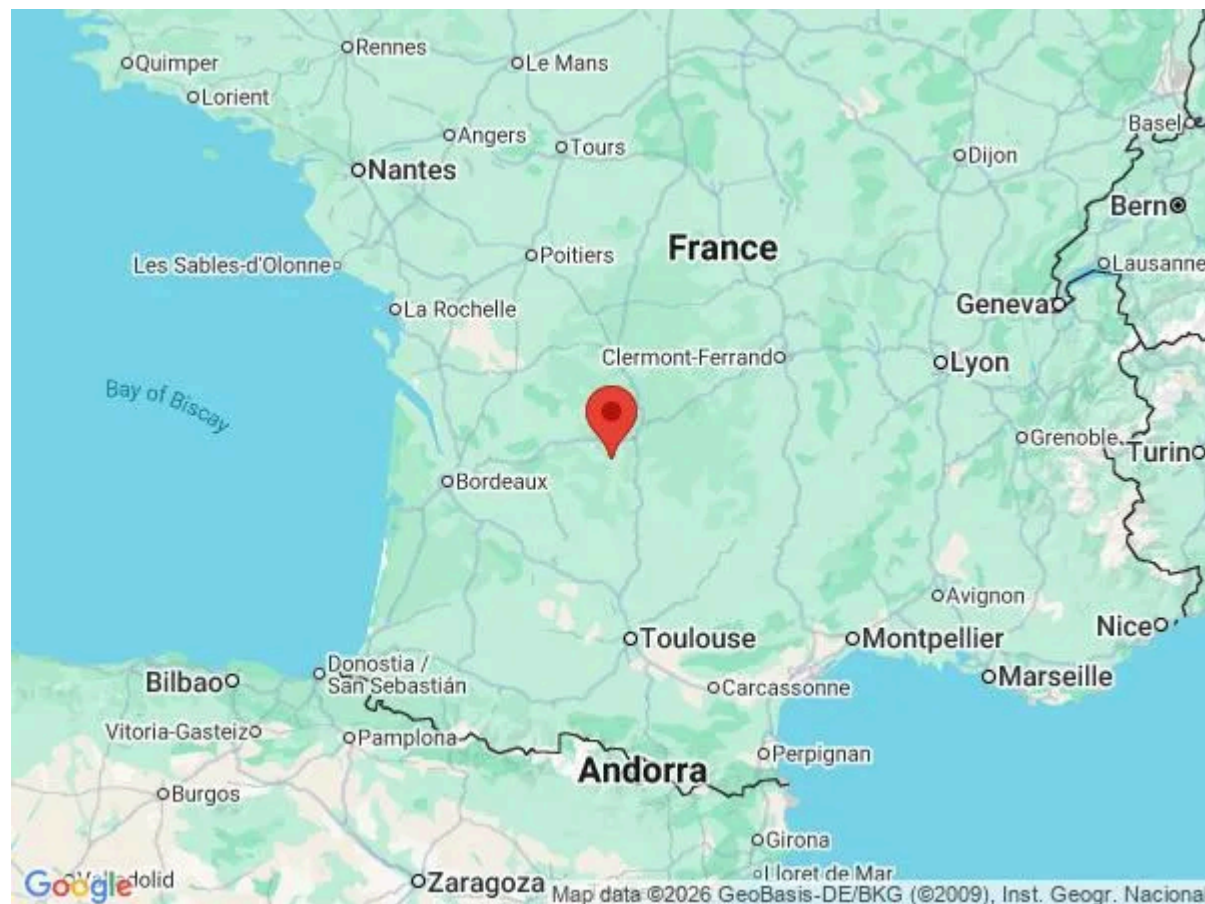
The nearby village of Saint-Geniès, only 3km away, is known for its traditional stone houses and lively Sunday market, while Montignac (8km) provides practical amenities including supermarkets, banks, shops and a choice of restaurants and cafés. Closer still, La Chapelle-Aubareil (5km) has a charming café-bar and a small local shop. This area is both tranquil and conveniently located, ideal for guests seeking countryside without sacrificing access to essentials.

The celebrated Lascaux IV Centre International de l'Art Pariétal (13km) near Montignac brings the magic of prehistoric cave art vividly to life through sophisticated recreations of original cave paintings. A little further, Les Eyzies (22km) sits at the heart of the Vézère Valley, a UNESCO World Heritage Site known for its dramatic cliffside caves and striking rock formations. The valley offers a glimpse into early human history, with opportunities to explore archaeological museums, caves and walking trails along the river.

For cultural immersion and fine dining, Sarlat-la-Canéda (16km) is a must. Famed for its honey-coloured stone buildings, lively Saturday market and vibrant squares lined with excellent eateries, it captures the essence of Périgord charm. Adventurous visitors can also take to the skies with hot air balloon rides or microlight flights from nearby Sarlat-Domme aerodrome, while water-lovers may enjoy canoeing on the Dordogne or exploring the cliff-hugging village of La Roque-Gageac, just 30km away.
