

Maison Baleyssagues

Region: Dordogne **Sleeps:** 6

Overview

Encircled by vines and open countryside, Maison Baleyssagues captures the easy elegance of rural life in south-west France. This architect-designed, single-storey residence stretches across 225 square metres, where pretty shuttered doors open onto beautiful gardens and extensive views beyond.

The interiors are light-filled and carefully composed. A high-ceilinged salon with a piano and library encourages slow mornings, while the dining room and well-equipped kitchen invite convivial evenings over regional wines. Each of the three ensuite bedrooms opens directly to the garden, allowing indoor and outdoor living to blend seamlessly. Thoughtful touches such as a Bluetooth speaker, Wi-Fi and shaded dining terrace with a Weber barbecue enhance the stay with understated luxury.

At the heart of the garden lies the stunning heated pool, a unique shape framed by lavender and flowers. With sun loungers arranged across a generous terrace, this is a space for lingering, whether with a good book or a leisurely swim beneath the wide blue sky.

Just five minutes away by car lies Duras, a fortified medieval town rich in heritage and local colour. Its weekly market bursts with regional produce, while the imposing château offers panoramic views across the Dropt valley. Here you are in the heart of the Côtes de Duras appellation with many local domaines waiting to be visited. Wine-lovers also note Saint-Émilion, Bergerac and the famed Entre-Deux-Mers wine region are all within easy reach, offering excursions steeped in culture, gastronomy and history.

Whether you're planning slow summer days by the pool, vineyard visits or lively summer night markets beneath the stars, Maison Baleyssagues offers an idyllic base in one of France's most rewarding regions.

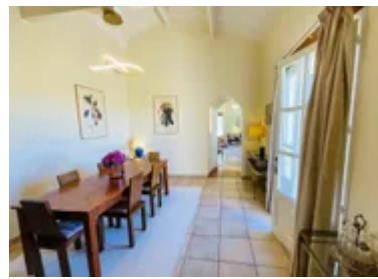

Location & Local Information

Set amidst the rolling hills and vineyards of the Lot-et-Garonne, Maison Baleyssagues offers a countryside escape just 4km from the historic town of Duras. Set on a hillside with extensive views, the house is ideally positioned between Bergerac (41km) and Marmande (25km), around 90 minutes from Bordeaux. Whether you're seeking rural charm, good wine or easy access to some of south-west France's most captivating destinations, this is a perfect base to explore the region's rich heritage and celebrated gastronomy.

The picturesque town of Duras is your nearest hub, boasting a striking medieval château, panoramic valley views and a lively atmosphere. You'll find all essential amenities here, from bakeries and cafés to a weekly produce market and vibrant night markets in the height of the summer, ideal for mingling with locals over wine and shared tables. For broader shopping and dining options, Marmande is only a 20-minute drive away, famed for its delicious tomatoes and other farm produce.

Wine lovers are particularly well-placed at Maison Baleyssagues. Located in the heart of the Côtes de Duras appellation, the surrounding area is home to nearly 200 vineyards, many welcoming guests for tastings of their organic and traditional red and white wines. Just a little further lie the vineyards of l'Entre-deux-Mers and Bergerac, while the iconic village of Saint-Émilion, with its cobbled streets and renowned crus, is only 45 minutes by car.

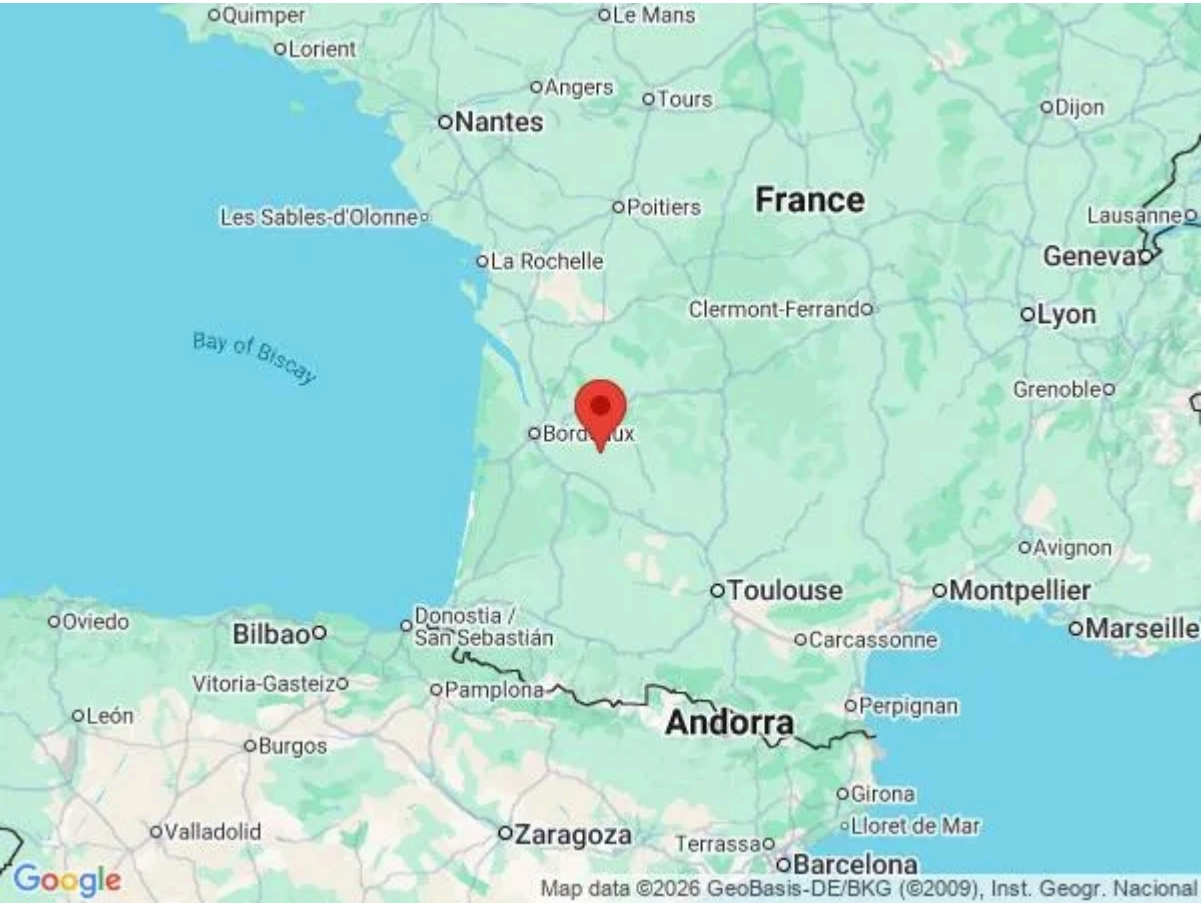
This part of France is steeped in history, with a wealth of bastide towns such as Monségur (8km), Eymet (25km) and Monpazier (70km), all easily reached for wonderful days out. Each offers charming squares, medieval architecture and atmospheric markets.

For those seeking outdoor adventure, the Dordogne River to the north and the Dropt River to the south provide idyllic settings for canoeing or kayaking, allowing you to take in the region's natural beauty from the water.

Whether you're wandering through Bergerac's old town, enjoying a sunset meal at a summer night market or sampling the region's exceptional wines, Maison Baleyssagues places you at the heart of one of France's most authentic and rewarding destinations.
