Set in six hectares of fields and woodland, Le Moulin du Souquet is a beautifully restored, detached country home offering both traditional charm and modern comfort. With stylish interiors, generous living spaces and a superb swimming pool, it's the ideal setting for a relaxed escape with family or friends.

Step inside and you'll find open-plan living designed with effortless style. The attractive kitchen with island bar is fully equipped for sociable cooking, flowing into a spacious lounge with TV, DVD player and fibre optic Wi-Fi. With four well-appointed bedrooms (three doubles and one quad with bunk-beds) and two family bathrooms across the first floor, there's ample space for up to 10 guests to unwind in comfort.

Outside, the pleasures of country living continue. Enjoy leisurely days by your raised swimming pool, dine al-fresco under the covered poolside terrace or challenge your group to a game on the boules court or professional table tennis table. As evening nears, sit back on the outdoor lounge with a glass of local wine and soak up the beautiful surroundings.

Just 1km away lies a local golf course and tennis court, ideal for those who want to stay active. The charming market town of Castelnau-Montratier, only 7km by car, offers everything you need – from a boulangerie and weekly market to cosy cafés and local restaurants. For larger shops and supermarkets, head to Cahors or Montauban, both around 40 minutes by car.

In the scenic countryside of southwestern France, Le Moulin du Souquet promises a restful getaway with all the comforts of home - and more.

Location & Local Information

Set within six hectares of private land in the French countryside near the border of Tarn-et-Garonne and Lot, Le Moulin du Souquet enjoys a pretty location in the heart of the Quercy Blanc. This picturesque corner of southwest France enchants with its tapestry of medieval hilltop villages and peaceful riverbanks, an ideal backdrop for both restful retreats and leisurely exploration.

Just 1km away, a local 9-hole golf course awaits keen players, also featuring a clubhouse where light lunches are served, as well as a tennis court available to hire by the hour. Scenic walking routes pass close by, and horse-riding stables are within driving distance for equestrian adventures.

Around 10 minutes by car lies the charming village of Castelnau-Montratier (7km), home to a traditional arcaded square, weekly market, local eateries and practical amenities including a supermarket. A little farther afield, Montcuq (15km) captivates with its medieval tower, relaxed ambience and lively Sunday market.



Only 17km away, Lauzerte, one of the region's best-preserved bastides, offers a delightful day out. It's especially atmospheric on Thursday evenings in the height of the summer when its night market and 'fête des repas' bring the streets to life with music, shared meals, and community celebration beneath the stars.

Active visitors will relish the chance to immerse themselves in nature, whether swimming in the clean waters of the Lot, Célé, or Aveyron rivers or enjoying kayaking and paddleboarding from nearby Bouziès (52km) or Saint-Antonin-Noble-Val (49km). For gentler pursuits, head south to the Canal Latéral à la Garonne for cycling along the towpath.

Cultural explorers can venture to Cahors (30km) for a taste of local heritage, with its lively market scene, historic bridges and acclaimed Malbec wines. Further wonders await at Saint-Cirq-Lapopie (50km) and across the UNESCO-listed Causses du Quercy Regional Park, both offering dramatic landscapes and rich historical allure.
