# Villa Challier

### **Overview**

Set into the hillside above the chic seaside town of Collioure, Villa Challier is an architect-designed villa with stunning interiors and glorious views, only 1.5km from the galleries, restaurants and beaches of this historic former fishing village.

Every detail of this contemporary home has been thoughtfully designed for both style and comfort. The open-plan upper level blends sleek kitchen design with a relaxed lounge and dining area, all seamlessly connected to the upper terrace for al-fresco dining and lounging beside the swimming pool (heated in certain months).

Below, four stylish double bedrooms each enjoy their own en-suite and direct access to the lower terraces. Here, guests can unwind in the jacuzzi, enjoy a game of table football or simply chill out by shaded seating nooks framed by palms and cacti.

Whether you are travelling as a family or a group of friends, Villa Challier is perfectly tailored for relaxed days and convivial evenings. There is high-speed Wi-Fi and air-conditioning throughout, along with a wine fridge and ice machine to keep things effortlessly chilled. The swimming pool outside is wonderful, just the right size for cooling off after a day exploring.

Just 1.5km downhill is the heart of Collioure. Known for its artistic heritage, colourful façades and vibrant Catalan culture, this little seaside town offers an array of cafés and restaurants as well as beaches and boat trips.

Beyond the town, the region's dramatic coastline and vineyard-covered hills offer endless possibilities. Explore headland walking trails, charter a boat from Port Vendres or taste your way through local produce at the nearby fish market. Action loving families will appreciate the close proximity of Argelèssur-Mer whilst guests seeking more cultural experiences should spend the day in Perpignan.

Just moments from one of the Mediterranean's most charming little towns, Villa Challier offers a stylish base where the rhythms of the coast can be truly experienced.

### **Location & Local Information**

Set in a residential neighbourhood above the shimmering Mediterranean, Villa Challier enjoys an enviable location just 1.5km from the heart of Collioure, one of the most enchanting towns on the southern French coast, 36km from Perpignan Airport and close to the Spanish border.

With its pastel-painted harbour, winding cobbled lanes and legacy as a haven for Fauvist artists, Collioure exudes timeless elegance. Come across traditional cafés, beachfront restaurants and golden pebbled coves. Look out for the atmospheric markets on a Sunday and Wednesday morning, a fine way to pick up a wealth of seasonal produce from the region.

Surrounded by the raw beauty of the Côte Vermeille, the villa is perfectly placed for both relaxation and adventure. The headland hiking trail offers panoramic views across the Golfe du Lion, while vineyards behind Collioure invite lazy afternoon strolls or tastings of fine Banyuls wine. Nearby Port-Vendres (4km) boasts the Côte Catalane Poissonnerie, a gourmet fish market that rivals London's finest food halls. If you're feeling adventurous, boat charters, scuba diving, horse riding and bike hire are all readily available.

Just 8km away, the vibrant beach resort of Argelès-sur-Mer offers long stretches of sand, family-friendly amusements and lively bars that come to life on summer evenings. In the other direction, the picturesque town of Banyuls-sur-Mer (13.5km) is famed for its sweet wines and rocky coves.


Meanwhile, culture-seekers should not miss Perpignan (28km), once the seat of the Kings of Majorca, where palm-lined boulevards lead to Gothic cathedrals, Romanesque cloisters and Catalan markets bursting with local charm.

For long days out, crossing into Spain opens up a whole new world – follow the winding coastal road or head inland via the autoroute. The dazzling white village of Cadaqués (62km), where Dalí once lived, is less than two hours away, as is the atmospheric city of Girona (100km), rich in medieval history and vibrant culinary culture.

For music lovers, the summer calendar offers delights such as the Pablo Casals Festival in Prades (70km), the cross-border Peralada Festival (66km), and Flamenco nights at Château Valmy (7.5km).
