

# Mas De Caludette

**Region:** Languedoc   **Sleeps:** 6

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## Overview

In a residential neighbourhood very close to the historic heart of Pézenas, Mas De Caludette is an attractively renovated detached home where contemporary comfort meets Southern French charm. Behind its modest façade lies a bright, welcoming interior designed for relaxed family living. A leisurely 10-minute stroll brings you to the winding streets of Pézenas' celebrated old town, where Renaissance buildings frame inviting shops, open-air cafés and vibrant market stalls.

Inside, the house flows comfortably over two levels. The ground floor features a stylish kitchen with central island, a dining area with air-conditioning and a cosy yet comfortable living room with TV (UK channels). Upstairs, the master bedroom includes its own balcony and an impressive ensuite with both bath and shower. Two additional bedrooms, one double and one twin, are thoughtfully laid out with access to a shower room. Every bedroom is air-conditioned, ensuring restful nights throughout the warmer months.

Outside, the dining terrace sets the tone for long lunches and evening barbecues, framed by a fenced garden and flowers. The swimming pool glistens to the side of the dining terrace, offering a refreshing escape after a morning at the market or a day by the sea. With gated off-road parking and a bakery and supermarket just a five-minute walk away, everyday ease is part of the experience.

Pézenas is one of the Languedoc's most treasured towns, known for its culture, history and artisan flair. The Saturday market is a spectacle in itself, spilling through the town's honey-toned streets, while summertime festivals, concerts and exhibitions bring a vibrant rhythm to local life. Sandy beaches await just 20 to 30 minutes south, from the family-friendly shores of Vias-Plage to the cosmopolitan buzz of Cap d'Agde.

Whether you're wandering through antique shops or sharing stories over rosé near the pool, Mas De Caludette is a wonderful base for exploring the many historic towns, wine villages and beaches of this part of southern France.

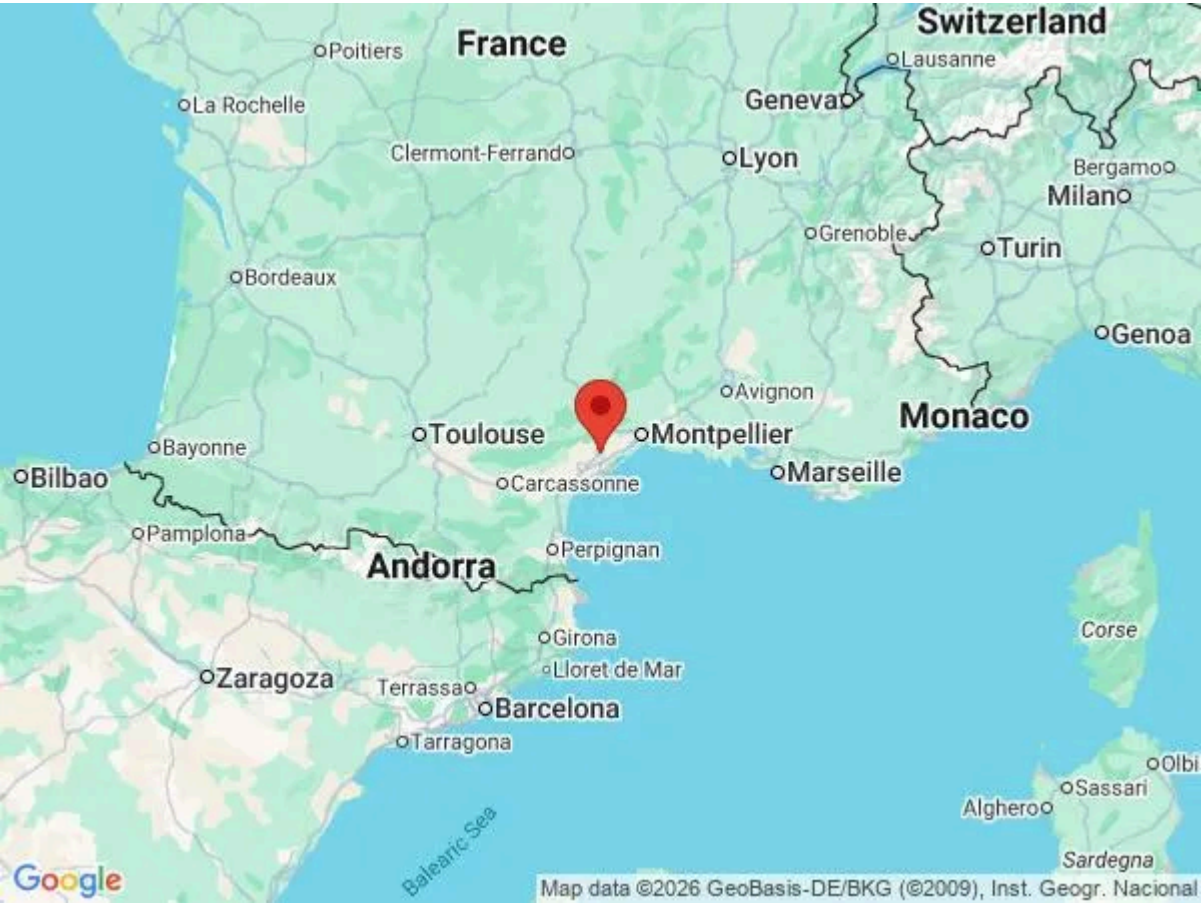
Renowned for its winding cobbled streets, grand Renaissance mansions and rich artistic heritage, Pézenas is often referred to as the 'Versailles of Languedoc'. From June through September, the town brims with life - festivals, open-air theatre, exhibitions and vibrant costume parades fill its historic centre. The Saturday market is a must: overflowing with local produce, crafts and *brocante* treasures, it's a weekly celebration of southern French living.

For seaside pleasures, the golden Mediterranean coast is just 20 to 30 minutes south. Choose the family-friendly buzz of Vias Plage or explore the more tranquil sands of Marseillan Plage and Sérignan Plage. Cap d'Agde delivers action and entertainment with its waterparks, aquariums, golf, shopping and boat tours.

Inland, a day trip to Béziers reveals grand boulevards, a soaring cathedral and one of the region's finest flower markets every Friday. Nearby, the tranquil Canal du Midi offers leisurely bike rides and barge cruises through pretty villages and vineyards.

Wine lovers are spoilt for choice, with Languedoc's celebrated vineyards so close. Discover characterful wine villages, sample local vintages or take a tour of the iconic Noilly Prat cellars in Marseillan, half an hour away.

Whether you're soaking up Pézenas' artistic soul, exploring coastal delights or wandering through vineyard-cloaked hillsides, Mas De Caludette is your practical and stylish base for discovering the heart of Languedoc.
