

# Chateau Cogulot

**Region:** Dordogne **Sleeps:** 10

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## Overview

Set atop a gently rising hill in the heart of the Dordogne countryside, Château Cogulot offers a timeless escape where tradition and wide-open space come together. Surrounded by 17 acres of private land, this classic French home is a place where mornings begin with birdsong and days unfold between leisurely swims, afternoon tennis and al-fresco dining under the soft golden light of the south-western sun.

Sleeping up to 10 guests, the estate comprises the main 3-bedroom house and an adjoining courtyard cottage, creating a flexible space for families or a group of friends. Inside, a warm kitchen with a central island and fireplace welcomes communal cooking and shared stories over wine. The traditional living and dining room brings everyone together, while upstairs, three ensuite bedrooms (sleeping 8) offer comfort and privacy. The adjoining courtyard house offers its own charm and independence, featuring a little kitchen and living-dining room, and a first-floor twin bedroom with its own bathroom.

Outside, the grounds invite both play and relaxation. Enjoy a match on your private tennis court, challenge each other to a game of table tennis or badminton, then cool off in the heated pool surrounded by a sun terrace and shaded seating area. Long, lazy lunches spill onto the dining terrace, where the barbecue sizzles and glasses clink into the evening.

Just over 4km away lies Eymet, a bustling bastide town with all the essentials: from boulangeries and café-bars to a farmers' market brimming with local produce. For wider adventures, riverside Bergerac is a short drive away with its medieval centre and excellent restaurants, while the Dordogne valley promises canoe trips, ancient caves, vineyards and fairytale castles.

Whether you're gathering with family or celebrating with friends, Château Cogulot offers an enriching retreat in one of France's most beloved regions.

### *Ground Floor (some steps)*

# Location & Local Information

Perched atop a gentle hill within seventeen hectares of private grounds, Château Cogulot offers a characterful base just 4.5km from the charming bastide town of Eymet.

Just a five-minute drive away, stroll Eymet's cobbled lanes, enjoy coffee under the plane trees and browse the local farmers' market bursting with regional fresh produce. With its welcoming café-bars, boulangeries, butchers and restaurants, Eymet provides all the essentials and then some, wrapped in quintessential Dordogne charm.

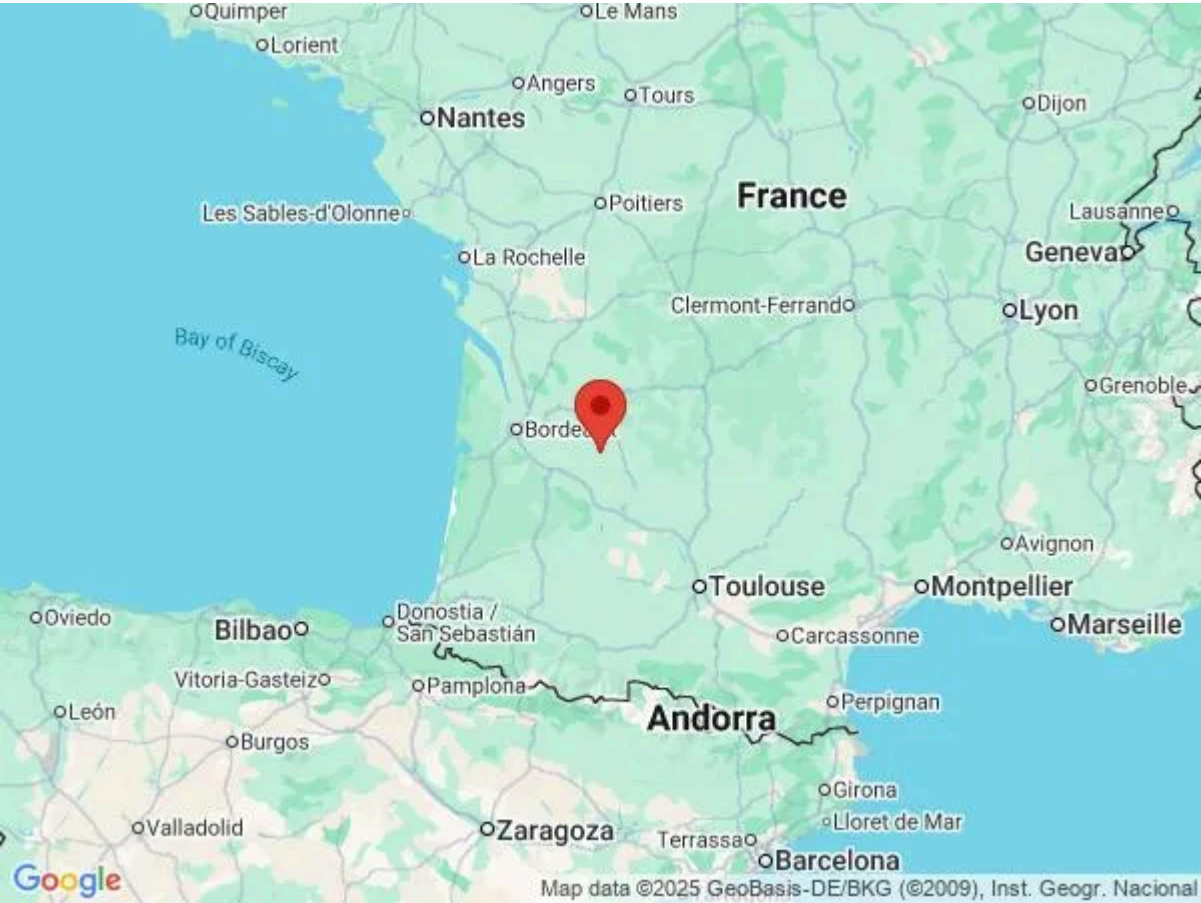
Only half an hour north, by the banks of the Dordogne River, Bergerac (30km) boasts a vibrant medieval centre with narrow streets lined with half-timbered buildings, an array of restaurants and lively squares. Stop by a riverside brasserie or stock up at the local hypermarket before exploring the surrounding wine country. Just a short drive away, the prestigious vineyards of Duras (17km) and Périgord Pourpre invite you to taste their celebrated vintages, while the renowned appellation of Saint-Émilion (60km) lies an hour north-west, the perfect day trip for lovers of history and wine alike.

The wider region is a haven for exploring bastide villages classified among France's Plus Beaux Villages. Discover the honey-stoned lanes of Monpazier (51km), the market charm of Issigeac (27km) or the hilltop beauty of Monflanquin (43km), all wonderfully preserved and steeped in medieval heritage. Sainte-Foy-la-Grande (30km), just across the Dordogne river, is famed for its Saturday market and pretty riverside setting, while Duras (17km) offers a fairytale château and panoramic views over rolling vineyards.

Outdoor adventures await throughout the Dordogne and Lot valleys, from scenic walks and cycling routes to canoeing along the river. And for culture seekers, the prehistoric cave paintings and troglodyte dwellings of the Vézère Valley lie within reach for a fascinating day out.
