

# Mas De La Rasclaouse

**Region:** Provence-Alpes **Sleeps:** 9

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## Overview

A tree-lined drive leads you into the heart of Mas de la Rasclaouse, a traditional Provençal mas set in private Provençal grounds. Surrounded by olive trees, a cherry orchard and swathes of summer lavender, the farmhouse blends rustic character with laid-back charm. As you step into the courtyard, soak up the slow rhythm of rural life in Provence, only 2km from hilltop Eygalières, one of the region's prettiest villages.

Inside, the mas retains its timeless appeal with warm stone walls, wood-beamed ceilings and light-filled living spaces. A piano rests in the salon for those inclined to play, while the adjoining library offers a quiet nook for reflection. The country kitchen opens directly onto the shaded terrace, perfect for leisurely lunches on warm summer days. Five bedrooms sit upstairs, offering simple comfort and views across the garden.

Outdoors, the grounds invite a slower pace. Cool off in the long swimming pool or challenge your companions to a match on the private tennis court. A boules court, table tennis and sauna offer moments of play and relaxation, while a pizza oven and barbecue promise convivial evenings under the stars. From cherry blossom in spring to the golden light of late summer, the gardens shift with the seasons and bring the best of Provence to your doorstep.

The mas lies just minutes from the captivating village of Eygalières, where cobbled lanes, welcoming cafés and a bustling Friday market capture the charm of southern France. Saint-Rémy-de-Provence, with its leafy boulevards and vibrant cultural life, is a short drive away, as are the Roman treasures of Arles, the dramatic rock village of Les Baux and the UNESCO World Heritage sites of Avignon.

Whether gathering with family or enjoying a traditional retreat, Mas de la Rasclaouse offers a sense of space and authenticity in one of Provence's most beloved corners.

# Location & Local Information

In the plains of Les Alpilles, Mas de la Rasclause offers a privileged location just 2km from the enchanting village of Eygalières. Surrounded by open countryside and framed by olive trees and lavender in its vast grounds, the property exudes rural charm with effortless access to some of Provence's most alluring destinations.

A leisurely 25-minute walk (following country roads, no pavements) or a very short drive leads to the heart of Eygalières, one of the region's most coveted villages, home to a traditional Friday morning market, lovely shops, welcoming café terraces and celebrated restaurants.

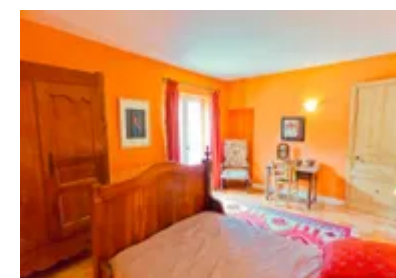
Just a little further afield, Saint-Rémy-de-Provence (13km) captures the very essence of Provençal vibrancy. Stroll beneath the shade of its plane trees, linger over lunch at one of the many stylish pavement cafés or explore the vibrant Wednesday market brimming with local produce and crafts.

The wider landscapes of Les Alpilles is equally captivating – a quintessential Provençal patchwork of vineyards, pine forests and timeless olive groves. For a step back in time, Les Baux-de-Provence (22km) reveals a dramatic medieval village hewn into rock, with spectacular views across the valley.

The Roman heritage of Arles (38km) awaits just over half an hour away. Discover its ancient amphitheatre, still alive with festivals and performances, or wander the tranquil cloisters of Saint-Trophime. Art lovers can follow in Van Gogh's footsteps, while foodies will delight in the bustling Arles markets held every Wednesday and Saturday – a sensory feast of olives, flowers, honey, and fragrant soaps. From here, the wilder landscapes of the Camargue beckon, where pink flamingos, white horses and black bulls roam freely. Horseback riding and birdwatching are popular ways to immerse in this unique biosphere.

A day trip to Avignon (28km) is a must for culture and history enthusiasts. The magnificent Palais des Papes dominates the skyline, and the famed Pont d'Avignon invites visitors to step into a living tableau of medieval grandeur.

For those seeking further Provençal charm, the nearby Luberon region unveils a rolling tapestry of perched villages such as Gordes (33km) and Ménerbes (30km) – perfect for lazy mornings, scenic walks and wine tastings among lavender-streaked hillsides.
