

Au Pont Du Gard

Overview

Au Pont du Gard is a stunning 7-bedroom villa in Gard, designed by a renowned architect and set in extensive private grounds with breathtaking views, including the famous Pont du Gard just 3 km away. The villa sleeps 14 guests comfortably and combines the highest level of interior design with a beautiful ambience both inside and out.

The spacious, fully equipped kitchen opens onto one of several dining terraces and the inviting swimming pool area. A large living room with a TV leads to another terrace with dining space overlooking the Pont du Gard. Additional highlights include a feature coffee bar stocked with a wide selection of teas and coffees, a conservatory-style seating area, and a high-ceiling hallway with a dining table.

The main house has two ensuite bedrooms on the ground floor and one more upstairs. Four further ensuite bedrooms are accessed externally, including one double and three poolside rooms. The private pool is surrounded by sun loungers and terraces with multiple dining and seating areas, including a heated bar, sauna, jacuzzi hot tub, table tennis, and darts.

Nearby, the local village offers restaurants, a café bar, and a newsagent, with more amenities and supermarkets in Remoulins. Avignon and Nîmes, both rich in history and culture, are within easy reach for day trips.

Location & Local Information

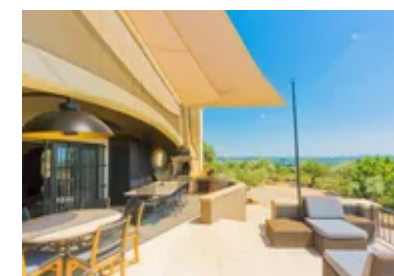
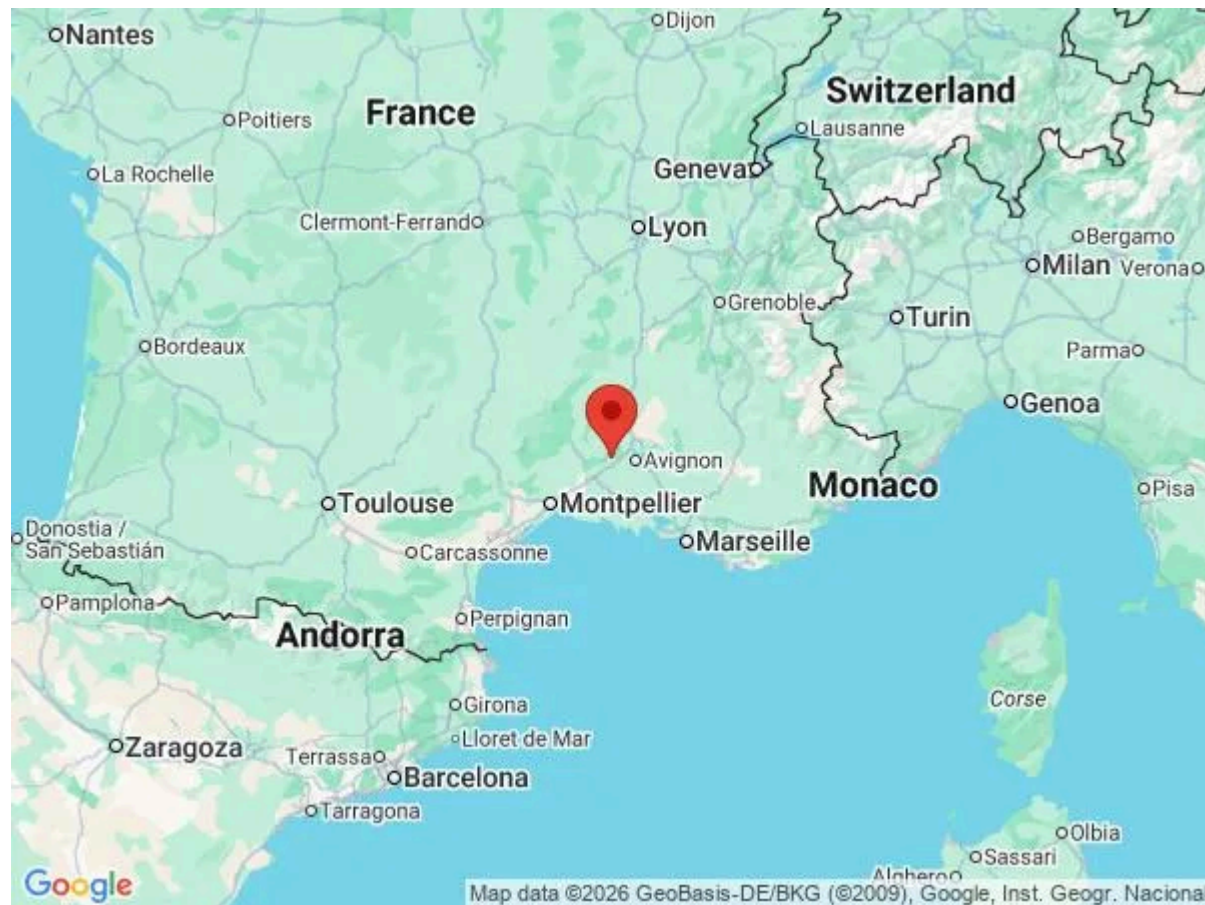
Au Pont du Gard is ideally situated in open countryside, offering direct views of the iconic Pont du Gard just 3 km away. This prime location provides easy access to a range of local amenities, including restaurants, a café bar, and a newsagent's in the nearby village. For additional shopping and dining options, the town of Remoulins is only 3 km away, featuring supermarkets and a wider selection of restaurants.

A visit to the Pont du Gard itself is a must, where you can explore this remarkable Roman aqueduct and enjoy the surrounding natural beauty. Within a short drive, two historic towns offer enriching day trips: Avignon, 30 minutes away, is renowned for its stunning Pope's Palace, the famous Half Bridge, and vibrant cultural scene with excellent shopping and events; Nîmes, 35 minutes away, boasts a spectacular Roman amphitheatre and numerous ancient sites.

For nature lovers, the nearby Camargue Regional Park is ideal for spotting wild white horses, black bulls, and flamingos. Nearby highlights also include the Roman town of Arles and the charming seaside town of Saintes-Maries-de-la-Mer. Local airports at Nîmes, Avignon, Montpellier, Béziers, Marseille, and Perpignan make the area accessible for international visitors.
