Overview

Maison Meunier is a beautifully renovated former miller's cottage set on an 18-acre estate in the rolling countryside of southern Dordogne. This charming two-bedroom villa sleeps up to five guests and offers a rural retreat with scenic views and easy access to nearby towns and amenities.

The single-storey property features a spacious living and dining room with a flat-screen TV, DVD player, and Wi-Fi. The interiors are comfortable and homely, with a fully equipped kitchen that includes a dishwasher and washing machine for added convenience. The sleeping arrangements consist of one double bedroom and a family room with three single beds, making it ideal for families. A modern family bathroom serves both bedrooms.

Outside, the villa enjoys a generous terrace with an outdoor dining area that overlooks the private swimming pool and surrounding countryside—perfect for relaxed summer evenings. The grounds are quiet and open, offering space to roam and unwind in nature.

Located on the edge of Saint-Front-sur-Lémance, the villa is just two minutes from Sauveterre for daily essentials, while the nearby towns of Fumel, Belvès, Beaumont, and Monflanquin provide a wider range of shops, restaurants, markets, and cultural attractions.

Location & Local Information

Maison Meunier is ideally situated on the edge of Saint-Front-sur-Lémance, in the southern Dordogne, a region renowned for its rolling countryside, medieval towns, and rich gastronomic heritage. The village has its own bakery, while nearby Sauveterre (just a 2-minute drive) offers further amenities. The towns of Fumel, Belvès, Beaumont, and Monflanquin provide excellent local markets, restaurants, and shops, all set within classic bastide architecture.

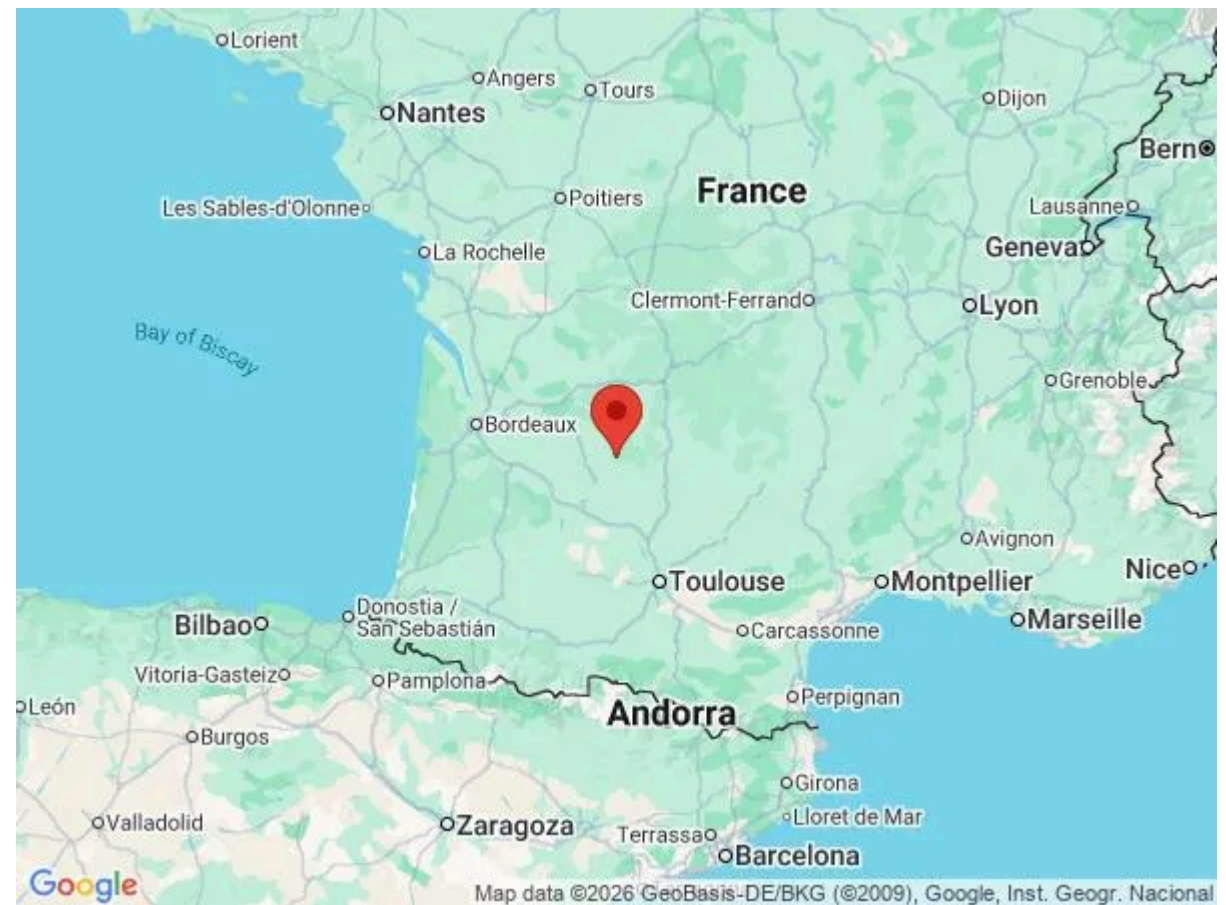
The Dordogne is a paradise for food lovers, famed for Périgordian specialities like foie gras, confit de canard, truffles, wild mushrooms, walnuts, and strawberries. Many vineyards welcome visitors to taste their wines along the scenic Route des Vins, particularly in the Bergerac area, just 50 minutes away.

The region is steeped in history and culture. Medieval towns like Sarlat-la-Canéda, Bergerac, and Monflanquin offer atmospheric lanes, local festivals, and vibrant markets. Nature lovers can explore the Dordogne river by canoe, especially from the beautiful village of La Roque-Gageac, or visit prehistoric cave sites near Les Eyzies and Lascaux. For Romanesque architecture, head to Carennac or Beaulieu-sur-Dordogne.

Maison Meunier offers the perfect base for discovering this enchanting region of France, where history, nature, food, and tradition blend seamlessly.
