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## Overview

Beyond surrounding hills and vineyards, Maison Papillon rests in idyllic seclusion, deep in the remote countryside. This contemporary country house, part of a prestigious working wine estate, offers a refined yet relaxed setting where nature, comfort and understated elegance converge. Set off a quiet lane, far away from the bustle of daily life, it is an exceptional home designed for gathering, unwinding and celebrating the good things in life.

Air-conditioned throughout, generous living spaces flow effortlessly between indoor and outdoor areas. The open-plan kitchen, with its dual fridge freezers, wine fridge and sleek central island, is perfect for relaxed meals or hosting with flair. Eight bedrooms, each with its own bathroom (most en suite), offer flexibility for families or groups, while the games room, TV lounge, sauna/hammam and private gym are all superb amenities.

Outdoors, Provençal living reaches its peak. The 16-metre private pool shimmers in the sun beside a spacious terrace lined with loungers, while the air-conditioned pool house with its summer kitchen and covered dining area sets the stage for long, convivial lunches or evening gatherings under the stars. A full barbecue setup, including a spit-roast, makes alfresco dining a true pleasure.

Daily housekeeping five times a week and a wine-tasting session at the nearby château are included, with a wide range of optional activities available, from yoga and lake picnics to sailing trips, horse riding and guided visits to Aix-en-Provence.

Tucked within a landscape of olive groves and vines, Maison Papillon lies just 14km from Brignoles, where you'll find shops, cafés and traditional Provençal markets. The beaches of Hyères and the shimmering Mediterranean are just over an hour away or spend time discovering picture-perfect villages and incredible scenery.

For those seeking privacy, style and a taste of authentic southern French living, Maison Papillon offers a richly rewarding escape where every detail has been carefully considered.

# Location & Local Information

Located away in the peaceful Var countryside, Maison Valescure sits along a quiet, private track within a hidden wine estate, surrounded by sweeping vineyard views. Just 3km from the domaine's main château, guests are invited to enjoy a wine tasting session as part of their stay. The wider area is dotted with renowned vineyards, making this a haven for wine enthusiasts.

Around 10km from the property lies the charming village of La Celle, a quintessential Provençal hamlet nestled along the banks of the Caramy River. Life here unfolds at a gentle pace, rooted in the rhythms of agriculture and nature. At its heart stands the impressive Abbaye de La Celle, a historic former Benedictine convent that was home to nuns for over five centuries. Adjacent to the abbey, the renowned Michelin-starred Hostellerie de l'Abbaye offers an exceptional dining experience, an ideal spot for a memorable meal in a truly atmospheric setting.

Only 14km away, the historic town of Brignoles offers essential amenities such as supermarkets, bakeries, cafés, and local restaurants. It's also the perfect gateway to the wider region. Outdoor lovers can lose themselves in the unspoilt beauty of the Sainte-Baume Natural Regional Park, where limestone cliffs and leafy trails invite walkers to explore the serene landscape. For a moment of quiet reflection, the forest-shrouded Abbaye du Thoronet (32km) offers a striking example of Cistercian architecture.

A little further on, the market towns of Lorgues (46km) and Vidauban (47km) are perfect for a slower pace, with lively market squares and more acclaimed wineries like Château Roubine and Château de Berne, both known for their excellent vintages. For something more active, head to the Argens River for kayaking or a riverside picnic.

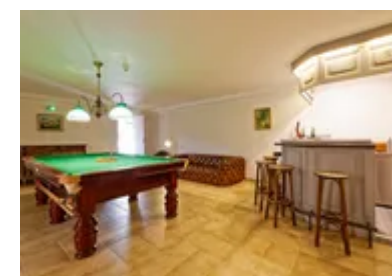
To the east, the striking silhouette of Montagne Sainte-Victoire, immortalised in Cézanne's paintings, leads to the cultured city of Aix-en-Provence (57km). Here, you can stroll cobblestone lanes, browse chic boutiques, and sip coffee beneath leafy plane trees in charming open-air cafés.

If you're in the mood for the sea, you'll find Saint-Tropez (77km), the charming harbour of Cassis (58km), and the golden beaches near Carqueiranne (48km) all reachable within 60 to 90 minutes by car.

Whether it's sampling fine wines, hiking through pine-covered hills, or exploring the vibrant Mediterranean coast, this secluded yet spectacular setting offers an ideal base for discovering the delights of this part of southern France.
