

Le Mas Feuille

Overview

Le Mas Feuille is a traditional country house that captures the beauty of the Dordogne countryside. From its lawned gardens and swimming pool to its views across the tree-lined valley, this detached home offers space and the gentle rhythms of rural living, all just moments from some of the region's most beloved towns and a short walk from the river.

Inside, the house is arranged for relaxed and sociable stays. The rustic yet impressive kitchen opens directly onto a shaded dining terrace, ideal for leisurely lunches or dinners under the stars. The main living area offers a comfortable retreat after a day of exploring, with Wi-Fi internet and doors leading straight out to the garden. Accommodation is spread over three levels, with two spacious double ensuite bedrooms on the first floor and two twin rooms with a shared family bathroom above, sleeping up to 8 guests in total.

Outside, the 12m long swimming pool is wonderful for long summer days. Table tennis, a barbecue and al-fresco dining area add to the outdoor lifestyle, making this an easy setting for quality time with family and friends with glorious countryside views.

Set in a prized location between the honey-stoned bastide of Domme and the vibrant medieval town of Sarlat-la-Canéda, the house places you at the heart of the Dordogne. Vitrac-Port, just a short walk away, offers riverside dining, swimming and canoeing on the Dordogne River. Within a short drive you'll find atmospheric castles, the famous gardens of Marqueyssac and villages like La Roque-Gageac with its rich heritage and traditional Gabarre boats.

Whether wandering the cobbled streets of Sarlat or enjoying a quiet morning coffee overlooking the valley, Le Mas Feuille promises an authentic escape where the pace slows and simple pleasures take centre stage.

Location & Local Information

Located between the charming hilltop village of Domme and the vibrant town of Sarlat-la-Canéda, Le Mas Feuille boasts an enviable position in the heart of the Dordogne. Surrounded by quintessential countryside, it offers effortless access to the region's most alluring sights where rich culture, river escapades and historic villages converge in perfect harmony.

A leisurely stroll leads to Vitrac-Port (500m) where the Dordogne River beckons with opportunities for swimming, paddling, or simply unwinding by the water's edge. This scenic riverside haven features a small beach, a seasonal canoeing, and a restaurant/snack-bar, ideal for sunny afternoons on or beside the water. Just five minutes away by car, the village of Cénac (6.5km) provides everyday essentials, including a small supermarket.

For those drawn to character and history, the fortified medieval town of Domme (4km) is within easy reach. Set high above the valley, its cobblestone lanes, sweeping vistas, and atmospheric eateries, wine cellars and artisan shops leave a lasting impression.


Follow the river further to discover the dramatic village of La Roque-Gageac (7km), clinging to the cliffs, or the magnificent château of Beynac-et-Cazenac (12km), both offering stunning scenery, traditional boat rides, and a window into the region's storied heritage. Nearby, the exquisite Jardins de Marqueyssac (10.5km) tempt the adventurous with cliffside walking paths and a scenic via ferrata experience overlooking the valley.

A 15-minute drive brings you to Sarlat-la-Canéda (9km), a true gem of the Périgord Noir. With its golden stone façades, lively markets and atmospheric alleys, this animated town is a sensory delight, brimming with fine dining, chic boutiques and bustling squares perfect for an aperitif and people-watching.

Whether you're gliding along the river, discovering medieval marvels or enjoying starry nights in rural surroundings, Le Mas Feuille places you at the centre of Dordogne's most unforgettable experiences.
