Set in the heart of the Dordogne, La Maison Bosquetere is a beautifully renovated country home that Périgord blends tradition with comfort. Surrounded by mature gardens and shaded by plane trees, this handsome stone house offers far-reaching views across the rolling countryside towards the iconic bastide of Domme.

Inside, the home retains its rustic soul, with beamed ceilings, exposed stone walls and generously proportioned rooms arranged across two floors. On the ground floor, a convivial kitchen opens onto a dining room and living area, an ideal space for both quiet evenings and family gatherings. Upstairs, four double bedrooms sleep up to 8 guests in comfort alongside three attractive bathrooms.

Outside, a pretty dining area invites long al-fresco meals, while the expansive lawn is perfect for games or lounging under the sun. The private pool, stretching 12 metres in length, is the centrepiece of outdoor life, framed by loungers and the sounds of birdsong with gorgeous rural views.

Perfectly placed between the golden-stone beauty of Domme and the medieval bustle of Sarlat-la-Canéda, the location offers access to some of the region's most cherished experiences. Stroll to the River Dordogne for swimming or seasonal canoeing from Vitrac-Port, just minutes away, or spend a day exploring cliffside villages, garden walks and hilltop castles. With restaurants, cafés and markets in easy reach, every day can begin with fresh croissants and end with a sunset glass of wine.

Whether you are looking to explore, unwind or simply reconnect with loved ones in a place of charm and calm, La Maison Bosquetere is the kind of home where summer memories naturally unfold.

## **Location & Local Information**

On a large country estate between the enchanting hilltop village of Domme and the lively market town of Sarlat-la-Canéda, La Maison Bosquetere enjoys a privileged location in the heart of the Dordogne. This idyllic setting places guests within minutes of the region's most captivating sights, blending authentic countryside with easy access to cultural gems, river adventures and timeless villages steeped in history.

Just a leisurely stroll away lies Vitrac-Port where the River Dordogne invites visitors to swim, paddle or simply relax along its banks. This picturesque spot offers a small beach, a riverside restaurant/snack bar and seasonal canoe hire, perfect for soaking in the summer sun or launching into a leisurely afternoon on the water. Meanwhile, the nearby village of Cénac, just a 5-minute drive, provides essential amenities including a small supermarket.

For lovers of heritage and charm, the medieval bastide town of Domme (4km) is also nearby. Perched high above the Dordogne Valley, its cobbled streets and panoramic views are as memorable as its quaint restaurants, wine outlets and artisan boutiques.

Further along the river, the cliffside village of La Roque-Gageac (7km) and the majestic château of Beynac-et-Cazenac (12km) offer breathtaking scenery, traditional boat trips and glimpses into the region's storied past. For those seeking a touch of adventure, the beautifully landscaped Jardins de Marqueyssac (10.5km) boast winding cliffside paths and a thrilling via ferrata overlooking the valley below.

A short 15-minute drive north leads to Sarlat-la-Canéda (9.5km), a jewel of the Périgord Noir. With its honey-hued stone buildings, bustling markets and atmospheric streets, this vibrant town is a feast for the senses. Here you'll find gourmet restaurants, boutique shopping and lively squares perfect for people-watching with a glass of local wine.

Whether it's canoeing along the river, exploring centuries-old castles, or unwinding beneath the stars, La Maison Bosquetere places you at the very heart of Dordogne's most iconic treasures.
