Region: Dordogne Sleeps: 10

Overview

Set in three hectares of private grounds, La Barde is a quintessentially French country home where tradition and space come together in timeless harmony. Dating back to the 18th century, this holiday abode blends historic character with the warmth of a much-loved family home.

Inside, the house retains its original charm. A beamed entrance hall sets the tone, leading to a welcoming farmhouse kitchen complete with a central island, rustic fireplace and dining table perfect for gathering over local delicacies. The living room is both spacious and comforting, offering Wi-Fi and a DVD collection for quieter evenings. Across three floors, five bedrooms, including three with en-suite bathrooms, offer flexible accommodation for families or groups of up to 11 guests.

Outdoors, the 13-metre private pool beckons on warm afternoons, with a shallow beach-style entry, diving board and a poolside terrace lined with loungers. A traditional open barn offers shaded dining with a plancha grill, barbecue and fridge, while a separate games barn comes complete with a table tennis setup and a rustic bar area for leisurely evenings.

La Barde lies just over 1km from the sleepy hilltop village of Lusignac, where a café-bar offers a taste of local life. Within five to ten minutes' drive, the villages of Saint-Séverin and Verteillac provide all essential amenities, while nearby Ribérac hosts cultural events and its famous Friday morning market. For broader explorations, the historic town of Périgueux is less than an hour away whilst the gorgeous villages of Aubeterre-sur-Dronne and Brantôme en Périgord are even closer.

Whether reading beneath the barn's timbered roof, cooling off in the pool or wandering through the wildflower meadow with a morning coffee in hand, La Barde invites a slower pace of life steeped in charm and comfort. A characterful base for reconnecting with family, nature and the rhythms of rural France.

Location & Local Information

Set in a little rural hamlet surrounded by open countryside in northern Dordogne, La Barde offers a picturesque escape just over 1km from the postcard-perfect village of Lusignac with its café-bar/restaurant.

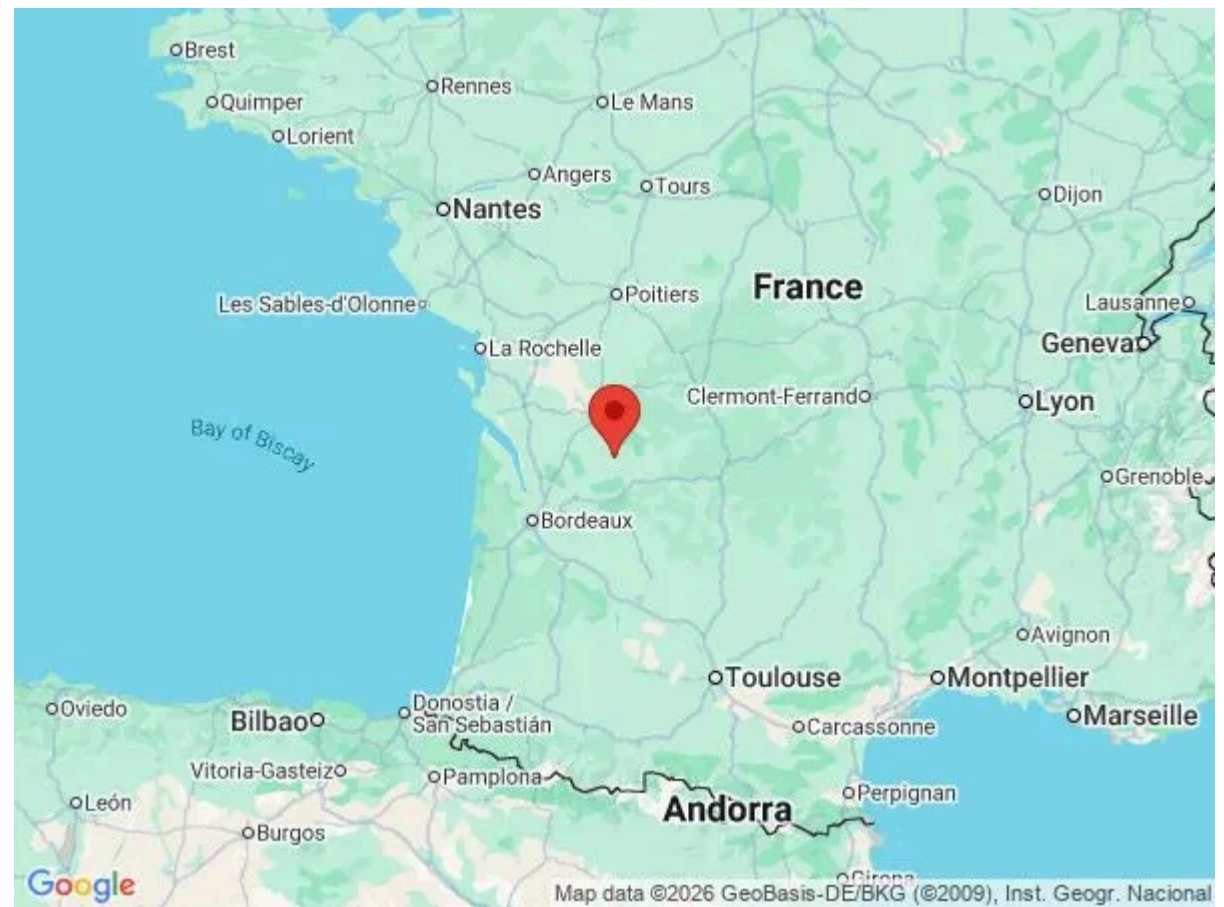
Within a five to ten-minute drive, the villages of Saint-Séverin (7km) and Verteillac (5km) provide all the essentials, from boulangeries and supermarkets to cafés and restaurants. Just 15 minutes away, the bustling town of Ribérac (11km) is known for its vibrant Friday morning market where stalls brim with seasonal produce, artisanal cheeses and local delicacies. Cultural events and a range of dining options make it a favourite spot to while away an afternoon.

Exploration beyond the local villages reveals a rich tapestry of history and beauty. The medieval village of Aubeterre-sur-Dronne (17km), perched above a river beach, enchants visitors with its monolithic church, good restaurants and galleries. In the other direction, the stately Château de Bourdeilles (25km) showcases Renaissance architecture and period furnishings, while the medieval town of Brantôme en Périgord, often called the “Venice of the Périgord” (34km), delights with its riverside abbey, canoeing adventures and vibrant market.

For those craving a deeper dive into Dordogne’s heritage, Périgueux (45km) is under an hour away and offers a wealth of Roman ruins, fine dining, and high-end shopping amid cobbled streets. Meanwhile, wine lovers can enjoy memorable day trips to the celebrated vineyards of Saint-Émilion (75km) or Bergerac (62km), both within easy reach for tastings and scenic strolls through vine-covered hills.
