

Villa Des Vignerons

Overview

Set amid the vineyards and open countryside of southern France, Villa des Vignerons is a beautifully restored former wine-maker's home, blending rustic charm with modern comfort. Surrounded by 12 acres of private land and commanding authentic views across the rolling countryside, this is a place where the rhythms of rural life unfold at a gentler pace.

Inside, the villa feels welcoming, spacious and stylish. The heart of the home is a bright, contemporary kitchen, complete with central island, wine fridge and doors opening out to a split-level terrace, perfect for long lunches and al-fresco dinners. The adjacent living and dining rooms showcase the home's winemaking legacy, with exposed beams, wood-burning stoves and original wine vats lending character to every corner. Families are especially well-catered for, with a cheerful children's bedroom featuring two sets of bunk beds, and a generous selection of books, board games and toys.

Upstairs, four thoughtfully designed bedrooms offer a restful retreat, including a king-size master with ensuite bathroom. Outside, days unfold between the front garden's swimming pool and hammock whilst there is plenty to keep all ages entertained with croquet, boules, badminton and table tennis.

Located just 15 minutes from the pretty market town of Limoux and only 40 minutes from the medieval citadel of Carcassonne, the holiday home makes a wonderful base for exploring the Languedoc's wine routes and heritage villages. Local shops, a bakery and a café-bar can be found in nearby Belvèze-du-Razès, while the region's open roads and vineyard trails beckon with endless opportunities for discovery.

Whether gathering with friends or holidaying with family, Villa des Vignerons offers an authentic slice of southern French life in the Aude countryside.

Location & Local Information

Set amid rolling vineyards and open countryside in southern France, Villa des Vignerons enjoys a glorious setting just 15 minutes from the bustling market town of Limoux and 40 minutes from the fairytale citadel of Carcassonne. Surrounded by sweeping views, this is a fantastic base for exploring the region's celebrated history, culture and natural beauty.


The house is just off the main road heading north towards the small village of Belvèze-du-Razès (6km) where you will find all your daily essentials, including a bakery for fresh morning croissants, a café bar, a grocery store and a butcher. Head south-east into Limoux (14km) for a wider selection of shops, restaurants and a vibrant local atmosphere - don't miss the lively weekly market and a tasting of the town's signature sparkling wine, Blanquette de Limoux.

Day trips offer a wealth of discovery, from the medieval bastide town of Mirepoix (23km), especially enchanting on Monday mornings during its colourful market, to the majestic ramparts of Carcassonne (36km), where you can wander cobbled streets, dine al fresco, or join a guided tour of the historic castle. The nearby Canal du Midi offers gentle walking and cycling paths as well as boat hire – join the towpaths in towns like Bram (22km), Castelnau-d'Oléron (34km) and Carcassonne, an ideal way to soak in the tranquil scenery at a leisurely pace.

Wine lovers are perfectly placed to explore the vineyards of the Razès and surrounding regions, with local domaines offering intimate tastings and vineyard tours that reveal the character and craft of Languedoc wines. For a change of scenery, head north to Revel (56km) for its acclaimed Saturday market, then unwind beside the waters of the Bassin de Saint-Ferréol (54km), where summer brings opportunities for swimming, paddleboarding, or simply enjoying a lakeside picnic with views over the forested slopes of the Montagne Noire.
