

# Le Pigeonnier Jean Blanc

Region: Dordogne Sleeps: 4

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## Overview

Surrounded by glorious fields, sometimes golden with sunflowers, Le Pigeonnier Jean Blanc offers a rare chance to stay in an original pigeonier tower, sensitively restored for up to 4 guests with its own gorgeous swimming pool.

Inside, the pigeonier reveals an open-plan living and dining space with exposed stone walls, timber accents and old French doors leading directly onto the garden terrace. The kitchen is well equipped with everything you need for relaxed, self-catered dining, while the adjoining lounge provides a welcoming space to unwind. A twin bedroom opens directly to the garden, ideal for easy outdoor living, while a narrow spiral staircase leads to the first-floor double bedroom tucked beneath the tower's original beams. A shower room can also be found upstairs.

Step outside to dine al fresco on the terrace with elevated views across the countryside and the scent of summer herbs drifting from the barbecue. The private pool invites hours of basking in the sunshine, framed by open skies and the gentle rustle of nearby trees. With eight hectares of grounds including fields and woodland, there's ample space to roam, read or simply do nothing at all.

Just 6km away lies the bastide town of Monflanquin, perched high on a hill and offering panoramic views, excellent restaurants, bakeries and a bustling weekly market. Further afield, Villereal and Bergerac provide even more to explore, from local food specialities and antique markets to scenic boat trips on the Dordogne River.

Whether you're here for the quiet beauty of the Lot-et-Garonne countryside, the rich flavours of the Périgord or simply a taste of rural French life, Le Pigeonnier Jean Blanc offers a stay that's both restorative and full of character.

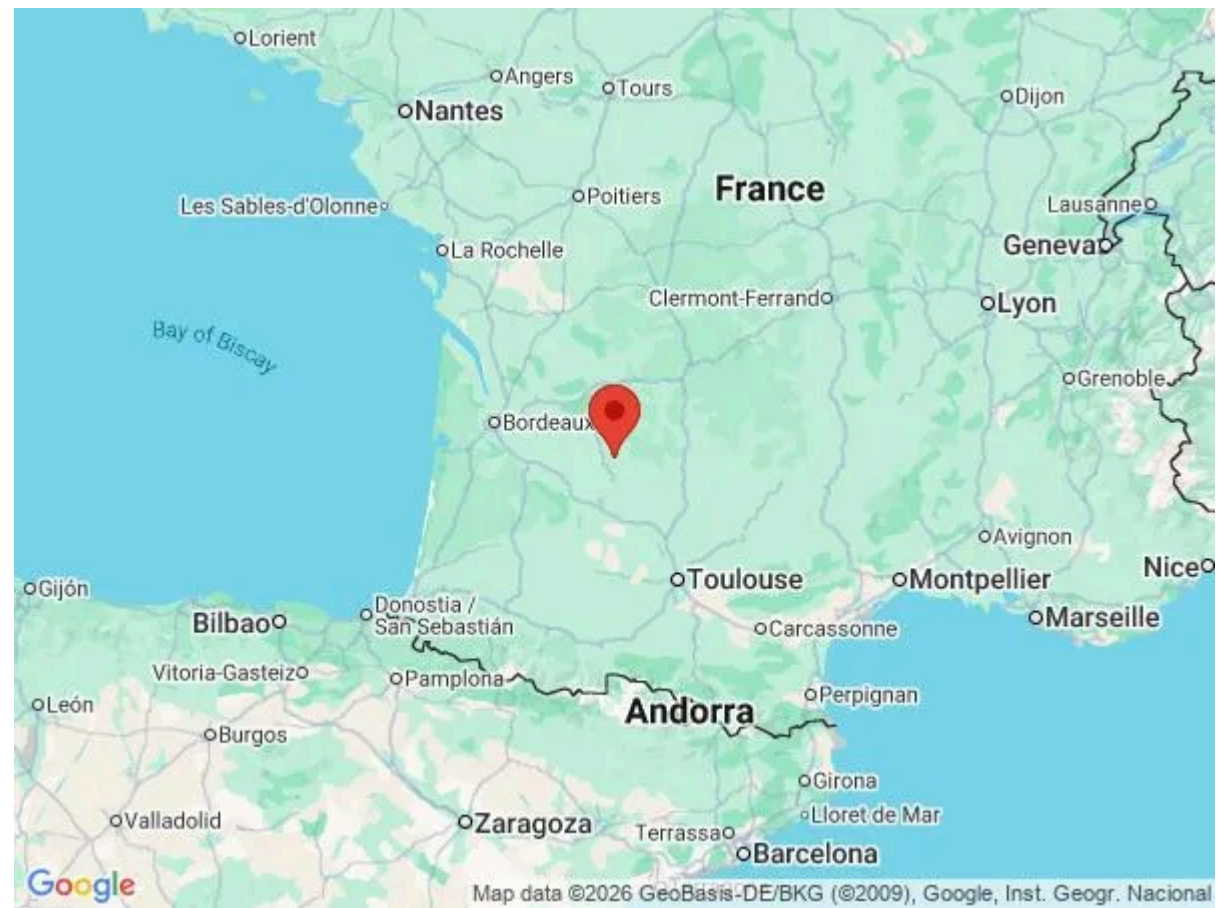
# Location & Local Information

In the beautiful open countryside just 6km from the enchanting bastide town of Monflanquin, Le Pigeonnier Jean Blanc offers a rural escape in one of France's most celebrated regions. The location is one of secluded charm, where meadows and woodlands give way to sweeping vistas and bright skies. Yet, you're within easy reach of some of south-west France's most iconic destinations, with Bergerac and its international airport only 50 minutes away.

Nearby Monflanquin is a jewel of the Lot-et-Garonne – a medieval hilltop village with winding lanes, commanding views and a classic bastide square. Enjoy its vibrant Thursday morning market, browse local shops and cafés, or linger over a meal in one of its traditional restaurants. Just 10km away, the pretty town of Villereal offers even more in the way of shops, markets and eateries, while Monpazier – a perfect bastide – lies within easy driving distance and is a must for lovers of history and architecture.

For nature and water-lovers, the Dordogne River beckons. Head north to the pretty villages of Limeuil (48km), La Roque-Gageac (62km) or Lalinde (39km) and look out for boat cruises and canoeing opportunities. Bergerac (43km), once a thriving wine port, makes for a charming day out. Stroll its historic centre, admire the half-timbered houses and take a boat trip or hop aboard the petit train for a tour through the old town. You might pause en route in Issigeac (25km), a captivating medieval village known for its Sunday market and artistic soul.

To the south, the Lot Valley unfolds with timeless appeal. Discover the flower-filled village of Pujols (31km), the lively streets of Villeneuve-sur-Lot (23km) or venture further to Cahors (74km), famed for its deep red wines and 14th-century Valentré Bridge. Historic Agen (52km), meanwhile, offers a dose of urban culture, shopping and its signature prunes.
