Overview

Just moments from the medieval heart of Sarlat-la-Canéda, Maison des Cordeliers is a rare and delightful find in one of the Dordogne's most enchanting towns. Surrounded by mature trees and a private garden, this charming detached house offers an idyllic haven with the luxury of a private pool, all within a short stroll of the town's lively squares, famous markets and celebrated restaurants.

Inside, the characterful house is welcoming and thoughtfully arranged across two floors, designed for comfort and easy living. The open-plan living and dining space is cosy and practical, with satellite TV, Wi-Fi and direct access to shaded terrace near the pool. A fully equipped kitchen opens to the rear garden, while three ensuite bedrooms (two with air-conditioning) ensure privacy and rest for families or small groups.

Outside, summer living comes into its own. The shaded dining terrace sits near the sparkling swimming pool, where loungers await sunny afternoons. At the end of a long driveway, it's hard to believe that one of the Périgord Noir's most famous towns is just minutes away on foot.

Indeed, the location in Sarlat-la-Canéda is hard to beat. Known as the jewel of the Périgord Noir, Sarlat is a town of honey-coloured stone and winding medieval alleys, home to one of France's most vibrant markets and a rich gastronomic heritage.

Within a short drive, guests can explore the extraordinary cave art of Lascaux, paddle down the Dordogne by canoe, or visit hilltop castles and iconic riverside villages like La Roque-Gageac, Domme and Beynac.

Perfect for those seeking authentic charm, Maison des Cordeliers offers a rare opportunity to stay in Sarlat-la-Canéda while enjoying the space and privacy of a lovely holiday home.

Location & Local Information

Located off a small road and at the end of your driveway, Maison des Cordeliers is just a short walk from Sarlat-la-Canéda's enchanting medieval heart. Indeed, this location is a rare find and places you at the centre of one of France's most beautiful and historically rich regions.

Less than a 10-minute stroll brings you to cobbled pedestrian streets, bustling markets and atmospheric cafés spilling out onto bustling squares. Life in this famous town moves at an unhurried pace - perfect for sampling the renowned Périgord cuisine, browsing boutiques or simply soaking in the town's timeless charm. As the many tourists head home, it's a pleasure to be able to stroll back to your characterful Dordogne holiday abode.

Sarlat-la-Canéda is not only a jewel in its own right but also a gateway to the stunning landscapes and heritage of the Périgord Noir. Flanked by the rivers Dordogne and Vézère, it offers easy access to majestic valleys and iconic villages such as Beynac-et-Cazenac (12km), La Roque-Gageac (14km) and Domme (13km) – each a postcard-perfect destination crowned by cliff-top castles or nestled into dramatic limestone cliffs. Canoeing along the Dordogne is an unforgettable way to take in the scenery with various bases along the river.

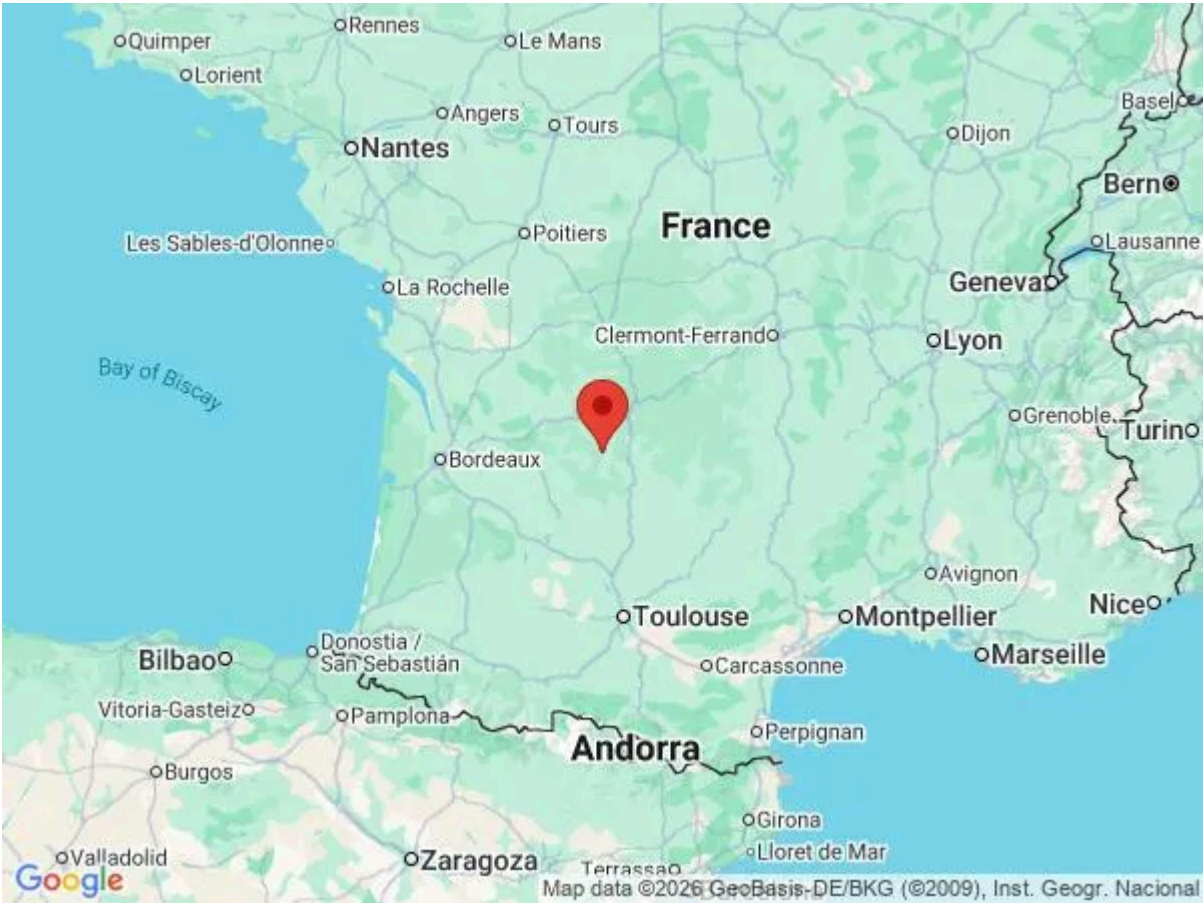
For those drawn to prehistory, the Vézère Valley beckons with wonders dating back tens of thousands of years. Les Eyzies (20km), often called the "Capital of Prehistory", is home to extraordinary cave complexes and archaeological treasures. A visit to the world-famous Lascaux caves (26km), with their astonishing 17,000-year-old paintings, offers a powerful glimpse into the dawn of human creativity and expression.

Outdoor adventures abound for those seeking active pursuits. Golfers are well catered for, with several courses nearby including Golf de Rochebois just 15 minutes away. Thrill-seekers can take to the skies with hot air balloon rides or light aircraft flights from the Sarlat-Domme aerodrome, enjoying panoramic views over the rolling countryside and winding rivers.

Whether you're exploring ancient caves, paddling past medieval villages or dining under the stars in Sarlat's old town, this is a region that never stops inspiring. With supermarkets, restaurants, and shops close at hand, and the very best of the Dordogne just beyond, this is an exceptional base for your French escape.
