Overview

Set in the authentic heart of Raissac-d'Aude, La Maison des Hirondelles offers a delightful getaway where village charm meets contemporary comfort. This fully renovated home reveals itself behind a modest façade, opening into light-filled, air-conditioned interiors with exposed stone walls, original beams and thoughtful modern touches that make every stay effortlessly enjoyable.

Upstairs, a spacious open-plan living area invites sociable cooking, dining and relaxing, with a stylish kitchen, cosy seating and a smart blend of rustic and refined finishes. Two simply but pretty double bedrooms, both air-conditioned, promise restful nights, while the bathroom's walk-in shower adds to the contemporary flair. For families, a third single bed in one of the rooms offers flexibility without compromising on style or space.

Outside, a lawned garden and shaded dining terrace set the scene for leisurely lunches and balmy evening barbecues. The terrace's summer kitchen, complete with plancha, fridge and coffee machine, makes outdoor dining a pleasure. The private pool, surrounded by loungers, offers the perfect spot to cool off or unwind after a day out exploring, and table tennis provides a dose of playful energy.

Ideally placed, the house is just a stroll from the small village shop, with further amenities a short drive away in nearby Canet and Lézignan-Corbières. Historic Narbonne lies just 15 minutes away, offering vibrant markets, excellent dining and cultural sites to explore.

For beach days, the Mediterranean's golden sands await just 40 minutes away at Narbonne Plage. Other wonderful days out include the storied ramparts of Carcassonne, the salt flats and stilt houses of Gruissan Plage, endless Languedoc vineyards and gardens of Fontfroide Abbey.

Whether you're planning lazy days in the garden, coastal adventures or discovering the treasures of the Aude, La Maison des Hirondelles is a superb village house for enjoying it all with ease and style.

Location & Local Information

La Maison des Hirondelles is located in the authentic village of Raissac-d'Aude, a charming base for exploring one of southern France's most captivating regions within easy reach of vineyards, historic towns and the Mediterranean coast.

In Raissac-d'Aude itself, a small grocery shop makes it easy to pick up basic essentials, while nearby Canet (2km) offers a bakery, butcher, bar and a handful of local amenities including a pizzeria and pharmacy. Another short drive brings you to the small wine town of Lézignan-Corbières (12km), where supermarkets, restaurants and a lively Wednesday morning market create a welcoming local hub – this is the capital of the Corbières wine region.

Indeed, wine lovers and nature seekers alike will be enchanted by the surrounding Corbières vineyards and traditional wine villages. Don't miss a visit to the majestic Fontfroide Abbey (17km) where landscaped Italian gardens and onsite wine production add depth to this remarkable National Heritage site.

For coastal charm, Gruissan's stilted "Betty Blue" beach houses, salt marshes and seaside restaurants are a 30-minute drive from your doorstep, while the sandy stretches of Narbonne Plage beckon just 35km away.


Culture and history abound nearby – explore Narbonne's Roman past, vibrant markets, and museums around 20 minutes away by car, or head to Béziers (45km) for canal strolls, cathedral views and its renowned flower market on Fridays. The tranquil banks of the Canal du Midi offer delightful opportunities for walking, boating and cycle rides.

If you can find the time, a day trip to the medieval fortress city of Carcassonne (50km) is another must. Wander its cobbled lanes, dine in traditional restaurants or soak in one of its many cultural events at one of France's most visited destinations.
