

Chateau Du Marquisat

Region: Languedoc **Sleeps:** 10

Overview

Set amid 60 hectares of Languedoc vines and close to the Canal du Midi, Château du Marquisat is a rare Art Deco jewel offering a refined yet welcoming retreat within a wine estate. Built in the 1920s and exuding all the charm of its heritage, this beautifully preserved French château invites guests into a world of timeless elegance, with every modern comfort discreetly woven into its graceful design.

From the moment you ascend the stone steps to its stately terrace, you are greeted by a sense of grandeur balanced by warmth and authenticity. Inside, generous rooms flow across three storeys, where high ceilings, gorgeous flooring and vintage furnishings set the tone. Five spacious bedrooms and four bathrooms provide comfort and privacy for groups of up to 10 guests. The main floor is designed for convivial living, with a smartly equipped kitchen, formal dining room and an elegant salon opening onto the terrace. Air-conditioning throughout ensures year-round comfort, while thoughtful touches like Smart TV, a sound system and table football add a relaxed, family-friendly feel.

Outside, the château's grounds unfold in a series of serene and playful spaces. The private pool, framed by a sun terrace and superb summer kitchen, is the centrepiece of long, lazy afternoons. Meals can be savoured al-fresco beneath the shade, followed by a round of boules or a table tennis match. The tranquil fountain with koi carp adds to the allure of the handsome grounds.

Perfectly positioned between the pretty villages of Homps and Olonzac, Château du Marquisat places you within easy reach of markets, bakeries, cafés and the shimmering waters of Lac de Jouarres. The tree-lined Canal du Midi is just 3km away, ideal for gentle strolls or bike rides. Carcassonne, with its iconic citadel and summer festivals, lies only 35 minutes to the west whilst the Mediterranean shores of Narbonne Plage can be reached in less than an hour.

Whether sipping wine overlooking the vines, exploring the medieval wonders of the region or simply gathering with loved ones in a setting of understated luxury, Château du Marquisat invites you to experience the very best of southern France in unforgettable style.

Château Interiors

Main Level

- Main entrance (via steps)
- Living room with leather sofa, armchairs, Smart TV, Wi-Fi, sound system and table football. Doors opening to terrace
- Open dining area with doors opening to terrace
- Kitchen, well-equipped including gas hob, oven, microwave, dishwasher and American-style fridge-freezer, leading through to conservatory with breakfast table and courtyard access
- 2 x WCs with sink
- Utility room with sink, washing machine and dryer

First Floor

- Bedroom 1 with double bed, door to two balconies and ensuite bathroom with walk-in shower and sink
- Separate WC
- Bedroom 2 with two single beds and door to balcony
- Jack and Jill bathroom (between Bedrooms 2 and 3) with WC, bath and twin sinks
- Bedroom 3 with double bed and doors to balcony

Second Floor

- Bedroom 4 with double bed, small double bed (for one person) and door to balcony. Ensuite shower room with walk-in shower and twin sinks

Location & Local Information

Set within a 60-hectare working wine estate between the charming villages of Homps and Olonzac, this beautiful location places you in the heart of the Minervois, just 36km from the fairy-tale citadel of Carcassonne. With views across rolling vineyards and easy access to some of southern France's most captivating villages and towns, it's an ideal base for discovering the beauty, culture, gastronomy and wine of the Languedoc region.

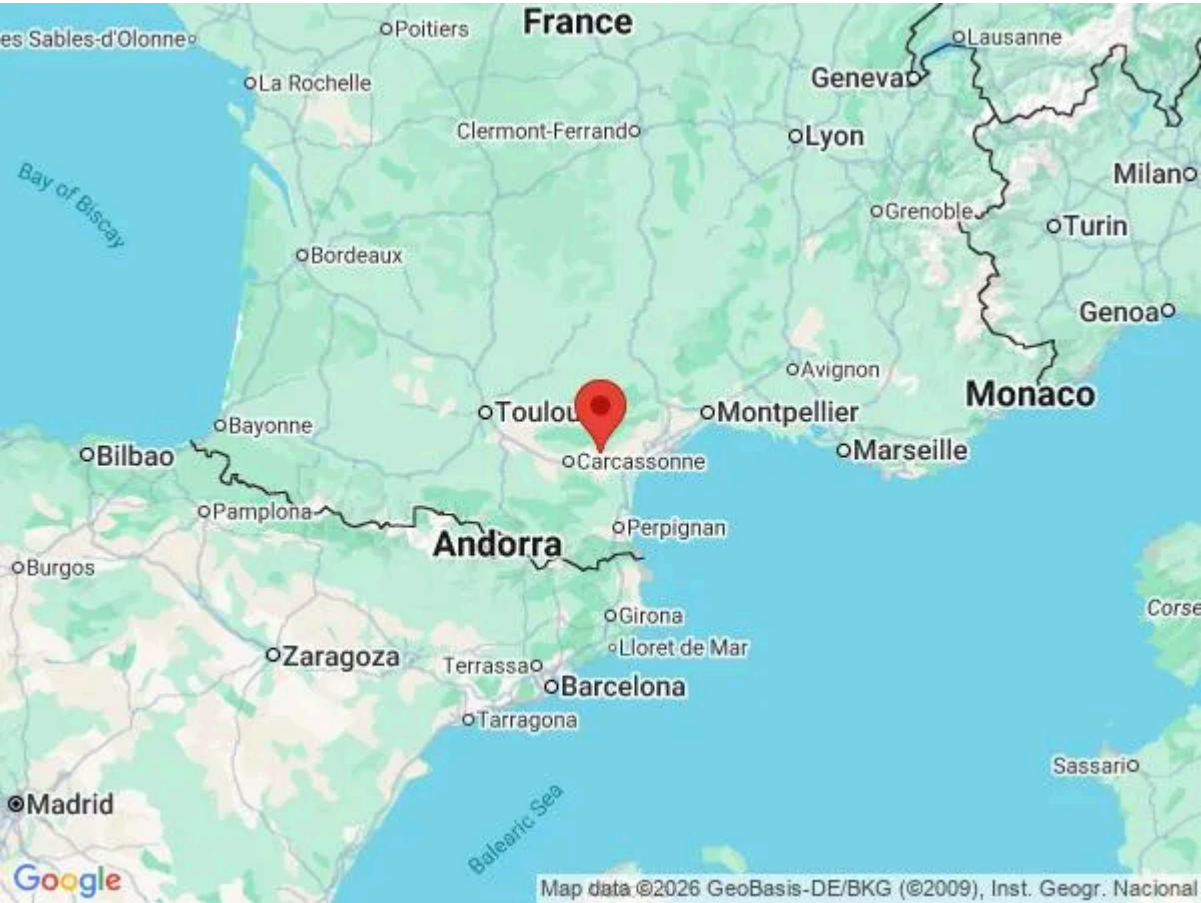
Less than 3km away, Homps is a delightful canal-side village with restaurants, cafés and a wine shop perfect for sampling local vintages. The nearby Canal du Midi, a UNESCO World Heritage site, invites leisurely walks or boat trips beneath its iconic plane trees, while bikes can be hired to cycle to other local canal-side villages and sights. Only 900m from the château lies Lac de Jouarres, a popular spot with its lakeside beach, snack bar and water-based activities in the height of the summer.

Olonzac, the 'capital of the Minervois', is just 3km away, home to bakeries, shops, a supermarket and its bustling Tuesday morning market. For those keen to sample the region's winemaking heritage, tastings at family-run domaines and larger châteaux are easily arranged in the surrounding countryside. History lovers will find the ancient hilltop village of Minerve (12km) a rewarding trip, with its dramatic gorge setting and links to the Cathar past.

For more extensive days out, Carcassonne's medieval ramparts and summer festivals offer something for all ages, while Narbonne (30km), with its Roman heritage, vibrant covered market and laid-back canal promenades, is also within easy reach. Sunseekers can continue to Narbonne Plage (50km) for golden sands and Mediterranean views. Alternatively, Béziers (47km), one of France's oldest cities, enchants with its cathedral, flower markets and summer festivities.
