

Le Moulin De Taron

Region: Midi-Pyrenees **Sleeps:** 6

Overview

Along a stretch of open countryside where rolling fields reach toward the horizon, Le Moulin de Taron is a sensitively restored former mill that offers a true escape from the everyday.

Inside, original features such as exposed beams and thick stone walls speak to the building's storied past. The ground floor flows between the lounge and the split-level kitchen and dining area, where a preserved millstone serves as a striking centrepiece. Natural textures and thoughtful details ground the home in its rural setting, while modern comforts like Wi-Fi and Smart TV ensure a relaxed, connected stay. French doors open to the terrace, where long summer lunches stretch into the afternoon. Upstairs, three cosy double bedrooms, including one with an en-suite, accommodate up to 6 guests with warmth and ease.

Outdoors, the generous garden merges with the surrounding meadows, creating an uninterrupted connection with nature. The private pool sits beside a sun-drenched deck and terrace, framed by loungers perfect for idle days.

The nearby bastide town of Garlin, just 8km away, is rich in heritage and provides everything from fresh bread in the morning to relaxed evening dining. Head to Eugénie-les-Bains for Michelin starred dining or stay slightly closer to home for wine-tasting, glorious walks, cycle rides and pottering around historic rural villages and towns such as Lembeye, Arzacq and Morlaàs.

The region's natural charm is matched by its access to larger destinations: the handsome town of Pau is within half an hour, while Biarritz and the Atlantic coast are easily reached for memorable day trips.

Back home, Le Moulin de Taron invites you to slow down, reconnect and savour a simpler pace of life in a timeless corner of rural France.

Location & Local Information

Amid the rolling hills of the Coteaux Béarn Madiran region, this area offers a picturesque escape into the heart of south-west France. Here you are surrounded by verdant countryside and charming rural villages, where the pace of life is delightfully unhurried. Set just off a country road, Le Moulin de Taron is just over 1km from a little hamlet with an impressive church and 8km from the lively town of Garlin.

Garlin itself is a welcoming bastide town with a well-stocked supermarket, bakery, bank, café bars and restaurants. Situated between the beautiful city of Pau and Bordeaux's famed wine country, it serves as the perfect base for exploring the region. It is rich in heritage, dating back to the 1300s and hosts a market on a Wednesday morning (every two weeks) showcasing local specialities.

Food lovers will be drawn to Eugénie-les-Bains (27km), home to a celebrated three Michelin-starred restaurant and a luxurious spa retreat. Meanwhile, nearby villages such as Lembeye (19km) and Arzacq-Arraziguet (22km) are ideal for leisurely mornings wandering markets, sampling local produce and discovering traditional Béarnaise architecture.


Wine enthusiasts will be in their element here, with the Madiran and Pacherenc vineyards offering tastings and tours throughout the region. Outdoor pursuits abound, from gentle country walks and cycling routes through sunflower fields.

Pau (36km) is a beautiful town rich in heritage and charm, with its elegant boulevards, château and panoramic views of the Pyrenees – not to mention a vibrant dining and shopping scene.

For those keen to explore further afield, day trips to Lourdes (55km), Tarbes (50km) and Orthez (60km) promise historical treasures and local character in abundance. And if you fancy a taste of the Atlantic, the golden beaches of Biarritz and Hossegor are just 90 minutes away – perfect for a coastal escape of surfing, seafood and sea air.
