

Villa Du Chateau

Overview

Beneath the imposing silhouette of the medieval Château de Duras, Villa du Château offers a rare chance to stay in the historic heart of south-west France, where centuries-old architecture meets laid-back countryside charm. With its vaulted ceilings, old staircases, exposed stone and undulating views over the hills from the upper terrace, this characterful 6-bedroom home exudes warmth, space and personality, inviting guests to enjoy the rhythm of rural French town life.

At the heart of the house, the wood-beamed lounge flows onto a raised terrace, perfect for long al-fresco lunches overlooking the Lot-et-Garonne landscapes. Inside, spacious living areas and six charming air-conditioned bedrooms, four of them with en-suite bathrooms, create the ideal layout for up to 14 guests.

Outside, guests are drawn to the large garden dotted with cypress trees and centred around the 12-metre swimming pool. A shaded summer kitchen with gas barbecue, table tennis and relaxed dining space makes summer living feel effortless from morning coffee to sunset aperitifs.

Step out and you're soon in the heart of Duras, a vibrant village just five minutes on foot, where boulangeries, cafés and wine bars spill onto cobbled streets. Wander the weekly market, stock up on local delicacies, or sample regional wines from surrounding vineyards, including Saint-Émilion, Monbazillac and Sauternes. For those seeking day trips, the Dordogne Valley is within easy reach, offering world-famous prehistoric caves, cliffside dwellings and beautifully preserved bastide towns.

For those who enjoy history, local flavours and a house with true character, Villa du Château is an inviting base for unforgettable holidays.

House Interiors

- Living-dining room with sofas, Smart TV, WI-Fi and table with benches.
- Doors open to the courtyard and elevated dining terrace
- Kitchen with island and table, well-equipped including oven, microwave, fridge-freezer, Nespresso machine and dishwasher. Doors open to courtyard
- Bedroom 1 with double bed, air-conditioning, courtyard access and open-plan ensuite bathroom with WC, bath/shower and sink
- Bedroom 2 with double bed, air-conditioning and ensuite bathroom with WC, shower, sink and washing machine

First Floor (via partially open-sided staircase)

- Bedroom 3 with two single beds (or double) and air-conditioning

Location & Local Information

In the Lot-et-Garonne countryside, the charming town of Duras offers the quintessential French escape, only a 40-minute drive from Bergerac Airport.

Just a short stroll from the heart of the village, guests will find all essential amenities – from a traditional boulangerie and welcoming cafés to a butcher, pharmacy and grocery store. The neighbouring Château de Duras stands as the village’s crown jewel, a majestic 12th-century fortress that tells tales of centuries past. Wine lovers won’t want to miss the nearby Maison des Vins, celebrating the region’s exceptional vintages. Come summer, the cobbled streets come alive with night markets, live music, and al fresco feasting under the stars.

The rolling countryside surrounding Duras is sprinkled with characterful bastide towns like Monségur (9km) and Eymet (20km), known for their lively weekly markets and pretty squares lined with arcaded buildings and cafés. Explore antique stalls, savour artisan goods, or simply enjoy a slow lunch in the sun.

Venture a little further and you'll find medieval gems like Issigeac (43km) and Monpazier (66km), two of the Dordogne’s best-preserved fortified villages. Their narrow, flower-filled lanes and half-timbered houses invite leisurely discovery, especially on bustling market days.

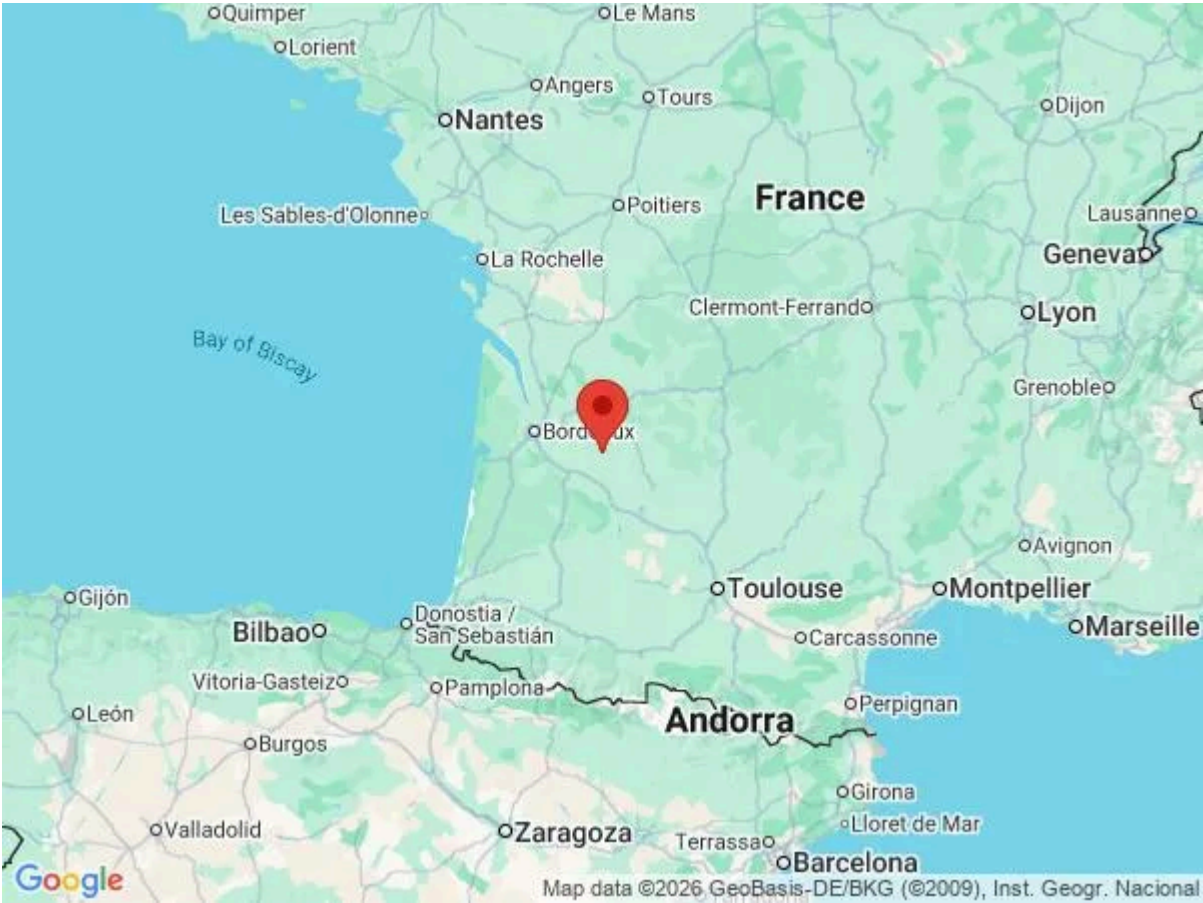
Sainte-Foy-la-Grande (22km), perched on the Dordogne River, is famed for its vibrant Saturday market, while the historic town of Bergerac (40km) draws visitors with its old quarter, antique fairs and Monbazillac wines.

For a truly special day out, a visit to Saint-Émilion (44km) is a must. This historic hilltop village is a feast for the senses – a labyrinth of limestone lanes, grand wine châteaux and atmospheric cellars offering some of the finest tastings in the world, surrounded by UNESCO-listed vineyards known across the world.

With its relaxed pace, cultural richness and proximity to Bordeaux and the Atlantic coast for yet more superb day trips (Arcachon is around two hours by car), Duras is not only a destination in its own right but also a gateway to some of southwest France’s most captivating sights.

- If planning to stay in mid-July, please note that a loud techno music festival usually takes place at the castle next door each year around 14th July (with fireworks and celebrations).
- Even though you can walk to the centre of Duras, a car is essential to be able to fully explore the surrounding region.
