Overview

Surrounded by open fields on a quiet country lane, Mas des Rivailles sits within expansive private grounds, offering the space and calm of rural living with modern comforts woven effortlessly throughout. This contemporary take on a traditional farmhouse is made for relaxed summer days and sociable evenings under the stars.

Inside, the interiors are modern and welcoming. The open-plan kitchen, dining and living areas are bright and spacious, with wide doors spilling out onto the garden and terraces. Every detail feels thoughtfully considered, from the sleek central island and dual ovens in the kitchen to the sofas and entertainment options that include Wi-Fi, TV and DVDs. Upstairs, three serene bedrooms sleep up to six guests in comfort, with an ensuite bathroom and shared shower room offering flexibility for families or small groups.

The outdoor lifestyle takes centre stage here. At the heart of the garden lies a generous 16-metre heated pool with a sun-soaked terrace and loungers for unwinding beside the water. Children will be endlessly entertained with a dedicated games room, swing and slide, wooden playhouse and space to roam. Table tennis, table football, darts, basketball and badminton invite friendly competition, while two separate dining terraces—one poolside and shaded, the other beside the house—offer scenic spots for alfresco meals.

Set just 1.5km from the small village of Seyches, guests can easily collect morning pastries or enjoy a casual lunch. For a broader choice of amenities, Escassefort and Marmande provide everything from supermarkets to traditional restaurants and weekly markets bursting with local produce. Meanwhile, venture to vineyards, picture-perfect villages and historic wine towns from Duras to Bergerac and even Saint-Émilion.

Perfect for families and relaxed gatherings, Mas des Rivailles combines country tranquillity with thoughtful design and plenty to keep everyone entertained.

Location & Local Information

Set amid the glorious countryside of south-western France, Mas des Rivailles lies just 1.5km from the pretty village of Seyches with its bakery, restaurant and grocery store. This is the Lot-et-Garonne department of France, not too far from the Dordogne border.

Around a 10-minute drive away, the village of Escassefort (8km) offers even more local flavour, with a bakery, grocery store, café-bar and restaurant. Meanwhile, the bustling market town of Marmande, just 15km away, is renowned for its juicy tomatoes and rich agricultural heritage. Stroll through its vibrant markets, discover excellent restaurants, and stock up at its supermarkets for long, lazy lunches under the sun.

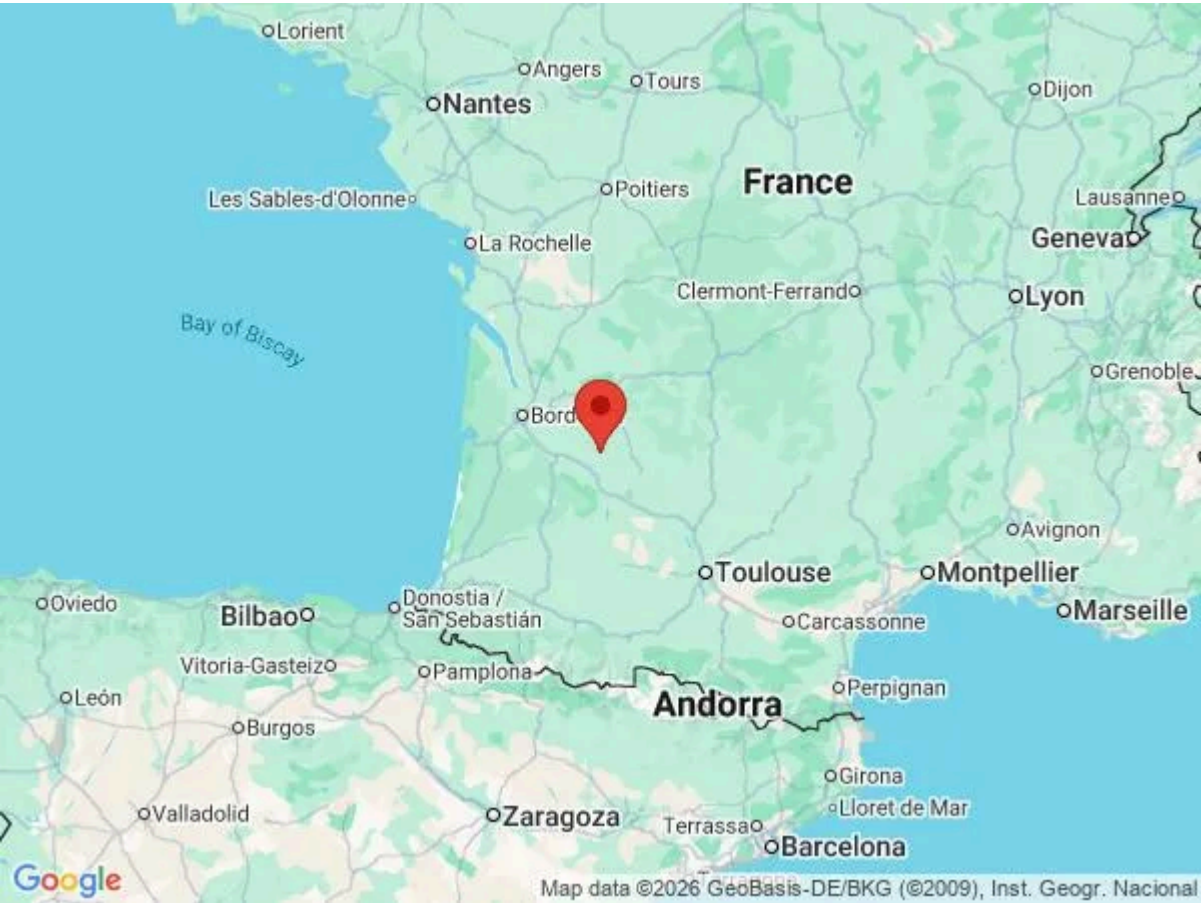
Wine lovers will be in their element across the region, with tastings available at nearby vineyards in Duras (20km) and the wider Entre-Deux-Mers region - home to elegant whites and robust reds alike. If you have a sweeter palate, Château de Monbazillac is only 40km away whilst Saint-Émilion is the perfect day out, just over an hour by car.

For a dose of timeless charm slightly closer to home, explore the beautifully preserved bastide villages of Issigeac (40km) and Eymet (20km), each brimming with character, colourful market days and medieval architecture. Alternatively, head to Sainte-Foy-la-Grande (40km) and the banks of the Dordogne River for kayaking, riverside walks and the superb Saturday morning market. Bergerac (44km), with its half-timbered buildings and wine culture, is also within easy reach, offering a perfect mix of history and gastronomy.

Whether you're sipping wine in Duras, browsing market stalls in Marmande, or paddling along the Dordogne near Bergerac, this corner of Nouvelle-Aquitaine promises an authentic and enriching French experience.
