Overview

At the end of a little lane, La Forge is a holiday home that radiates warmth and timeless charm. This traditional village cottage invites a slower pace of life, where the rhythm of the day is dictated by sunshine, good food and the swimming pool. Step through the shared courtyard path and into a world of characterful interiors, where thick, timeworn walls keep the cottage cool even in the summer.

Inside, the living space is simple and welcoming, with an open-plan layout that brings together the dining, and sitting area in one convivial hub. A farmhouse-style kitchen offers everything needed for laid-back meals at home, from morning coffee outside to leisurely dinners around the dining table. Wi-Fi is available, though many may choose to switch off and soak in the unhurried atmosphere. Upstairs on the first and second floors five double bedrooms provide a comfortable retreat for couples or a small family, served by 2 generous bathrooms.

Begin your day with breakfast under the covered dining terrace, shaded from the rising sun. Spend lazy afternoons lounging by the private 10-metre pool, complete with waterfall feature and a seating area perfect for a good book. Fire up the barbecue as dusk falls and enjoy long evenings of grilled local produce under the stars.

La Forge is located in the remote village of Villarzel-du-Razès in the Aude countryside. Just 30 minutes from the storybook ramparts of Carcassonne and its international airport, the cottage offers rural simplicity without being too isolated. There is a restaurant on the edge of the village, while Limoux, around 20 minutes away, offers a full range of shops, bakeries and excellent restaurants – try its excellent sparkling white wine.

Perfect for those seeking an authentic slice of French country life, La Forge is a place to reconnect with nature, slow down, sample good wine and savour each unhurried moment.

Location & Local Information

At the end of a quiet impasse leading to open countryside, this traditional house in Villarzel-du-Razès offers a rural escape in the heart of southern France. This small village is authentic and remote and there is a restaurant nearby.

Following the country roads north, just 20 minutes away lies the village of Arzens, where you can stock up on fresh pastries at the bakery. For everyday essentials and a livelier atmosphere, the bustling town of Limoux (13.5km) offers everything you might need – from supermarkets and boutiques to cafés and a lively weekly market. Renowned for its sparkling wine, Blanquette de Limoux, this riverside town is a must for wine lovers, with tasting rooms and vineyard tours set among picturesque hills.

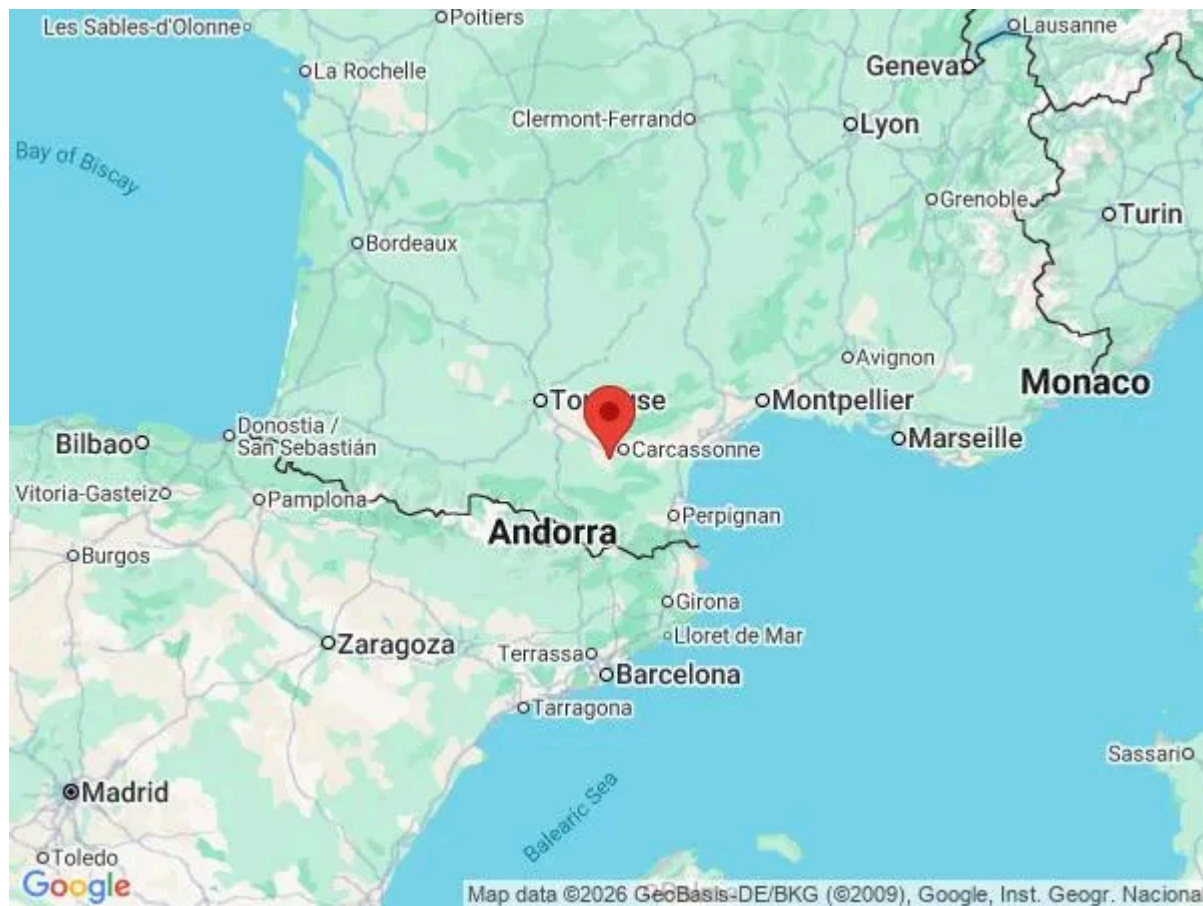
A 30-minute drive brings you to the fairytale citadel of Carcassonne (20km), one of France's most extraordinary medieval landmarks. Wander through its double-walled fortress, explore ancient ramparts and dine in atmospheric courtyards, before enjoying a tranquil stroll or bike ride along the nearby Canal du Midi – a UNESCO World Heritage site lined with plane trees and stone bridges.

Venture further afield to discover the enchanting town of Mirepoix (35km), with its half-timbered arcades and colourful market square. Brimming with history and charm, it's a wonderful place to spend a day browsing artisan stalls, enjoying a glass of wine or simply soaking up the medieval ambience. Its Monday morning market is one of the loveliest in the region.

Wine-tasting is a real highlight across the area, with numerous domaines offering tastings of local reds, whites and sparkling wines, many within a short drive of the house.

- A car is essential in this remote part of France – there is car parking for two to three cars.

- **Security deposit:** €750 charged to client's credit card by Oliver's Travels as a pre-authorisation at least 2 weeks prior to arrival and refunded two weeks after departure, subject to full inspection.
