Au Moulin

Overview

Encircled by waterways and open countryside, Au Moulin is a masterful transformation of a former water mill into a beautiful retreat. From the moment you step inside, the sight of the mill's original mechanism, preserved behind glass by the entrance hall, reminds you of the building's heritage, even as it flows effortlessly into its new life as a stunning 5-bedroom escape.

Across three spacious floors, the interiors are rich with thoughtful design and historic character. The raised living level opens into an open-plan kitchen, dining and lounge area, where contemporary finishes meet exposed stonework, historic charm and a view of the mill's mechanism. Meanwhile, the five bedrooms are elegant and stylish, each featuring their own en suite facilities (some open-plan to the bedrooms – the baths in the bedrooms are especially striking).

Outside, two hectares of private grounds invite leisurely afternoons by the 12-metre swimming pool or moments of calm by the jacuzzi terrace. There is ample space to gather, play table tennis or simply sit back and listen to the rustle of leaves beside the gently flowing canal and river. A decked terrace invites al-fresco meals in glorious surroundings.

Just 7km away lies the medieval bastide town of Lauzerte, one of France's 'Plus Beaux Villages', where café terraces spill onto cobbled squares and local produce fills the market stalls. Further afield, the riverside town of Moissac and the vibrant hub of Castelsarrasin offer all the essentials, while wine lovers will find much to explore in nearby Cahors and the Lot valley.

Whether gathering with loved ones for a summer holiday or seeking character and charm amid rolling countryside, Au Moulin offers a rare blend of authenticity, style and rural elegance.

Location & Local Information

The countryside surrounding Au Moulin offers an authentic escape in the heart of Tarn-et-Garonne. This unique and characterful house lies within a 2-hectare estate with a small canal and river, a wonderful setting for nature and wildlife lovers. Yet you are also well connected, only 400m from the road connecting Lauzerte (7km) and Valence d'Agen (22km).

Less than 10 minutes by car from the medieval bastide town of Lauzerte, this area brims with rustic charm, heritage architecture and a gentle pace of life. Classified as one of Les Plus Beaux Villages de France, Lauzerte is a delightful maze of cobbled lanes, stone facades, artisan galleries and relaxed cafés – the perfect place for a morning stroll or leisurely lunch. Moissac (18km) enchants visitors with its UNESCO-listed abbey, vibrant Saturday market and picturesque riverside setting.

Venture north to Montcuq (18km), known for its lively Sunday market and colourful character, or explore the hilltop beauty of Tournon-d'Agenais (28km), where panoramic views stretch across the verdant countryside.

The Lot Valley also awaits with scenic riverside villages like Fumel (40km), wine-rich Puy-l'Évêque (43km) and the elegant town of Cahors (45km) – a haven for lovers of bold reds and heritage buildings, from the iconic Pont Valentré to bustling market squares. Whether sampling local vintages or ambling along the riverside, this region invites you to savour each moment.

Day trips to the towns of Montauban (35km) and Agen (44km) offer a vibrant contrast, with museums, canalside walks and excellent dining. Montauban's Ingres Museum and pink-brick architecture lend a touch of grandeur, while Agen charms with its old-town ambience and gastronomy. The surrounding countryside is dotted with sunflower fields, plum orchards and sleepy villages, making every journey a pleasure in itself.

Practical amenities are well catered for – Lauzerte provides supermarket access, cafés, and restaurants, while larger hubs like Moissac and Castelsarrasin (both within half an hour) offer further amenities. With Toulouse Airport around an hour's drive, and Bergerac a little further, this rural yet well-connected location makes an ideal base for exploring the hidden gems of southwest France.
