

Maison Saint Emilion

Overview

Set at the heart of Bordeaux's most celebrated wine region, Maison Saint-Émilion offers a rare chance to immerse yourself in vineyard living with charming contemporary comfort.

This beautiful detached home is surrounded by the prestigious vines that have made Saint-Émilion a name known around the world. With sunlight pouring through tall windows and living spaces that open onto your very own garden, this is a place made for lingering afternoons, slow lunches and fine wine shared under open skies.

Inside, a sleek open-plan kitchen with a central island flows into split-level living and dining areas, all air-conditioned and finished to a high standard. The ground floor also features a spacious double bedroom with a gorgeous ensuite bathroom. Upstairs, three further air-conditioned doubles provide flexible accommodation for families or groups, with three shower rooms, two of which are en suite.

The garden opens directly onto the surrounding vines, a vista of rolling green that shifts with the light. The private pool invites refreshing dips under the sun, while the shaded terrace is perfect for long al-fresco meals. Whether you're basking by the water or enjoying a barbecue as dusk falls, the outdoors here is as inviting as the interior.

Just over 3.5km away lies the storied village of Saint-Émilion, a historic haven of cobbled streets, wine cellars and intimate bistros. Here, you'll find everything from artisan shops to elegant dining, as well as opportunities for tastings at both famed châteaux and family-run domaines across the UNESCO listed vineyards.

With the vibrant riverside town of Libourne also nearby and the cultural allure of Bordeaux less than an hour by car, Maison Saint-Émilion is perfectly placed for exploration, indulgence and complete relaxation. For those seeking a refined escape in the heart of wine country, this is a stay where timeless beauty meets modern ease.

Location & Local Information

With its garden opening directly to vines, Maison Saint-Émilion enjoys an enviable position in the heart of Bordeaux's most celebrated wine region, just over 3.5km from the heart of the famous medieval hilltop wine village.

The house is set along country lane, surrounded by a patchwork of wine domaines from large estates to smaller family-run producers. The estate next door offers tastings and hosts occasional wine events that are open to all.

Just a 5-minute drive away (or a brisk 45-minute walk for the most energetic) lies the breathtaking medieval village of Saint-Émilion (3.6km), a UNESCO World Heritage site and a true jewel of south-west France. Meander through cobbled streets lined with wine cellars, little shops and upmarket restaurants, or explore the remarkable underground monolithic church and ancient catacombs carved into limestone. The town's cafés and gourmet eateries offer a refined yet relaxed ambiance, ideal for lingering lunches or evening dining paired with celebrated local vintages.

Around a 15-minute drive brings you to Libourne (8km), an authentic riverside town with one of the finest traditional markets in the Gironde, held three times a week. Beyond the lively square, you'll find boat trips along the Dordogne, a great range of shops and all the essential amenities including large supermarkets and transport connections.

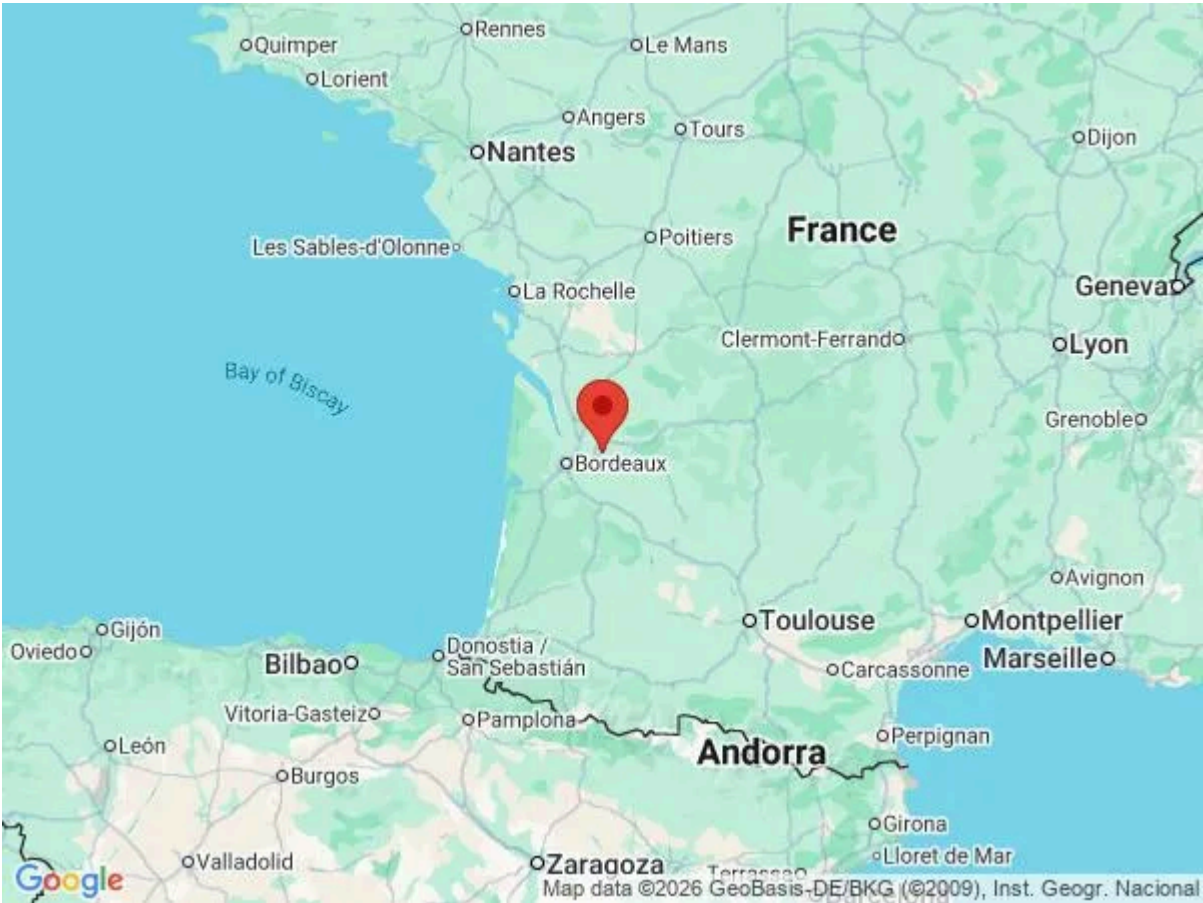
Heading south-east instead, Castillon-la-Bataille (14km) offers a slower pace, perfect for riverside picnics and canoeing adventures, with a bustling Monday morning market and spectacular Battle of Castillon reenactments in July and August that bring local history vividly to life.

For a cultural day out, Bordeaux (45km) is less than an hour by car (or consider the 30-minute train ride from Saint-Émilion), an elegant city filled with world-class museums, designer boutiques and architectural grandeur.

When you're ready for a change of scenery, a day trip to Lacanau (85km) offers serene lake shores ideal for watersports, forest walks and cycle rides, plus a dramatic Atlantic surf beach where you can soak up the sea air or ride the waves.
