Overview

Surrounded by wide skies and sweeping fields, Le Mas Gironde is a high-quality country home where sleek, contemporary living meets the tranquil rhythm of rural France. Just 2km from the market town of Monségur, this attractive three-bedroom residence sits within extensive lawns and open farmland, offering a rural ambience with modern touches throughout.

Inside, this historic home has been transformed into a light-filled, open-plan space, where clean lines and contemporary comforts create a warm and sociable atmosphere. Glass doors connect the airy kitchen, living and dining area to the covered terrace and poolside beyond, blurring the boundaries between indoors and out.

On the ground floor, a double bedroom with a sofa-bed and its own ensuite opens directly onto the garden, while upstairs you'll find two further doubles, including one with a quirky mezzanine and cosy futon reached via a ladder. The family shower room provides practical comfort, while full air-conditioning and Wi-Fi throughout ensure every modern convenience is at hand.

Lounge by the private pool, which glows after dark for moonlit swims, or relax in the shade of the terrace where dining, lounging, and games (giant Connect4 and darts!) invite guests to slow down and enjoy one another's company. Wander across the lawns to take in views over the fields, or fire up the barbecue as the evening breeze settles over the countryside.

The location offers the best of both worlds: a rural setting within easy reach of the charm and convenience of Monségur only 2km away. Here, you'll find local cafés, a bakery, supermarket and traditional shops, while the nearby towns of Duras and Marmande expand your options with restaurants, vineyards, markets and historic châteaux.

Whether you are reconnecting with family, entertaining friends or simply unwinding in nature, Le Mas Gironde offers a refined escape in the heart of the French countryside.

Location & Local Information

Set amidst the open countryside in south-western France, just 2km from the charming bastide town of Monségur, this pretty farmhouse offers the perfect base for exploring the rich tapestry of culture, gastronomy and natural beauty that defines the region. The surrounding landscape is a mosaic of vineyards, summer sunflower fields and quiet country lanes ideal for walking, cycling or simply soaking up the rural ambience.

Monségur itself is a lively yet laid-back hub, home to all essential amenities including café bars, restaurants, a bakery, grocery store and a supermarket. With its traditional arcaded square and summer night markets, it invites visitors to immerse themselves in local life.

Just 10 km away, historic Duras boasts an impressive château, wonderful wine bars and a weekly market on a Monday morning, while the larger town of Marmande, 30 minutes by car, is famed for its plump tomatoes and bustling produce market.


A short distance opens up a treasure trove of day trip opportunities. The Dordogne's prettiest villages, including Eymet and Issigeac, are within easy reach, their medieval streets lined with artisan boutiques and cosy cafés. Sainte-Foy-la-Grande and Castillon-la-Bataille, both perched along the Dordogne River, are perfect for a day of market browsing followed by canoeing along the water's meandering course.

Wine lovers will relish a visit to the UNESCO-listed town of Saint-Émilion, where ancient wine cellars and elegant tasting rooms beckon. For a dose of urban culture, both Bergerac and Bordeaux are comfortably doable as full-day excursions, offering vibrant riverside promenades, historic architecture and excellent dining opportunities.

Whether you're seeking a peaceful rural escape or an active holiday of food, wine and adventure, this location near Monségur provides an irresistible blend of authenticity and access.
