

Chateau Des Florettes

Overview

Rising above a patchwork of vineyards and meadows, Château Des Florettes is a masterfully restored 13th-century residence where history, elegance and comfort converge. A long private drive winds through the estate before revealing the château's beautiful façade and rose-filled garden. Inside, the atmosphere is at once refined and welcoming, with centuries-old beams, flagstone floors and grand fireplaces speaking to its rich heritage.

Accommodation unfolds across various levels, with seven beautifully appointed bedrooms, multiple living areas and a superbly equipped kitchen perfect for convivial evenings. Guests can gather in the characterful dining room or enjoy relaxed meals on the shaded terrace with sweeping views across rolling hills. The upper floors offer cosy nooks, a charming library lounge and elevated vantage points over the surrounding landscape.

Outside, the private infinity pool invites idyllic afternoons, framed by a generous terrace with loungers and a poolside bar. Meanwhile, dining beneath the stars becomes a nightly ritual, with barbecues served al-fresco and glasses raised to the quiet beauty of the setting. Table tennis, Wi-Fi, Smart TVs and a piano offer entertainment indoors, while concierge services, private transfers and wine tours are available to enhance every stay.

In a secluded location between Limoux and Puivert in the Aude countryside, Château Des Florettes places guests in the heart of the Cathar region. The nearby town of Limoux, less than 20 minutes away, offers charming cafés, lively summer festivals and the famous Blanquette sparkling wine. Carcassonne, with its iconic medieval citadel, is 45 minutes by car and makes for a magical day out.

Whether you're planning a family reunion, an escape with friends or a celebration with a touch of grandeur, Château Des Florettes offers an incredible setting that feels both timeless and utterly personal.

Château Interiors

- Entrance hallway (via steps)
- Kitchen with island, butcher block and breakfast table with banquette and chairs. Kitchen well-equipped including range cooker with two ovens, plancha, gas hob, microwave, dishwasher, fridge-freezer, coffee machine and Nespresso machine

Location & Local Information

In the heart of the remote Aude countryside, Château Des Florettes offers an enchanting escape amidst rolling vineyards and forest. Just a short drive from the small village of Castelreng (3.3km), this secluded setting is the perfect retreat for those seeking authentic beauty and the charm of rural southern France. Here, the landscape breathes with history and quiet lanes lead to hidden valleys, medieval ruins and vineyards.

Perfectly positioned to explore the captivating Cathar region, the château lies just 20 minutes from Limoux (11.5km), a characterful town renowned for its café-lined square and lively summer festivals. This historic riverside hub is the birthplace of Blanquette de Limoux, France's original sparkling wine. Spend a lazy afternoon sampling local vintages or browsing the town's boutiques and markets before returning to the serenity of your estate.


To the south, discover the fairy-tale ruins of Château de Puivert (24km) where panoramic views, lakeside walks and rustic dining options await. For a deeper journey into the region's medieval heritage, venture 35 minutes to either Fanjeaux (34km), with its hilltop views and serene village charm, or the bustling bastide town of Mirepoix (28km), whose half-timbered arcades shelter lively cafés and artisan shops – it's Monday morning market is especially charming.

No visit would be complete without a day trip to the UNESCO-listed Cité de Carcassonne (36km), a 45-minute drive away. Its towering ramparts, cobbled alleys and vibrant summer performances create an unforgettable atmosphere steeped in legend. Alternatively, head just over an hour south to Foix (65km), where the dramatic castle looms above the Ariège river, guarding the gateway to the Pyrenees.

Whether you're tracing the footsteps of Cathar knights, tasting sparkling wines under the sun or simply soaking in the stillness of nature, Château Des Florettes is a base of quiet luxury from which to savour the region's rich past and present.
