Overview

Le Cottage Four à Pain offers an immersive escape into the rural beauty of southwest France, not far from the medieval village of Castelnau-Montratier.

This fully restored stone cottage welcomes 4-5 guests with a seamless blend of contemporary comfort and heritage charm. Thoughtfully updated, the interior retains its rustic soul with exposed stone walls, high ceilings and a wood-burning stove, while offering modern amenities including a projector screen (for Chrome Cast), gorgeous contemporary shower rooms and a stylish sauna within the grounds.

In the main part of the cottage, the open-plan space creates a sociable flow, with a sleek kitchen alongside a relaxed living space with French doors opening to the terrace and garden. A pretty en suite twin bedroom and a family shower room complete the ground floor whilst the mezzanine level upstairs is home to an attractive double bedroom.

A few steps from the main cottage, a converted bread oven reveals a delightful surprise – a characterful single bedroom steeped in the charm of centuries past.

Outside, the experience expands across rolling lawns and peaceful terraces, each corner designed for leisurely living. Mornings stretch into afternoons beside the swimming pool, surrounded by sun-loungers and countryside views. Al-fresco meals are a must beneath the covered dining terrace, complete with barbecue. There's a trampoline for younger guests, a hammock for quiet moments, and a unique sauna offering a touch of indulgence with a view.

Le Cottage Four à Pain is ideally placed for exploring the Lot's timeless beauty. Just 7km away, Castelnau-Montratier offers cafés, a bustling weekly market and all daily amenities. The bastide towns of Lauzerte and Moissac are within easy reach, while the riverside charm of Cahors and the historic avenues of Montauban lie just 40 minutes away in either direction.

Whether savouring peaceful mornings with coffee and croissants or discovering the rich heritage of the Quercy Blanc, this charming French cottage invites you to slow down and stay awhile.

Location & Local Information

Le Cottage Four a Pain is set within 12 hectares of private grounds opening to the beautiful countryside, just a 10-minute drive to the charming market town of Castelnau-Montratier. Ideally positioned between Cahors and Montauban, guests can enjoy the best of both worlds: rural tranquillity and easy access to bastide villages and historic towns.

Castelnau-Montratier itself is a vibrant local hub with a warm, authentic atmosphere. Here you'll find everything needed for a comfortable stay: a baker, butcher, pharmacy, grocery shop, supermarket, bank, tabac and a lively weekly market, alongside a handful of cafés and restaurants that spill out onto cobbled squares.

The surrounding Tarn-et-Garonne and Lot landscapes are a haven for walkers and cyclists, with scenic trails winding through vineyards, woodlands and picturesque villages. Active guests will relish a round at the nearby Golf des Roucous (also home to tennis court you can rent) and there are horseriding opportunities within the region.

Those seeking cultural riches can explore the many bastide towns dotted throughout the region. Lauzerte, with its medieval charm and artist studios, and Moissac, famed for its Romanesque abbey and cloisters, are both within easy reach. The lovely town of Montcuq offers a delightful Sunday market and a chance to wander narrow lanes lined with shuttered houses, while Réalville provides yet another glimpse of local life, full of understated charm.

For a more extended adventure, the canal paths near Moissac invite leisurely bike rides through idyllic countryside, perfect for soaking up the region's slow-paced beauty. Further afield, Cahors tempts with its famous Valentré Bridge and Malbec wines, while Montauban's pink-brick facades, art museums and elegant squares offer a vibrant contrast.
