

Maison Mouline

Region: Dordogne Sleeps: 10

Overview

Maison Mouline is a thoughtfully renovated house in the Dordogne just 14 km from the medieval beauty of Sarlat-la-Canéda. This spacious country home offers families and groups a relaxed, easy-going escape surrounded by greenery, games and beautiful terraces.

Inside, the house flows seamlessly between social spaces and quiet corners. On the ground floor, the bright and elegant kitchen features a large central island, double ovens and a generous dining table, leading directly to the outdoor terrace and swimming pool. Upstairs, a gorgeous living room with Smart TV opens onto a picturesque terrace, ideal for morning coffee or evening aperitifs. With five bedrooms spread across two floors, including a master en suite bedroom and a large family bathroom, the layout easily accommodates both togetherness and privacy.

The garden is a delight for all ages. Children can play on the lawn, enjoying the swings, badminton net and football goals, while adults gather for a game of boules on the floodlit court. The private swimming pool is the heart of outdoor living, complete with sun loungers, shaded dining and even a poolside hammock perfect for lazy afternoons.

Just a short walk from the house lies a tranquil lake with a sandy beach and summer Base de Loisirs offering a snack-bar, paddle boards, pedalos and supervised swimming in the height of the summer. There's a bakery, small supermarket and café-bar just 2km away whilst the historic charm of Sarlat-la-Canéda can be reached by car (or bike) with its gastronomic restaurants, markets and exquisite medieval architecture.

Whether cycling along the nearby voie verte, canoeing down the Dordogne or soaking up the character of villages such as Domme and La Roque Gageac, the region is brimming with activity and heritage. Yet here at Maison Mouline, the pace slows. Meals linger outdoors, children play until dusk and evenings stretch under the stars.

- Open-plan kitchen and dining area, well-equipped including large central island and stools, two ovens, hob and microwave, dishwasher, fridge freezer, washing machine and drinks fridge. Doors open to terrace and pool area

- Living room with TV (UK channels, Prime and Netflix) and Fibre-optic Wi-Fi. Doors open to upper terrace with steps down to garden

Location & Local Information

Maison Mouline is in the Dordogne department of southwestern France, only 14km south of Sarlat-la-Canéda and a short drive from the Lot border.

Local amenities can be found just 2km away (a café-bar/restaurant, Spar grocery store and bakery). Even closer you can walk to a pretty lake for nature, fishing and relaxation. The lake also features a summer Base de Loisirs (entry fees apply) with a sandy beach, supervised swimming and picnic spots alongside a snack-bar and paddle-boards/pedaloos for hire (facilities are usually available July and August). The lake is next to a nature reserve with a diverse range of flora and fauna, a haven for birdwatchers, walkers and nature lovers.

The surrounding countryside is a dream for outdoor enthusiasts, with a voie verte cycling trail passing nearby. This former railway line now serves as a scenic route for cycling and hiking, offering a greenway route from Sarlat-la-Canéda to Cazoulès with a detour south of the Dordogne very close to the house. Sarlat itself is a medieval gem, renowned for its honey-coloured stone buildings, winding alleys and bustling markets teeming with local delicacies like truffles and foie gras.

For those drawn to the water, canoeing along the Dordogne River is an unforgettable way to experience the region's dramatic landscapes. Glide past towering limestone cliffs and riverside castles, stopping for picnics or swims along the way. Canoe hire is readily available in the surrounding area, making this an accessible and family-friendly adventure.

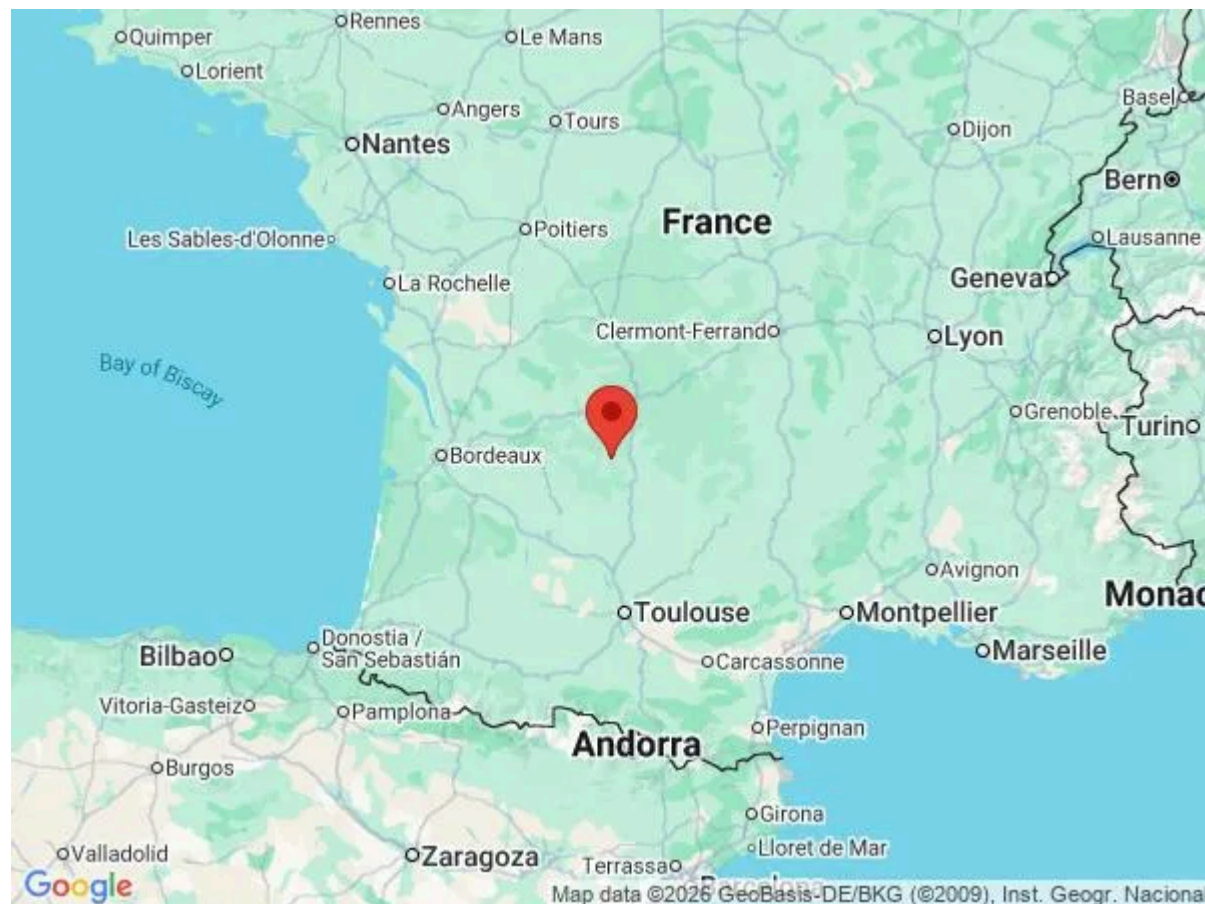
The storybook villages of Domme (9km) and La Roque-Gageac (14km) promise riverside charm and panoramic views in abundance. Explore Domme's hilltop bastide streets or wander the waterfront alleys of La Roque-Gageac, where golden houses nestle beneath a looming cliff. Meanwhile, majestic châteaux such as Beynac and the enchanting Château des Milandes (former home of Josephine Baker) offer captivating glimpses into the region's noble past.

Day trips further afield open the door to wonders like the hanging village of Rocamadour (42km), dramatically clinging to its cliffside, and the awe-inspiring Gouffre de Padirac (51km), a subterranean world of giant caverns and underground rivers.

With such a rich tapestry of nature, culture and history at your fingertips, Maison Mouline is perfectly placed for a Dordogne escape to remember.

What you should know...

- It's just a 2-minute stroll to a pretty lake. There's also a sandy beach, bordering a nature reserve. The lake's Base de Loisirs (with a snack-bar, pedalo/paddleboard hire and supervised swimming) is only open in the peak season (approx. July and August) and an entry fee usually applies.
