

# La Metairie De Mespoule

Region: Dordogne Sleeps: 10

## Overview

Set amid a patchwork of sunflower fields or whispering maize, La Métairie de Mespoule is a lovingly restored farmhouse that radiates both warmth and refinement. Arriving here, the open Lot-et-Garonne countryside stretches before you, a setting that promises total relaxation and long, leisurely days. The home sits within spacious grounds that blend seamlessly into the rural landscape, with mature trees, a sprawling lawn and glittering private pool offering a truly beautiful retreat.

The interiors are a testament to understated elegance. Exposed stone walls, timber beams and soft tones create a timeless backdrop for laid-back living. The kitchen and dining room are designed for convivial meals, opening directly onto a covered terrace perfect for al fresco lunches or long summer dinners. Five ensuite bedrooms (four of which feature air-conditioning) offer comfort and privacy for up to 10 guests, while a separate TV room/study and air-conditioned mezzanine invite moments of calm.

Days here unfold at a gentle rhythm. Guests of all ages can challenge each other at table tennis, then cool off in the 12-metre pool, or you may prefer simply reading a book on a sun lounger or savouring a glass of local wine under the pergola. For the more active, tennis is available at a nearby property by arrangement, whilst walking and cycling routes weave through the surrounding countryside.

The house enjoys a superb location in the Lot-et-Garonne, close to the Dordogne border, between Bergerac and Monflanquin. Nearby Castillonès, less than ten minutes by car, offers everyday essentials and a weekly market brimming with local produce. The town's medieval square and storied architecture speak to a rich history that echoes across the region. From the atmospheric château at Biron to the vibrant culture of Villerséal and the vineyards around Issigeac, there is no shortage of places to explore.

Whether gathering with family or escaping with friends, La Métairie de Mespoule offers the rare luxury of space and effortless French country charm.

# Location & Local Information

Set in the Lot-et-Garonne countryside, La Metairie de Mespoule offers a rural escape with easy access to some of the region's most captivating bastide towns and scenic landscapes. Tucked between Bergerac and the hilltop jewel of Monflanquin, the house enjoys a wonderful setting, surrounded by open farmland with rotating sunflower and maize fields.

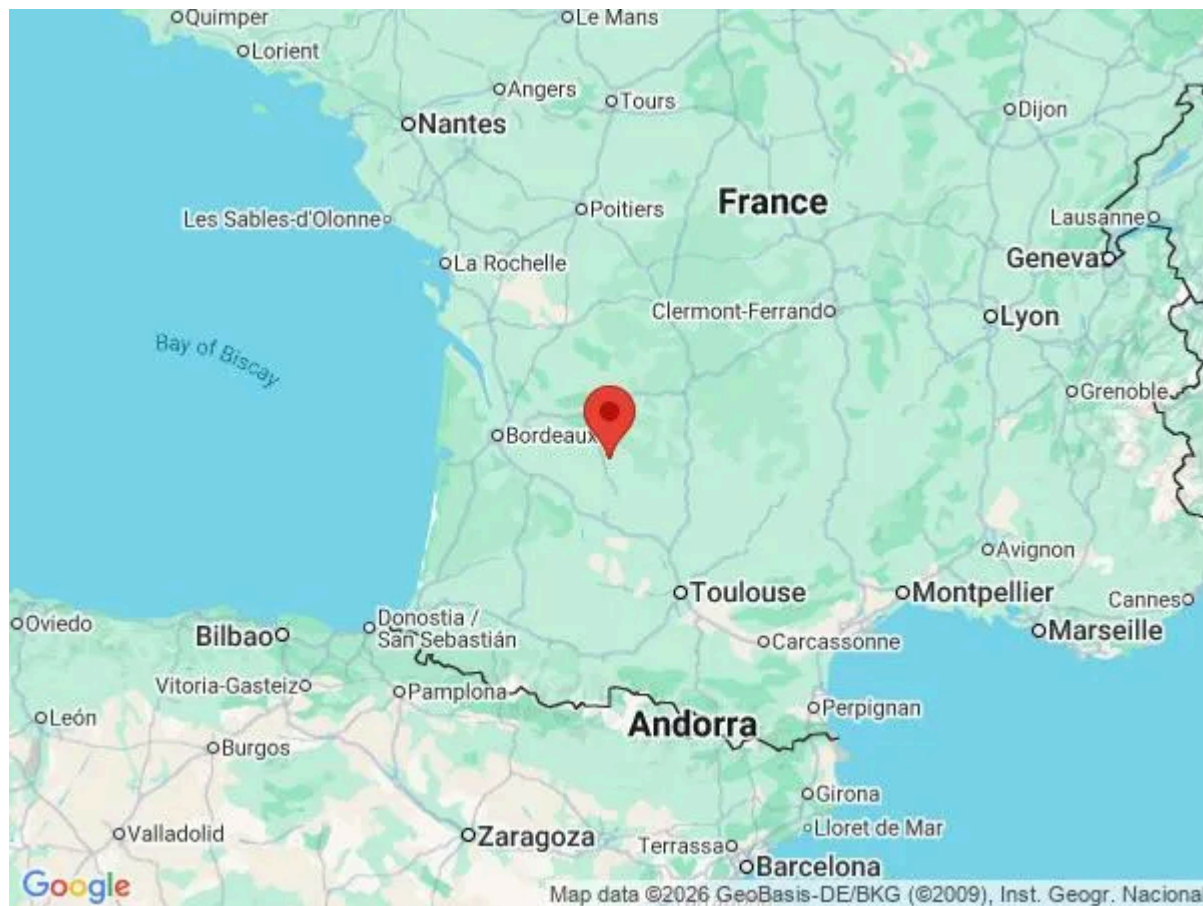
Less than a 10-minute drive away, the pretty bastide town of Castillonès provides essential amenities and historic charm. Its arcaded central market square bursts to life on Tuesday mornings, where fresh produce and local crafts fill the stalls. Wander its medieval streets to discover the graceful Église Saint-Pierre, the historic Porte de la Lune and the fascinating Museum of the Bastides. For further everyday needs, the thriving market town of Villereal is just a little further, offering a choice of shops, bakeries and restaurants.

The area is a haven for walkers and cyclists, with meandering trails that link villages and vineyards through gentle hills and shaded woodland. One scenic route leads to the village of Issigeac, classified as one of France's 'Plus Beaux Villages' and famous for its picturesque Sunday morning market.

Culture seekers can explore the majestic Château de Biron, perched dramatically above its namesake village, or discover pretty villages across the Périgord Pourpre such as medieval Eymet with its attractive riverside setting beside the Dropt. Don't miss the two beautiful bastide villages of Monflanquin and Monpazier, both within half an hour.

For a change of pace, a day trip to the Dordogne River promises leisurely riverside dining, boat rides and lively markets in Bergerac, just half an hour by car, or the charming village of Limeuil, one of France's 'Plus Beaux Villages', where the Vézère and Dordogne rivers meet. Closer to home, local vineyards offer intimate wine tastings in picturesque surroundings, a delightful way to sample the region's celebrated vintages.

This location is a gateway to Southwest France's authentic charms from historic bastides to the simple pleasures of rural life, making it a perfect base for a truly memorable escape.
