Overview

In the prestigious wine village of Meursault lies a beautifully restored 5-bedroom *maison* that embodies the essence of Burgundy's winemaking heritage with contemporary finesse.

Once a wine merchants home, the interiors flow with understated luxury - think soft neutral tones, artisanal materials and thoughtfully curated furnishings that reflect both comfort and style. From the beautiful kitchen with its central island and sleek appliances, to the calming living area opening directly onto the garden terrace, every space has been designed for ease, elegance and convivial living.

Accommodation is air-conditioned throughout and spans three floors, with five double en-suite bedrooms offering privacy and space for up to ten guests. Each room has been fitted with high-quality linens, king or super king-size beds and gorgeous bathrooms.

Outside, the terrace is ideal for long al-fresco lunches by the barbecue or evening dinners accompanied by some of the region's finest wines.

The location could scarcely be better. In Meursault, a jewel of the Côte de Beaune and one of Burgundy's most celebrated wine-producing villages, guests are just a short stroll from a dozen restaurants, gourmet shops and local wine cellars. For oenophiles, this is the promised land. The owners, with decades of experience in the wine trade, are happy to organise tailored tastings and exclusive vineyard tours.

Meursault itself lies along the legendary Route des Grands Crus, with iconic names like Puligny-Montrachet, Volnay and Pommard just minutes away. And for deeper cultural immersion, Beaune is a historic hub of wine and architecture and less than fifteen minutes' drive. Whether it's sampling Grand Crus in vaulted cellars, walking through mosaic-roofed towns or simply soaking up the golden light over the vines, this is Burgundy at its most inviting.

Location & Local Information

Maison Joigneaux is located in the famous wine village of Meursault, one of the destinations along the iconic Route des Grands Crus and just over a 10-minute drive from Beaune.

Set in the prestigious Côte de Beaune, Meursault is celebrated for its world-class Chardonnay and sweeping vineyard vistas. With its elegant charm and wine-soaked history, the village offers a quintessential Burgundian experience in a truly privileged setting.

Centrally located on the edge of the village centre, guests will find everything they need within a short walk of the property. Whether it's collecting fresh croissants from the boulangerie, browsing the local butcher or picking up essentials, convenience is at your doorstep. A choice of twelve restaurants, ranging from classic bistros to fine dining, alongside a café-bar and two grocery stores, makes dining and daily life effortlessly enjoyable in this walkable village.

Wine lovers are perfectly placed to explore some of Burgundy's most prestigious appellations. From the full-bodied reds of Gevrey-Chambertin and Nuits-Saint-Georges to the refined whites of Corton-Charlemagne, vineyard visits abound, each offering unique tasting experiences. Locally, Château de Meursault is a must-visit, with its majestic architecture, gardens and vaulted cellars open for tours and tastings.

For a slower pace, take to the vine-covered landscapes on foot or bike - scenic trails wind through the surrounding countryside, providing serene views and an authentic sense of place. Nearby villages like Pommard, Volnay and Puligny-Montrachet make delightful trips along the celebrated wine route.

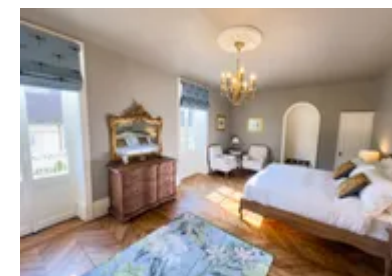
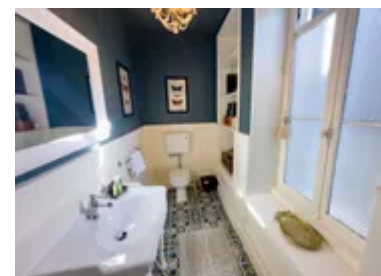
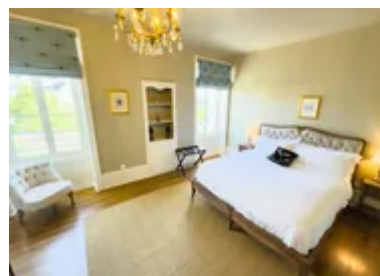

- Located just off a road on the edge of the village, it's an easy walk (with narrow pavements) to the heart of Meursault – the main square and fountain is less than 500m away.
- Despite the central location, car hire is still recommended to fully experience this beautiful region. There is parking for one car at the house and further parking around 20m away.
