

# Chateau Salettes

## Overview

Beyond the graceful curve of the entrance pathways, Château Salettes rises amid mature trees and manicured lawns, its honey-hued stone walls whispering stories from the 17th century. Fully renovated yet faithful to its historic roots, this majestic estate offers a beautiful escape for up to 14 guests, where elegance and contemporary comfort are seamlessly woven together.

Inside, seven ensuite bedrooms blend clean-lined sophistication with heritage details. Expect parquet flooring underfoot and bathrooms finished with flair (four bedrooms also feature air-conditioning). A gym equipped with everything from a rowing machine to free weights offers a chance to energise each morning, while bright, sociable spaces such as the expansive kitchen and light-filled dining area open out into the gardens.

Outside, life takes on a slower rhythm. Mornings begin with coffee on the breakfast terrace. The day unfolds between swims in the sculpted, kidney-shaped pool and leisurely lunches on the dining terrace. As evening falls, the brasero seating area calls for local wine and conversation beneath the stars.

Set in a tiny village in the Pyrénées-Atlantiques region of Nouvelle-Aquitaine, close to the Haute- Pyrénées border, the château lies just ten minutes by car from Lembeye, a fortified bastide village where you'll find all the essentials from boulangerie to small supermarket. The beautiful town of Pau, half an hour away, is perfect for day trips, with elegant boulevards, historic cafés and a panoramic promenade overlooking the snow-capped peaks. Discover the birthplace of Henri IV, explore medieval castles, or venture further to the Pyrénées National Park for hiking, rafting, or simply absorbing the raw grandeur of the mountains.



Whether gathering with family for a summer reunion or sharing relaxed dinners with friends, Château Salettes offers a timeless setting for connection, comfort and discovery.

# Location & Local Information

In the Pyrénées-Atlantiques department of southwestern France, close to the Haute- Pyrénées border, this 17th century château enjoys a picturesque location in a small village around a 10-minute drive from Lembeye and 26km from the beautiful town of Pau.

This authentic region of France offers an enticing blend of bucolic charm and cultural richness, all set against the breathtaking backdrop of the Pyrénées. Nearby Lembeye (10km) provides all essential amenities including a bakery, small supermarket, restaurants, a pharmacy and a traditional bar. It's lovely to stroll around the fortified village and there are some wonderful walks and vineyard tours close to the village.

Adventurers and heritage seekers alike will find much to explore nearby. The medieval Château de Montaner (18km) is a striking fortress steeped in regional history. For horse-riding, head to the nearby equestrian centre in Saint-Laurent-Bretagne (7km). Families can enjoy Pau's Aquasport Park (27km), complete with rafting, airboat rides, and a play park for younger children, or relax by the shores of Lac d'Aressy (29km) near the Ousse River.

Meanwhile, Pau itself offers the vibrancy of a city with the soul of a spa town. Stroll the iconic Boulevard des Pyrénées, visit the birthplace of King Henri IV, now a museum with Renaissance gardens and the historic Money Tower, or explore the fine art and Resistance museums.

In the other direction, Tarbes, (35km) is a lively town nestled at the foot of the Pyrénées, offering a delightful blend of heritage and culture. Known for its elegant boulevards and tree-lined squares, it boasts a charming historic centre with vibrant markets, cosy cafés and traditional brasseries. Highlights include the impressive Massey Garden – home to the Musée Massey with its fascinating military and fine art collections – and the striking National Stud, where visitors can learn about the town's equestrian legacy. With its relaxed atmosphere and scenic setting, Tarbes is a wonderful destination for a leisurely day out.

Outdoor enthusiasts will relish the proximity to the Pyrénées National Park where dramatic cirques, karst valleys and crystal-clear lakes await. Spot chamois in the wild or take in unforgettable views from the famous Pic du Midi, around a 90-minute drive from your historic château.
