Overview

A short walk from the shores of the Étang de Lacanau, Maison Siren is a refined architect-designed villa created for modern living in beautiful surroundings, within walking distance to a seasonal sports centre with a swimming pool, tennis courts, restaurant and horse-riding opportunities.

Originally designed in the early 1970s by a renowned Finnish architect, this single-storey residence now offers an authentic sense of contemporary elegance. Clean lines, open spaces and large windows define its newly renovated interior, where a sleek designer kitchen flows effortlessly into the expansive living and dining areas, all framed by views of the decked terrace and enclosed garden.

Discover three good-sized double bedrooms, each with its own stylish en-suite shower room and Smart TV, two also enjoy easy access to the terrace and garden. Indeed, the enclosed garden wraps the house in greenery, offering privacy, dappled shade and plenty of room to relax or entertain. Enjoy long lunches accompanied by the scent of pine trees, sunbathe on loungers or simply savour this beautiful natural setting.

The villa is part of a complex of residences set within the forest just a leisurely walk from a seasonal facilities including a shared swimming pool, tennis courts and a restaurant . There is also a horse-riding centre nearby. The étang's shores are within walking distance (around 1.5km) whilst the useful amenities of Lacanau village are just a short drive away.

Maison Siren is perfectly placed to explore the region's natural beauty. Discover the étang's pretty beaches, ideal for early morning swims or paddleboarding. The surf and seaside charm of Lacanau-Océan lie only 15 minutes away by car, whilst the world-famous vineyards of Bordeaux, Margaux and Pauillac are under an hour's drive.

Closer to home, cycling trails meander through the forest to bustling market mornings in local villages. Slightly further north, Lac d'Hourtin-Carcans also awaits with its watersports and idyllic scenery.

Whether you're drawn to the architecture, the lifestyle or the coastal air, Maison Siren offers a refined base to experience the very best of this alluring part of southwest France.

Location & Local Information

Maison Siren is a contemporary abode set within a 150-hectare marina resort (Marina de Talaris), a large estate of holiday residences set within the pine forest a short walk from the shores of the Étang de Lacanau (1.5km) near France's stunning Atlantic coast, only a 45-minute drive from Bordeaux International Airport.

A 1km walk away, the heart of the estate features a sports centre with a shared swimming pool (18x9m), tennis courts (reserve ahead) and a restaurant whilst there are horse-riding opportunities on the edge of the resort a little further afield. Do note services are seasonal and opening hours apply.

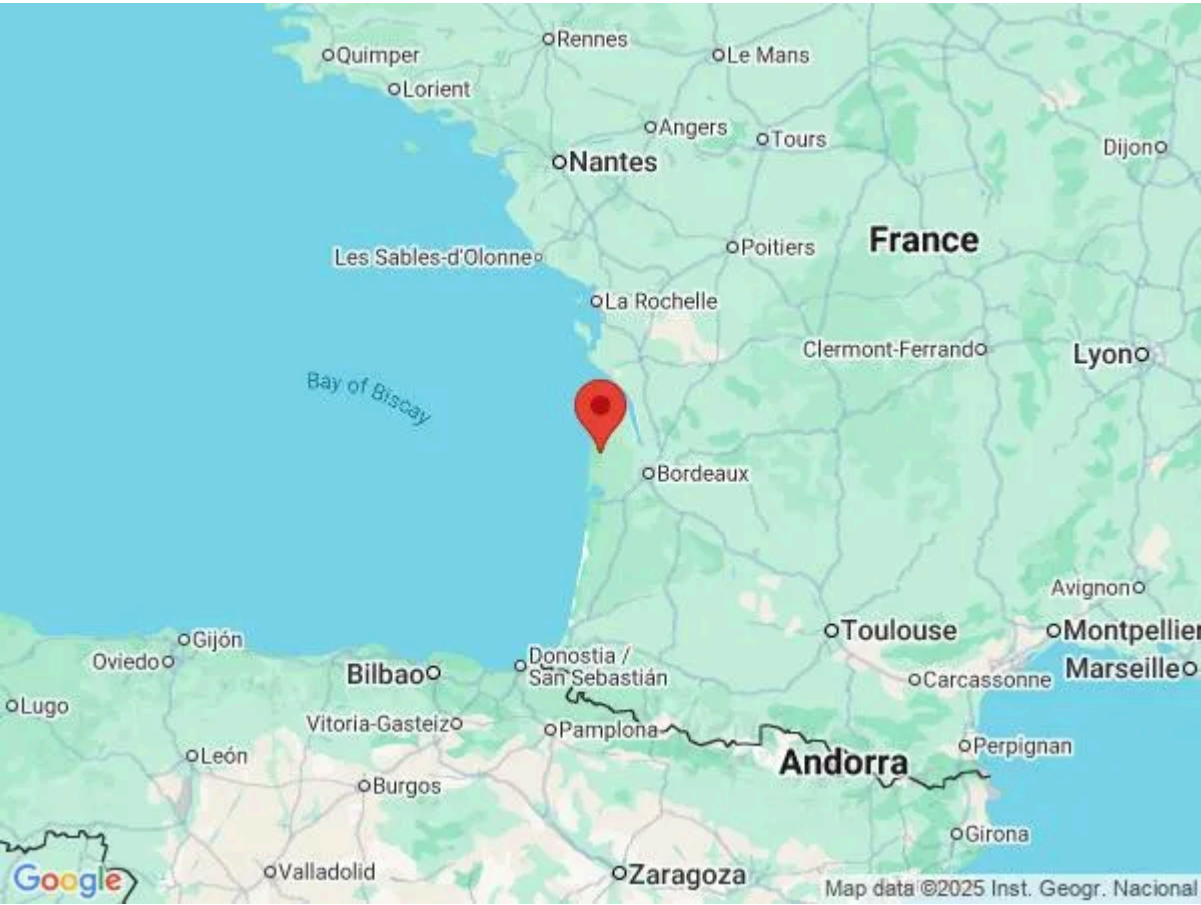
Furthermore, Lacanau's villages amenities are just a very short drive away (3km). Here you will find a supermarket, bakery, butchers etc as well as a weekly market (June to September) and a Thursday evening night market in the height of the summer.

The Étang de Lacanau, a beautiful freshwater lake perfect for paddleboarding, sailing or wild swimming, lies just beyond the resort, while the Atlantic beaches of Lacanau-Océan are just fifteen minutes away by car. Here, golden sands stretch for miles and surf culture thrives alongside bustling summer beach bars and restaurants. A summer market takes place in Lacanau-Océan from mid-June to September.

Just a little further north, the vast Lac d'Hourtin-Carcans (18km), the largest freshwater lake in France, offers calm waters, beaches, summer watersports and shaded picnic spots amidst unspoilt nature.

Adventurers will delight in the network of cycling trails that weave through the surrounding forest. These well-maintained paths link lakes, dunes and coastline, creating a scenic playground for all ages.

Wine lovers are perfectly placed to explore the prestigious vineyards of the Médoc, with renowned appellations like Pauillac and Margaux around a 45-minute drive away. Enjoy intimate tastings in family-run châteaux or savour a gastronomic lunch overlooking the vines. For an enriching cultural day trip, the elegant city of Bordeaux (48km) awaits with its world-class museums, neoclassical architecture, vibrant riverside quays and wine-bars.
