Location & Local Information

Located in the very heart of this historic town, Gaillac captivates visitors with its rich winemaking heritage, vibrant atmosphere and charming blend of history and modernity. As one of France's oldest wine regions, it invites you to explore family-run vineyards, indulge in tastings, and learn about traditions dating back to Roman times. Beyond the vineyards, Gaillac's lively town centre hosts colourful weekly markets (just a few steps from your house), boutique shops and inviting café terraces, perfect for soaking up the relaxed southern French lifestyle.

The town is set in the heart of south-west France's coveted "golden triangle", close to Cordes-sur-Ciel (25km) and Albi (24km). Surrounded by rolling vineyards, medieval bastides, and beautiful Tarn countryside, guests will find themselves immersed in the heritage and beauty of this region.

Explore the nearby medieval jewel of Cordes-sur-Ciel, perched high on a hilltop and often cloaked in early morning mist, giving it a heavenly, otherworldly quality. Stroll its cobbled lanes lined with artisan workshops and panoramic viewpoints, or delve into its fascinating Gothic heritage.


Meanwhile Albi is a UNESCO World Heritage Site famed for its magnificent red-brick Sainte-Cécile Cathedral and the exceptional Toulouse-Lautrec Museum, set within the imposing Palais de la Berbie. Don't miss the wonderful covered market taking place Tuesday to Sunday mornings.

For lovers of nature and outdoor pursuits, the surrounding Tarn countryside offers abundant opportunities. From canoeing through gorges and hiking among the forested hills to cycling scenic country roads between bastide villages, the region rewards exploration at every turn. Highlights include the atmospheric streets of Saint-Antonin-Noble-Val (37km), the perched villages of Puycelsi (22km) and Penne (32km), and the storybook turrets of the Château de Mauriac (9km), now home to a collection of contemporary art.

Whether you're drawn by heritage, gastronomy or the sheer beauty of the landscape, this exceptional setting is a gateway to the very best of the Tarn.
