## Overview

With views over rolling vineyards and the rhythm of rural life unfolding below, Apartment du Vin offers a refined escape at the heart of one of France's most prestigious wine domaines. Set within a beautifully converted first-floor coach house, this is a holiday abode where elegant interiors meet the timeless appeal of the Loire's winemaking heritage.

Surrounded by 200 hectares of organic Sauvignon and Pinot Noir vines, the first-floor apartment is set within a celebrated estate, where high-end quality is matched only by authenticity. The apartment is beautifully finished, with exposed beams and an open-plan layout that flows effortlessly from the modern kitchen through to the welcoming living and dining area. Two stylish ensuite bedrooms offer flexibility and privacy, while the tower study provides a peaceful spot to work or read. With a Sonos sound system throughout and both UK and French TV, modern comforts are seamlessly provided.

Another highlight is the rooftop terrace. From sunrise to sundown, this private perch invites long al-fresco meals and glasses raised against the panorama of vineyards stretching to the horizon.

Apartment du Vin sits in a region brimming with possibility. The surrounding area is dotted with charming villages, local markets and excellent restaurants. The upmarket town of Richelieu, with its elegant architecture and boutiques, lies just over 30 minutes away, whilst the historic city of Poitiers, with its Roman roots and Plantagenet past, offers culture, shopping and fast TGV links to Paris.

Whether you're sipping the estate's own wines or exploring the châteaux of the Loire Valley, this is a place to savour French country life.

# Location & Local Information

Set within one of France's premier organic wine estates, Apartment du Vin offers a stunning getaway in the heart of the Vienne countryside. Just 25km north of the historic city of Poitiers, this beautiful estate is a paradise for wine lovers. September brings the magic of the harvest, when the scent of ripening Sauvignon and Pinot Noir fills the air and tractors rumble through the vines - an unforgettable glimpse into winemaking in motion.


Everyday essentials are close at hand, with the villages of Marigny-Brizay (2km) and Ouzilly (2.7km) just a five-minute drive away, perfect for fresh bread or groceries. The nearby towns of Lencloître (8km) and Jaunay-Clan (10km) offer bustling weekly markets and charming café-bars, while the elegant town of Richelieu (32km) delights with stylish boutiques and refined dining amid its 17th-century arcades.

From vineyard tours to cultural day trips, Les Roches is ideally placed for exploring western France. Head to Chinon (53km) for riverside canoeing and atmospheric wine bars or discover the architectural beauty of Saumur (80km) and Tours (91km). The iconic châteaux of the Loire Valley, such as Villandry, Azay-le-Rideau and Chenonceau, are all just over an hour away, offering an enchanting journey into France's regal heritage.

To the south, Poitiers beckons with its cobbled lanes, Romanesque churches, and lively shopping streets, steeped in Plantagenet history. Families will also love Futuroscope (15km), one of France's most visited attractions, where imagination and technology collide.
