

La Petite Maison Generille

Overview

Beside the garden's olive trees and the open Dordogne countryside, La Petite Maison Générille offers a charming bolthole where comfort and authenticity blend seamlessly. This pretty cottage stands detached within a large garden, sharing the grounds with a neighbouring rental and the owners' residence, yet maintaining a sense of privacy with its gorgeous outdoor terrace.

Inside, exposed beams and warm tones create a welcoming, homely feel. The open-plan living area features a well-equipped kitchen, wood-burning stove and access to your very own shaded terrace that invites slow al fresco meals. Upstairs via the spiral staircase, two double bedrooms and a bathroom provide restful spaces for couples or a small family.

Outside, the expansive garden opens onto fields and woodland, while the shared 16m heated swimming pool sits ready for a refreshing dip. Days here might include a friendly game of badminton, a round of darts by your terrace or simply relaxing in the dappled shade. As evening falls, fire up the barbecue and enjoy dinner as the sky turns pink above the countryside.

Perfectly placed for discovering the region, the cottage lies around a 10-minute drive from Beynac-et-Cazenac, one of the Dordogne's most enchanting riverside villages. Here, you'll find cafés, restaurants and boat trips for drifting along the river's calm waters. Domme, perched high above the valley, is just a little further and offers breathtaking views, especially magical when the morning mist lifts to reveal a scattering of colourful hot-air balloons. Sarlat-la-Canéda, a jewel of medieval architecture and bustling market life, is also within easy reach.

For those in search of culture and countryside charm, La Petite Maison Générille promises a relaxing escape in the heart of one of France's most picturesque regions.

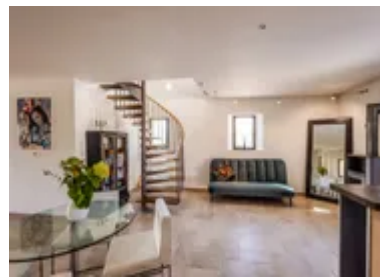

Set in a tiny hamlet amidst in the open Dordogne countryside, this holiday home offers charming getaway within easy reach of the region's most captivating destinations. Just 3km away you will find a boulangerie, small grocery store, tabac and butchers.

Around 7km by car lies the postcard-perfect riverside town of Beynac-et-Cazenac, where honey-coloured houses climb the hillside below a majestic medieval château. Here, you can wander cobbled lanes, dine beside the river or take to the water by canoe to soak up the spectacular scenery from a fresh perspective.

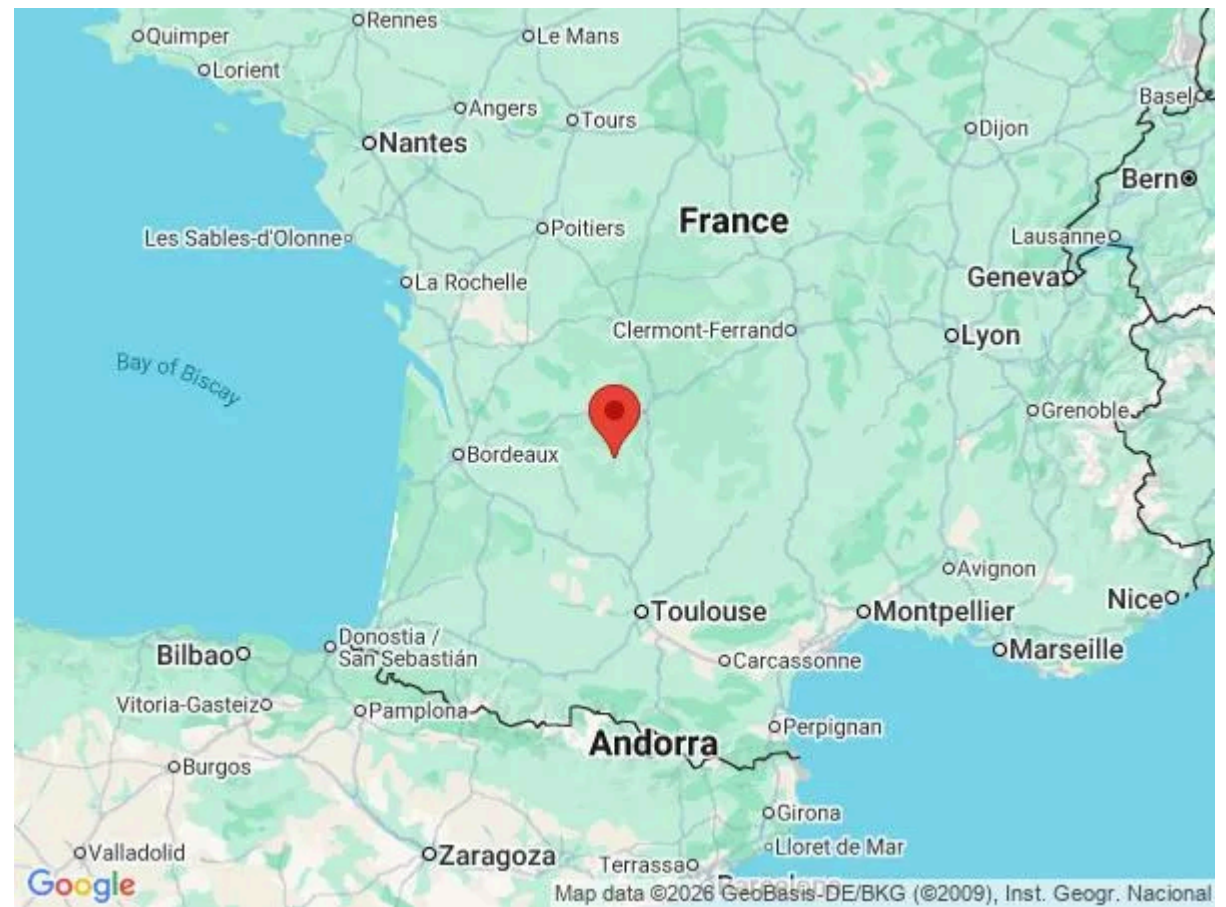
Just a short drive further, the remarkable hilltop village of Domme enchants visitors with its panoramic views over the Dordogne valley and its vibrant tradition of hot-air ballooning. The village boasts a fine selection of restaurants and all necessary amenities, while La Roque-Gageac, nestled beneath towering limestone cliffs, offers riverside strolls, striking cliffside architecture and boat rides along the Dordogne.

The medieval town of Sarlat-la-Canéda (15km) is a highlight of any Dordogne escape. Known for its impeccably preserved architecture, bustling markets and irresistible gastronomy, Sarlat invites you to explore its winding lanes and dine al-fresco in its beautiful central square.

Outdoor enthusiasts will relish the wealth of activities in the surrounding Dordogne countryside. From riverside canoeing and boat rides to leisurely hikes, cycling and exploring cliffside villages, this region offers something for every pace of life. With its mix of natural beauty, historical treasures, and outstanding cuisine, this location promises an unforgettable French escape.

- This pretty detached cottage is set in a large garden alongside one another holiday rental (Le Six de Générille (<https://www.oliverstravels.com/france/south-west-france/aquitaine/le-six-de-generille/>)) and the owner's own residence – the swimming pool and lawn area are shared with the holiday rental next door.
- If staying with children, please take care on the stairs including the spiral open-tread staircase to the first-floor bedrooms.
