

L'Escapade Au Lac

Overview

Surrounded by woodland and gazing out over the beautiful waters of Lac Vert, L'Escapade au Lac is a countryside retreat where lakeside charm, privacy and play come together effortlessly. This characterful cottage in the heart of the Lot invites guests to unwind in an unspoiled natural setting just moments from the lake's lively summer scene.

Blending rustic charm with modern comfort, this holiday abode is set over two floors and designed with relaxed gatherings in mind. The main living space features an open-plan lounge and dining area that flows onto a large, elevated terrace with panoramic views across the lake. A fully equipped kitchen and a double bedroom with king-size bed complete the upper level, while the lower ground floor hosts two further bedrooms and a family bathroom. Outside, an idyllic terrace surrounds the private pool, while table tennis and woodland trails promise entertainment and exploration.

From morning swims in the lake to sunset drinks on the terrace, the guest experience here is deeply connected to the outdoors. Just a short stroll leads you to the other side of Lac Vert for its vibrant offerings in the height of the summer: beach volleyball, tennis, children's play areas, lakeside dining and an aquapark for energetic afternoons. Canoes, pedalos, paddleboards and walking trails mean every day can unfold in a different way. When it's time to stock up or dine out, the little village of Catus is within easy reach, offering essential amenities and local flavour.

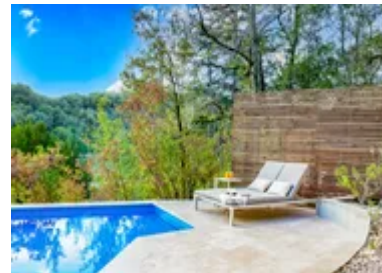
Perfectly positioned between the historic towns of Cahors and Gourdon, this location unlocks some of south-western France's finest cultural and culinary treasures. Spend a day wine tasting in Cahors, exploring medieval lanes in Gourdon, or venturing a little further to the famed Dordogne River and Sarlat-la-Canéda's gastronomic markets.

Location & Local Information

In the rolling countryside of the Lot region in southern France, this charming house overlooks the waters of Lac Vert in Catus. It is set in four acres of grounds (mainly woodland) in the open countryside, and the shores of the lake can be reached within a five-minute walk.

Lac Vert offers a wealth of wonderful activities such as long walks and lakeside picnics. In the height of the summer, the area comes alive with a swimming area and small blue-flag beach, aquapark, pedalo and canoe hire, various sports (beach volleyball, basketball, tennis) and fishing (with a permit). Most of the summer activities take place on the other side of the lake (10 to 15 minutes on foot).

The nearby village of Catus (1.6km) is around a 20-minute walk away (or short drive). Here, you'll find all the essentials: a well-stocked Spar supermarket, a local restaurant, a tabac (with bakery), a take-out pizza spot and a weekly market on a Tuesday morning. For more extensive shopping and local flavour, head to the historic towns of Cahors (17km) or Gourdon (30km), where bustling markets, wine outlets and vibrant town squares await. Cahors in particular is renowned for its Malbec wines and striking Valentré Bridge.

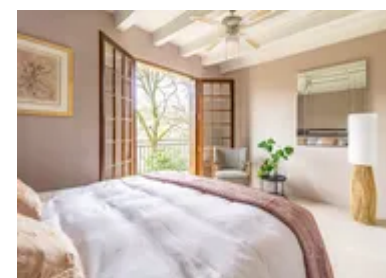
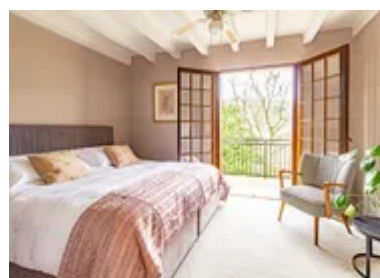
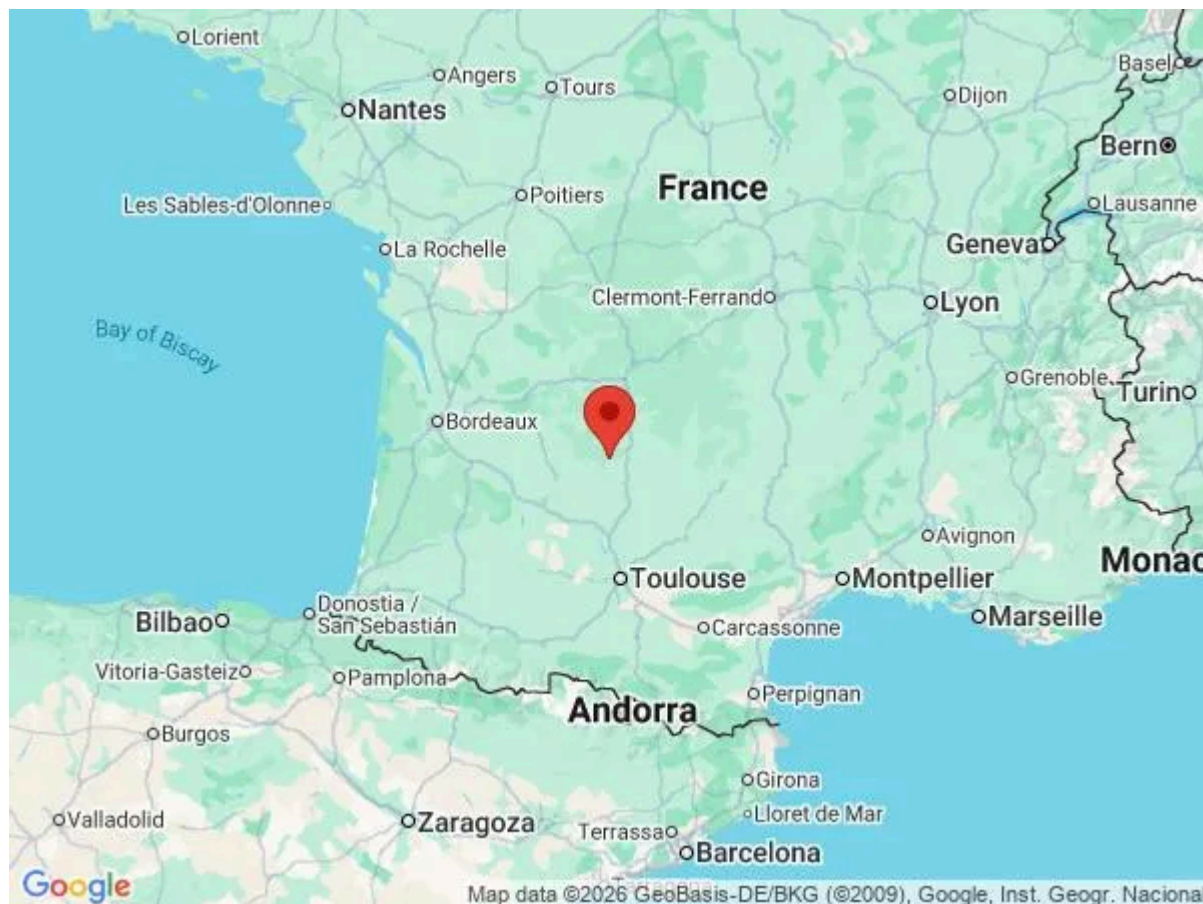
This region is rich in riverside charm and medieval heritage. Follow the winding Lot River to discover enchanting villages like Puy-l'Évêque (23km), where timber-framed houses and riverside cafes invite you to linger. One of the crown jewels of the area is Saint-Cirq-Lapopie (48km), perched high above the river and often cited as one of the most beautiful villages in France. Meander through its cobbled streets, lined with artisan boutiques and dramatic views. Even further afield, Rocamadour (52km) is an incredible day out.

For a taste of the Dordogne's splendour, a 55-minute drive brings you to Sarlat-la-Canéda (50km), a beautifully preserved medieval town brimming with character. Nearby, the cliffside villages of Domme (37km) and La Roque-Gageac (42km) offer breathtaking views over the Dordogne River, while further south, bastide villages like Monpazier (48km) and Villefranche-du-Périgord (29km) transport you back to the time of fortified towns and bustling market days.

Whether you're here to soak up the beauty of Lac Vert, explore storied towns or paddle down tranquil rivers, this location promises a magical blend of natural beauty, cultural richness and laid-back French charm.
