The kitchen and dining space, fully equipped for every occasion, spills into both front and rear gardens, making meals a relaxed, indoor-outdoor affair. With four welcoming bedrooms, including an en suite double bedroom on the first-floor, there is ample space for families and friends to gather and unwind.

Outside, the heated swimming pool offers the perfect antidote to a warm afternoon. Make the most of the large lawns, enjoy table tennis in the old barn or settle in with a glass of Bergerac wine as dusk falls.

Leyssartarde enjoys a wonderfully central location for exploring the Dordogne's rich tapestry of culture, cuisine, and countryside. Just a 15-minute drive from Lalinde, a pretty riverside village with all daily essentials, and within easy reach of both Bergerac, Trémolat and Limeuil, this charming holiday abode is ideally placed for boat trips, canoeing, farmers' markets and vineyard visits. The medieval streets of Sarlat-la-Canéda, the prehistoric wonders of Les Eyzies and the artistic marvels of Lascaux are all close enough for day-long adventures.

Location & Local Information

This charming detached holiday home enjoys sweeping countryside views in the Dordogne, just 23km north-east of Bergerac, making it an ideal base for exploring the region while embracing a slower pace of life.

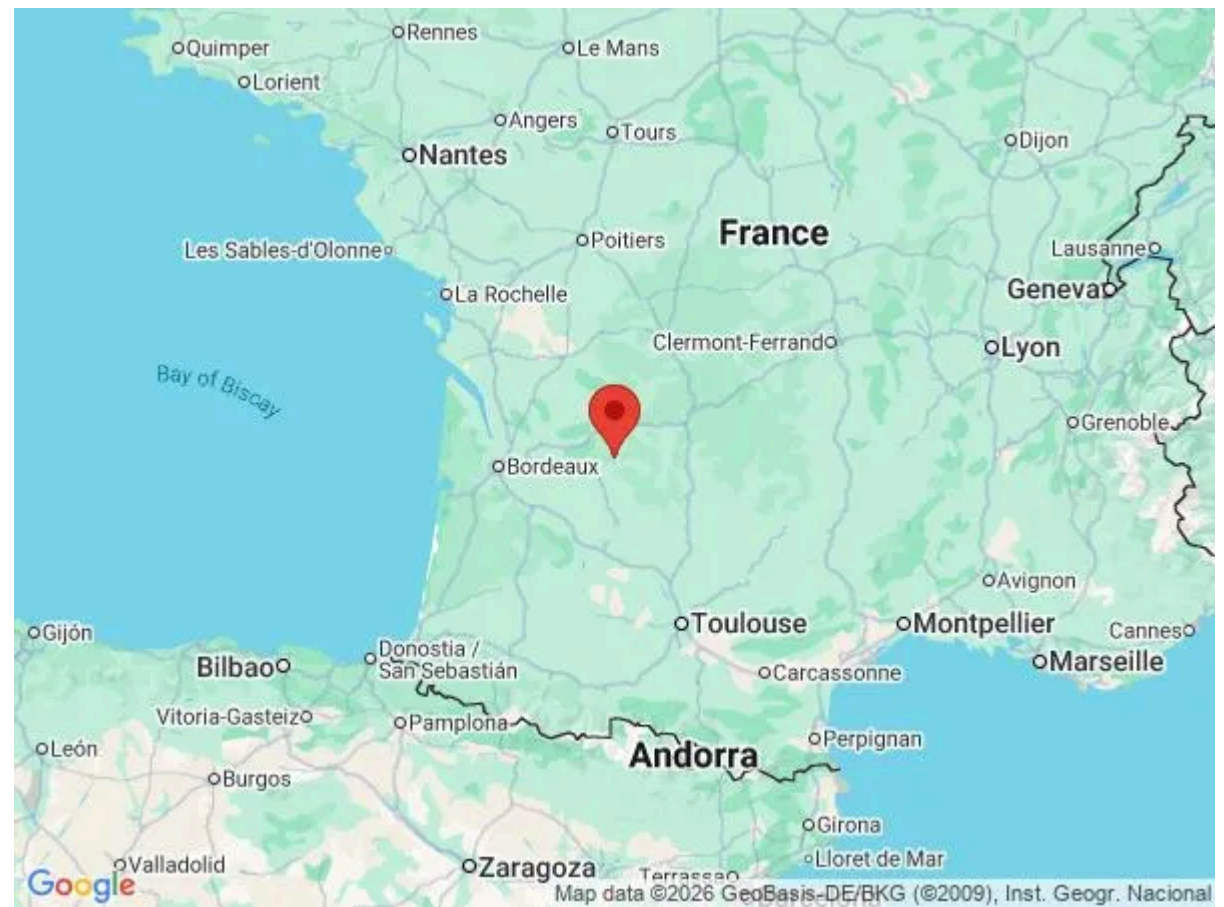
Nearby Lalinde, set along the Dordogne River, offers a traditional market, bakery, restaurants and supermarket. Continue to Bergerac, known for its half-timbered houses, vineyards and relaxed riverside atmosphere. In the opposite direction, Limeuil, one of France's most beautiful villages, sits at the meeting point of two rivers, while Trémolat offers scenic walks and excellent local cuisine.

The Vézère Valley is rich in history, with Les Eyzies and the famous Lascaux caves within reach. South of the river, Issigeac charms with its Sunday market and medieval lanes, while Sarlat-la-Canéda enchants with its preserved architecture and renowned food markets.

From here, enjoy canoeing, vineyard visits and discovering the Dordogne's rich heritage.
