

Le Manoir Et Pavillon

Overview

Manoir et Pavillon rises like a Provençal dream - a master-crafted country retreat where tradition meets uncompromising quality. At its heart, a grand manor house, lovingly finished by its master carpenter owner, radiates understated elegance, while just across the courtyard, the stunning poolside pavilion offers a contemporary space designed for relaxed living and long afternoons beside the swimming pool.

The main house is both welcoming and refined, with generous interiors, air-conditioned bedrooms and hand-crafted woodwork throughout. Each of the six en-suite bedrooms offers cool comfort even at the height of summer, while the stylish living and dining area opens to a leafy front courtyard with flowers.

Across the garden, the separate Pavillon impresses with soaring beamed ceilings and seamless flow from the kitchen to the lounge to the shaded dining terrace. Here, days unfold easily – imagine poolside lunches sizzling from the plancha, games of billiards or table football in the games room or simply lounging by the 10-metre pool, pausing only to cool off or sip something chilled from the bar. A traditional court invites boules matches at golden hour, and when the sun dips, the atmosphere turns mellow beneath the stars.

Set on the edge of Robion, Le Manoir enjoys an enviable location in the Luberon countryside, just a 15-minute stroll into the village for fresh croissants or a leisurely café crème. Robion itself is a charming slice of Provençal life, with its cobbled streets, 12th-century Romanesque church and weekly market offering olives, lavender, goat cheeses and honey from nearby farms. Explore further and you'll find the hilltop villages of Gordes, Oppède and Ménerbes, each revealing timeless views and artisanal delights.

Whether gathering with family and friends or simply savouring the pace of life in this exquisite corner of Provence, Le Manoir et Pavillon promises a stay that blends craftsmanship, comfort and charm in perfect harmony.

Location & Local Information

Set in the countryside on the edge of Robion, Le Manoir et Pavillon offers guests a privileged position in the Luberon region of Provence.

Robion itself is a delight, where cobbled lanes weave past weathered stone houses and fragrant olive groves, set against the dramatic backdrop of the Luberon mountains. Just a 15-minute stroll from the property (partly following country lanes/roads with no pavement), guests can enjoy the warm village atmosphere, browse the Friday market brimming with local produce or admire the 12th-century Romanesque church. In summer, the restored open-air quarry theatre hosts enchanting concerts under the stars.

The nearby town of Cavaillon offers a full range of amenities including large supermarkets and additional dining options. Renowned for its succulent summer melons and vibrant market, it's also home to a striking 18th-century synagogue and an impressive Roman arch.

From here, you're perfectly positioned to explore the enchanting landscapes of the Luberon Regional Natural Park, where hiking and cycling trails wind through lavender fields, vineyards and perched hilltop villages.

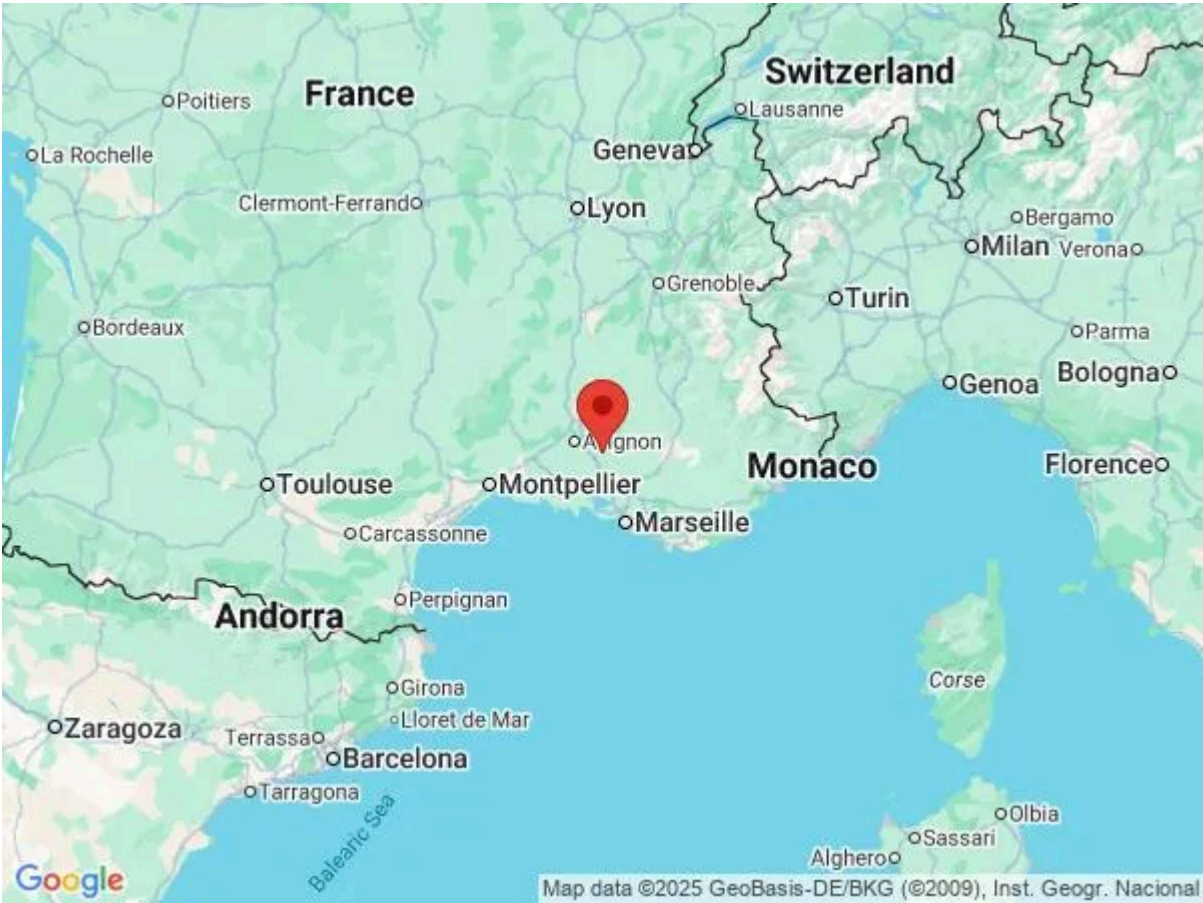
Within easy reach, discover the storied villages that inspired Peter Mayle's beloved A Year in Provence such as Ménerbes, Gordes, Lacoste and Goult, each offering a postcard-perfect blend of rustic charm, pretty restaurant terraces and sweeping valley views. Look out for lovely weekly markets and plenty of wine-tasting opportunities across the region.

For a touch of riverside romance, head to L'Isle-sur-la-Sorgue, famous for its antique shops, waterside cafés, and leafy canals that meander through the town. A little further afield, the historic city of Avignon beckons with its majestic Papal Palace, medieval ramparts and vibrant arts scene.

Whether you're exploring ancient streets, sipping local Côtes du Luberon wines or indulging in Provençal cuisine under a canopy of plane trees, Le Manoir et Pavillon promises the perfect base from which to savour the best of southern France.
