

Villa Serenity Hill

Region: Paxos Sleeps: 4

Overview

Villa Serenity Hill is a 100-year-old stone house located in the hillside of Lakka. Combining traditional features with modern comforts, the property has thick stone walls, beamed ceilings, and updated amenities such as air-conditioned bedrooms, a fully equipped kitchen, and WiFi. The two bedrooms consist of a double with an ensuite bathroom and a twin that can be converted into a double. Both are bright and comfortable, with soft linens and windows overlooking olive groves.

The Villa is set on 2 acres of private land with landscaping and no neighbours, the outdoor area includes a private pool with jacuzzi surrounded by sun loungers and Mediterranean plants, set against terraced hillsides. The surrounding landscape features olive groves leading down to the sea. Guests can enjoy swimming, dining on the terrace, or exploring local walking paths through nearby villages. The village of Lakka, with tavernas, shops, and boat hire, is located 2km away, while the villa itself provides a peaceful and private setting.

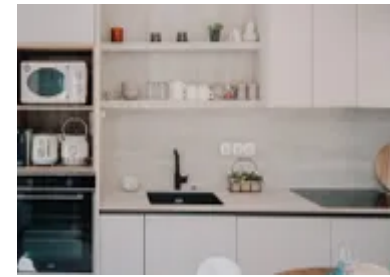

Location & Local Information

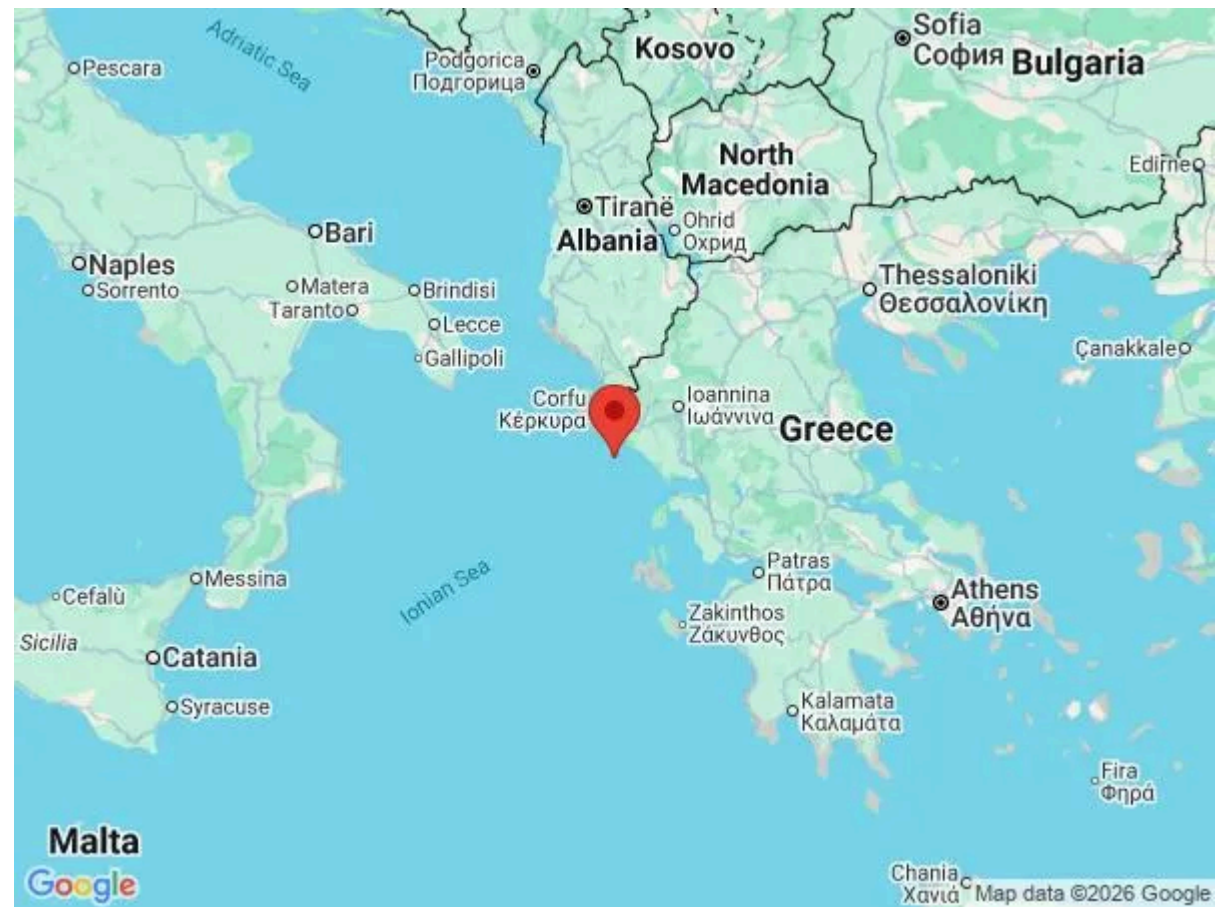
Located near the historic Church of Ypapanti, this villa is set in a quiet valley close to Grammatikeika. Surrounded by olive groves, stone walls, and rolling hills, it provides a calm environment away from busier areas. Paths from nearby Magazia pass through the countryside with fig trees and wild herbs, making it a pleasant spot for walking or enjoying nature.

Nearby, you will find Lakka, a small fishing village on the northern tip of Paxos. It is known for its horseshoe-shaped bay, considered one of the most attractive natural harbours in the region. The clear, calm waters are suitable for swimming, snorkelling, or boating. Yachts and smaller vessels often anchor here, contributing to a lively but relaxed atmosphere.

The village centre features a waterfront lined with pastel-coloured buildings, tavernas, and cafés. Visitors can dine by the water, try local seafood, and watch the sunset over the Ionian Sea. Although Lakka is a popular destination, it maintains a traditional character, with narrow streets, welcoming residents, and a slower pace.
