Fully air-conditioned and equipped with modern amenities, Villa Lys d'Arles ensures every comfort is thoughtfully considered. The semi-open kitchen flows into the dining space, perfect for preparing regional delights with ease. The living room, complete with a fireplace and television, provides a relaxed setting for cooler evenings. Both bedrooms downstairs feature a queen-size double bed and en suite, with the master bedroom boasting both a bathtub and Italian shower. Upstairs, a self-contained studio with twin beds, kitchenette and private shower room offers independence for family members or friends.

Ideally located, the villa places you just moments from Arles' celebrated Roman amphitheatre, vibrant galleries and lively markets. From here, explore the Camargue's wild beauty, visit Nimes or venture into Les Alpilles for picture-perfect villages, olive groves and vineyards.

Location & Local Information

Villa Lys d'Arles is set in a residential area close to the historic centre offering a superb base for exploring Arles. It's also wonderful to be within driving distance to many cultural highlights of southern France from picture-perfect Provençal villages and olive groves across Les Alpilles to the wild beauty of the Camargue.

Rich in Roman heritage and artistic spirit, Arles is a city that brims with cultural treasures. The UNESCO-listed Roman Amphitheatre (650m) is a breathtaking sight, especially when illuminated at night, and nearby you'll find the ancient theatre, thermal baths and impressive cryptoporticus beneath the forum. Art lovers can follow in the footsteps of Van Gogh, visiting spots that inspired his masterpieces, while contemporary art spaces like LUMA Arles (1km) add a modern twist to the city's creative soul.

Wander the cobbled lanes and atmospheric squares, discovering galleries, charming cafés and vibrant markets brimming with Provençal produce. The Musée Réattu (900m), housed in a 15th-century Grand Priory, offers a fascinating collection of fine art and photography. Throughout the year, Arles plays host to renowned festivals, from photography and music to traditional Camargue celebrations – there's always something to experience, not to mention the Saturday morning market, considered to be one of Provence's most impressive.

Just south lies the captivating Camargue, a wild and protected landscape of salt marshes, lagoons and expansive plains. Spot pink flamingos and semi-wild white horses on a 4x4 safari, explore scenic walking trails or enjoy horse-riding through nature reserves. The nearby town of Saintes-Maries-de-la-Mer (42km) offers beach days, boat trips and a taste of local culture.

To the northeast, Les Alpilles invites exploration. Visit Maussane-les-Alpilles (17km) for its olive oil mills and weekly market, then discover Fontvieille (9km) and its scenic windmill trail inspired by Daudet. Les Baux-de-Provence (18km), a hilltop village with spectacular views, not far from the immersive Carrières des Lumières, while Saint-Rémy-de-Provence (24km) enchants with its Wednesday morning market, ancient Roman ruins and Van Gogh walking trail.

Further afield, Nîmes (36km) beckons with its grand Roman monuments, including the mighty Arena and Maison Carrée. Combine a visit with the extraordinary Pont du Gard (39km), an iconic Roman aqueduct bridge straddling the Gardon River – a testament to the architectural brilliance of antiquity and a stunning sight amidst beautiful natural surroundings.
