In the quiet village of Kaina, in the heart of Apokoronas, Villa Orophelia welcomes you with a harmonious blend of modern elegance and traditional Cretan charm. Surrounded by stone walls, mountain views, and lush greenery, this private villa offers living spaces across two levels and is designed for both families and groups who want privacy, comfort, and easy access to Chania's treasures.


Location & Local Information

The villa lies in the charming village of Kaina, a quiet corner of Apokoronas surrounded by rolling hills and dramatic views of the White Mountains. Life here moves at a gentle pace, with traditional tavernas, local grocers and family-run cafés found in nearby villages such as Vamos and Douliana. For beach days, Almyrida and Georgioupolis are within a short drive, both offering golden sand and shallow waters ideal for swimming.

Kaina's location also gives easy access to Chania, around half an hour away, where Venetian history, lively markets and excellent dining come together. The region is known for its wine, olive oil and timeless rural traditions, and visitors can enjoy walking trails through cypress forests or tours of local wineries. It's an authentic taste of Crete, with all the essentials close at hand.

Terms & Conditions

- **Security deposit:** There is no security deposit, but should there be any damage or loss caused by you or your guests during your stay you will be liable for the cost
- **Arrival time:** 5pm
- **Departure time:** 11am
- **Energy costs included?**: Yes, include in rental price
- **Linen & towels included?**: For reservations of 5 to 7 days, we provide one cleaning service with a change of linens and towels, and for stays longer than 7 days, we offer one cleaning service and a change of linens and towels every 4 days.
- **Pets welcome?**: Not allowed
- **Other Ts and Cs:** Please note that on occasions, in Greece, extremes in weather can cause water and/ or electric supply to be cut or reduced. Services are normally restored as soon as possible.
- **Changeover day:** Flexible
- **End of stay cleaning available?**: Yes. However, guests are required to leave the accommodation clean, tidy and in the same condition as on their arrival.
- **Smoking Allowed?**: Not permitted
- **Insurance:** Guests are required to be in possession of a valid insurance policy, which covers them for cancellations, personal belongings, personal liability and any accidental damage caused during their stay.
- **Minimum stay:** 4 nights
- **Internet access?**: The property has complimentary Wifi connection. It is good to note that the speed is dependent on local provider and technical issues may cause reduced speed or cut of service.

The Greek government requires owners to collect a Tourist Climate Tax, your property manager will collect this in cash:

€15 per night/villa from April to October
€4 per night/villa from November to March
