

Cluzel Barn Conversion

Overview

In the heart of the Lot Valley, Cluzel Barn Conversion rises from the landscape as a sophisticated blend of traditional craftsmanship and contemporary design. This former agricultural building has been thoughtfully reimaged by an architect with a deep respect for its rural heritage, retaining its soaring beamed ceilings and exposed stonework while introducing sleek, modern finishes that elevate the everyday.

Inside, the expansive double-height living and dining space creates a sense of light and freedom. The open-plan kitchen is beautifully equipped, with a central island and BORA induction hob, ideal for relaxed holiday cooking. The dining and living area flows seamlessly toward a tall window framing views across the countryside. Throughout the home, original timber and stone are softened by warm textiles and elegant furnishings, creating an atmosphere that's as welcoming as it is refined.

Three bedrooms comfortably accommodate up to six guests. A lower-floor ensuite double opens directly onto the terrace, while two upstairs bedrooms, both with ceiling fans and exposed wood beams, share a stylish family bathroom. A mezzanine lounge with Smart TV and upright piano offers an additional space for quiet moments or evening entertainment.

Outside, the grounds stretch out towards woodland and rolling hills, with an inviting 11-metre private pool, shaded dining terrace, barbecue area as well as table tennis and table football.

This characterful retreat is ideal for couples, friends or families with older children seeking a slow, sensory-rich escape. Spend your days lounging by the pool, strolling through countryside or enjoying a leisurely breakfast overlooking the valley as sunlight spills across the garden.

The location is wonderfully placed for exploring the best of the Lot. Just 10km from Prayssac's lively market, cafés and restaurants, and only 21km from the riverside town of Cahors, where medieval charm meets fine Malbec wines and vibrant local culture. Castelfranc's village bakery and weekly market lie even closer, while the swimming lake at Lac Vert offers family-friendly adventures a short drive away.

For those in search of natural beauty, authentic flavours and a sense of space, Cluzel Barn Conversion offers a setting where time slows and the views go on forever.

In nearby Castelfranc (7km), guests will find a charming village atmosphere with essential local amenities including a bakery, a traditional restaurant and a lively Monday street market ideal for picking up fresh local produce. Prayssac (10km) offers a fuller range of shops, a supermarket, cafés and restaurants, along with a popular Friday market that showcases the region's culinary delights.

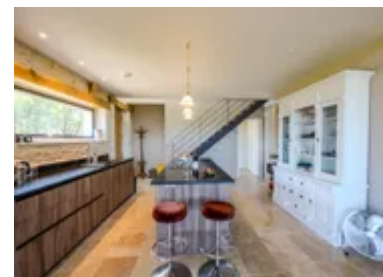
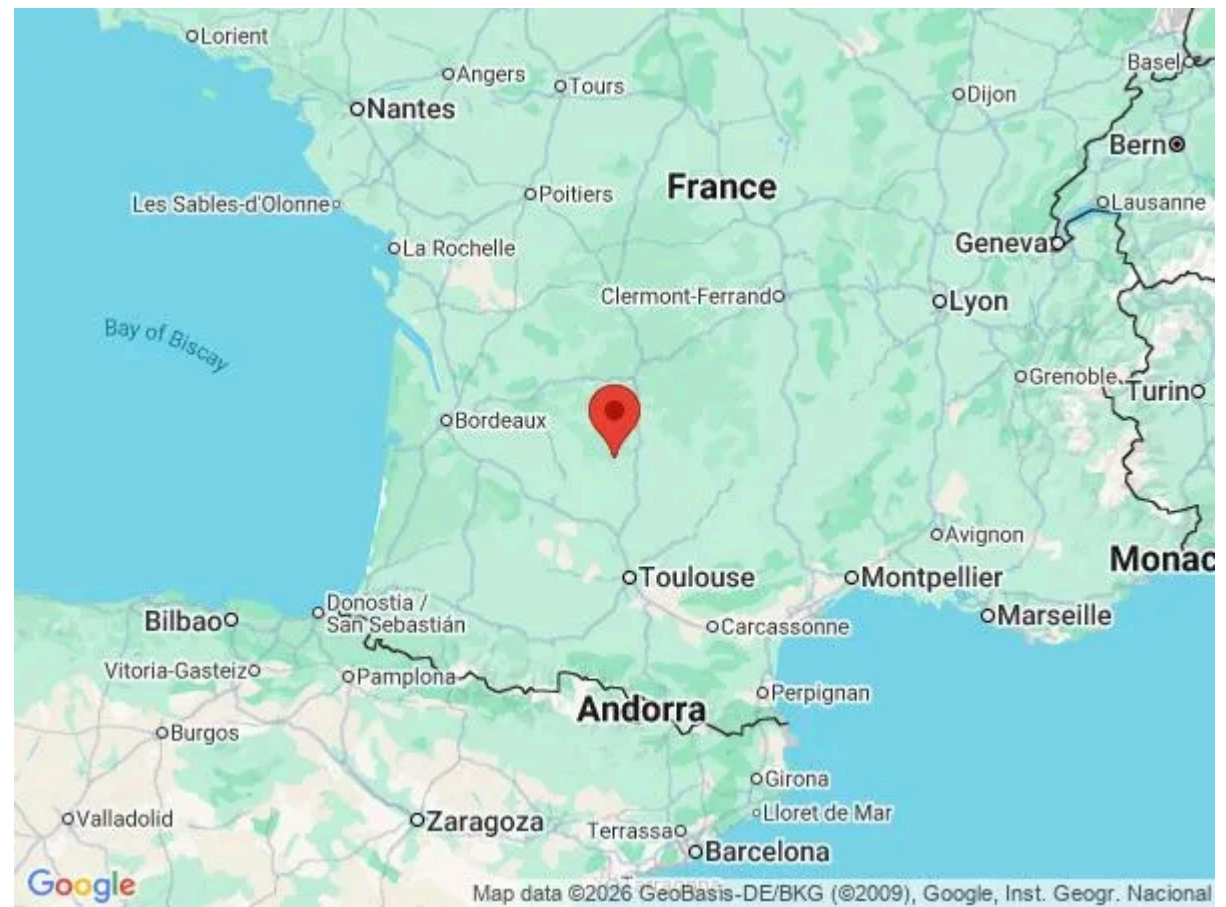
Cahors is a captivating riverside town renowned for its medieval charm, vibrant markets and rich wine-making heritage. It lies at the heart of the prestigious Malbec vineyards, where visitors can enjoy wine-tasting at renowned domaines dotted throughout the surrounding countryside. For those eager to explore, there's plenty more to enjoy within easy reach. Spend the day swimming and relaxing at Lac Vert in Catus (8km), a lovely lake with shaded picnic spots and plenty of seasonal activities beside and on the lake. History and culture enthusiasts will enjoy visiting the fairytale village of Saint-Cirq-Lapopie (48km), perched high above the river — you can even take a scenic boat trip there from Cahors for a leisurely day out.

Whether you're cycling through the countryside, exploring local markets or sipping wines by the river in Cahors, this idyllic corner of the Lot provides a truly enriching French experience.
